CONTENTS

This is the 6th report in the FEC Disclosure Series. It covers the financial activity of the 64 candidates for the United States Senate who appeared on the 1976 general election ballot.¹ These candidates included 33 Democrats, 30 Republicans, and one Independent.² The Report provides a comprehensive financial picture of each campaign, including sources of receipts, total adjusted receipts and expenditures, cash on hand and surplus/deficit positions. Also included is a chart showing total receipts and expenditures for all candidates, and charts showing the distribution of receipts and expenditures among candidates by party affiliation, incumbent or challenger status, and winners or losers.

This report covers all campaign finance activity during the period January 1, 1975 through December 31, 1976. The figures therefore represent a combination of primary and general election financing.³

Adjusted figures for receipts and expenditures are the best indication of income and costs for a campaign, as loan repayments, refunds, or other items which inflate the figures have been eliminated.

The Total Receipts Adjusted for the 1976 Senatorial campaigns were \$39,129,660. The Total Expenditures Adjusted were \$38,104,745.

The financial figures in this report are derived from the figures reported by the individual candidates, their principal campaign committees and all other authorized committees. The figures may be subject to adjustment following subsequent amendment or FEC audit.

This was the first campaign in which a candidate's principal campaign committee was required to file Consolidated Reports of Receipts and Expenditures (to include all authorized committees). As a result, many campaigns were not conversant with this procedure, and it was often difficult to derive a clear picture of overall costs from these consolidated reports. Therefore, the adjusted figures in this report were derived by review of each individual report filed and represent the best effort with the time and resources allocated. More detailed or itemized campaign finance data can be found in the actual disclosure reports filed.

All reports are available for public review and/or copying at the Federal Election Commission, "Provided, that any information copied from such reports and statements shall not be sold or utilized by any person for the purpose of soliciting contributions or for any commercial purpose." (2 U.S.C. Section 438(a)(4))

¹ While there were 33 races, the Democratic candidates in Mississippi and West Virginia were unopposed in the general election.

² In New York the Democratic candidate was also the nominee of the Liberal Party, and the Republican candidate the nominee of the Conservative Party.

³ All 64 General Election candidates also appeared on the primary ballot in their respective states with the exception of Lawton Chiles of Florida.

DEFINITIONS

INDIVIDUAL CONTRIBUTIONS:

to and including \$100: Contributions reported in this amount, including total unitemized contributions.

\$1 - \$499: Contributions reported in this amount. This is a derived total, not a tabulated total.

\$500 and over: Total contributions reported in this amount. The number of contributions is also given for this category which could include more than one contribution from the same contributor.

Contributions from the candidates: This includes monies directly reported as contributions from the candidate and does not include loans.

POLITICAL COMMITTEE CONTRIBUTIONS:

Party - Total monies received from Party Related Political Committees.

Non-Party - Total monies received from Non-Party Political Committees.

LOANS:

Candidate Loans - Loans from the candidate or endorsed by the candidate. This figure reflects the aggregate total of all loans received from the candidate and has not been adjusted for loan repayments. The computer printout also lists an amount repaid as 'RPD.'

Other Loans - This figure reflects the aggregate totals of all loans received from sources other than the candidate and has not been adjusted for loan repayments.

TOTAL RECEIPTS ADJUSTED:

Contributions received from individuals, contributions from political committees, loans, and miscellaneous income. It does not include refunds, rebates, returned contributions, loan repayments, treasury notes and certificates of deposit which have been bought and redeemed.

TOTAL EXPENDITURES ADJUSTED:

Total gross expenditures less refunds, rebates, returned contributions, loan repayments, transfers between affiliated committees or between the candidate and his/her committee(s), treasury notes and certificates of deposit which have been bought and redeemed.

Because this study is based solely on reports filed by a candidate and his/her authorized political committee(s), the Total Expenditures Adjusted do not include expenditures reported by the national political parties; persons making independent expenditures; communication costs of corporations, labor and membership organizations; trade associations. Office accounts which are clearly identified as non-campaign accounts and have not been included even though they are presently registered as political committees.

CASH ON HAND:

This figure is as reported on the Year End 1976 Report. In a number of instances, negative Cash on Hand was reported.

SURPLUS/DEFICIT:

This is a theoretical figure derived by subtracting the amount owed by the committee, or adding the amount owed to the committee, from the Cash on Hand figure which was reported on the Year End 1976 Report.

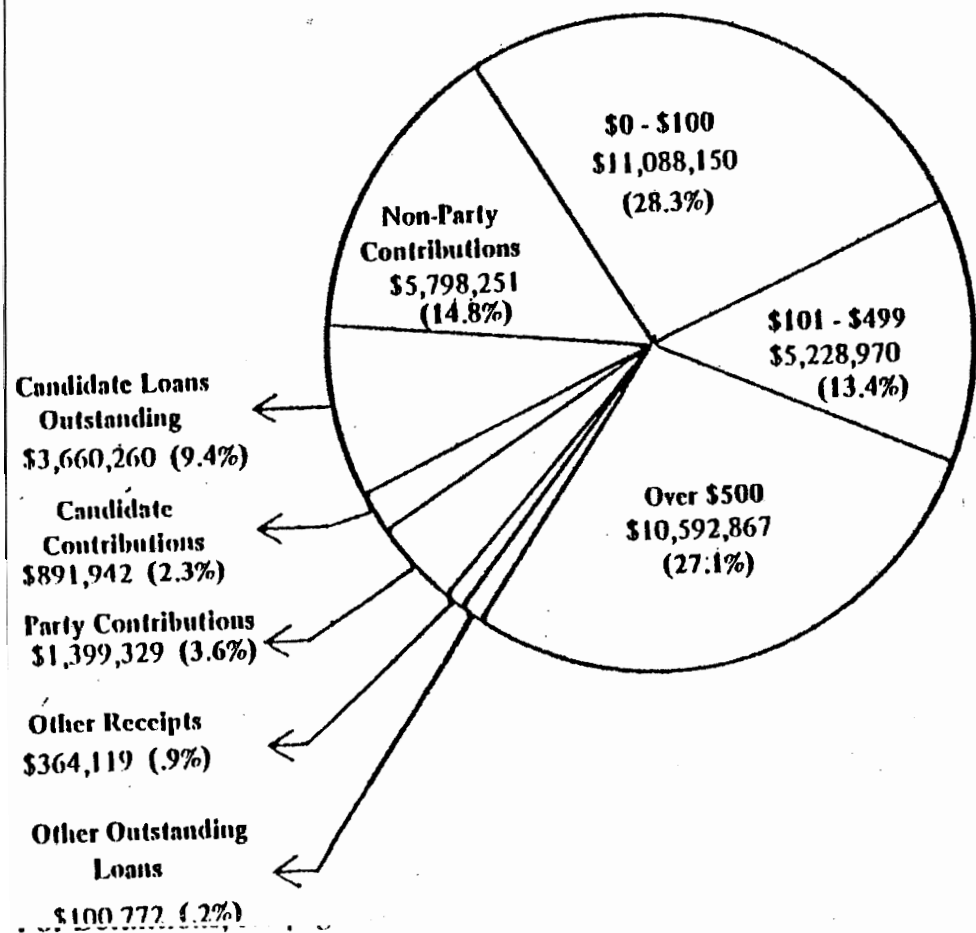

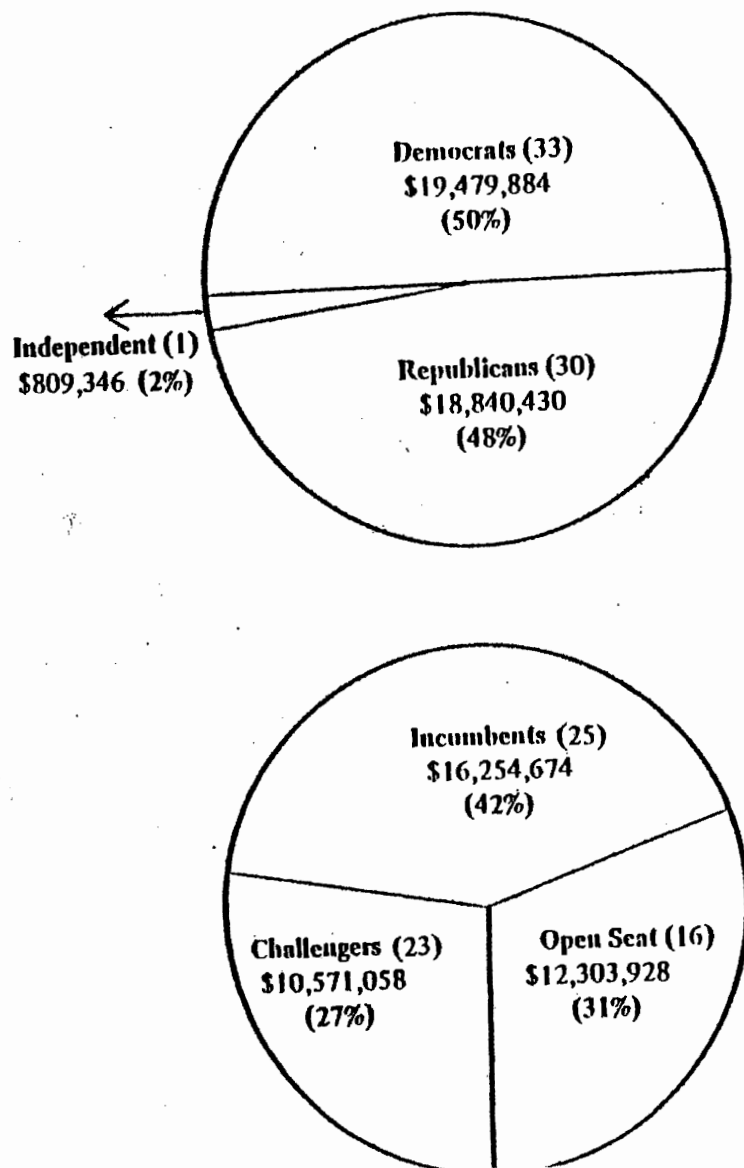

DISTRIBUTION OF RECEIPTS BY PARTY AND STAT \$39,129,660



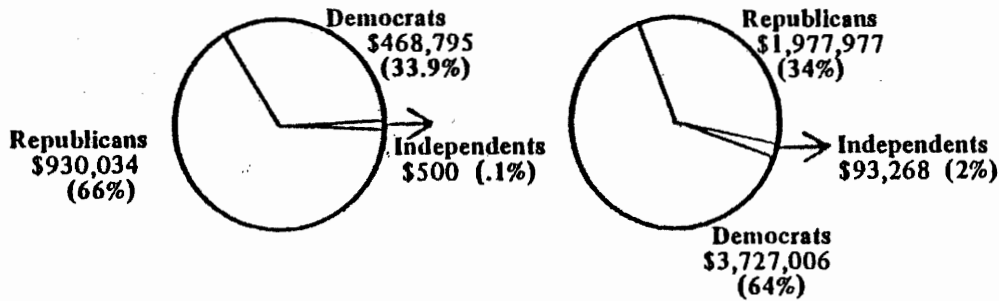

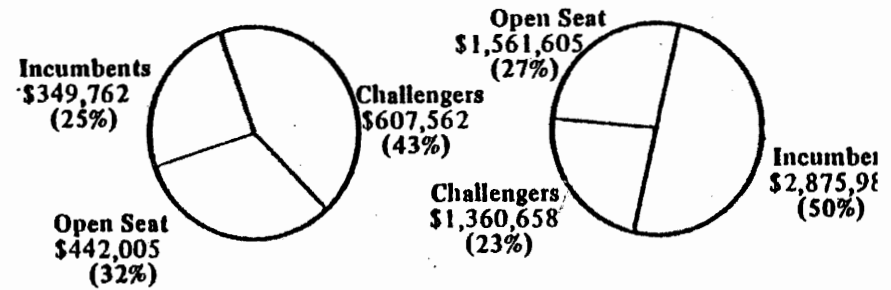

DISTRIBUTION BY STATUS



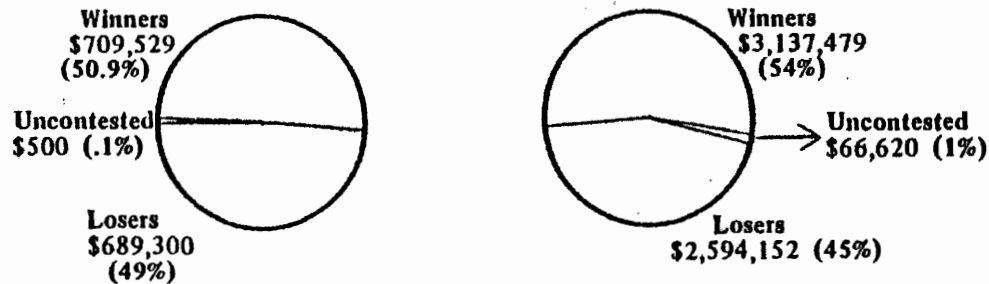

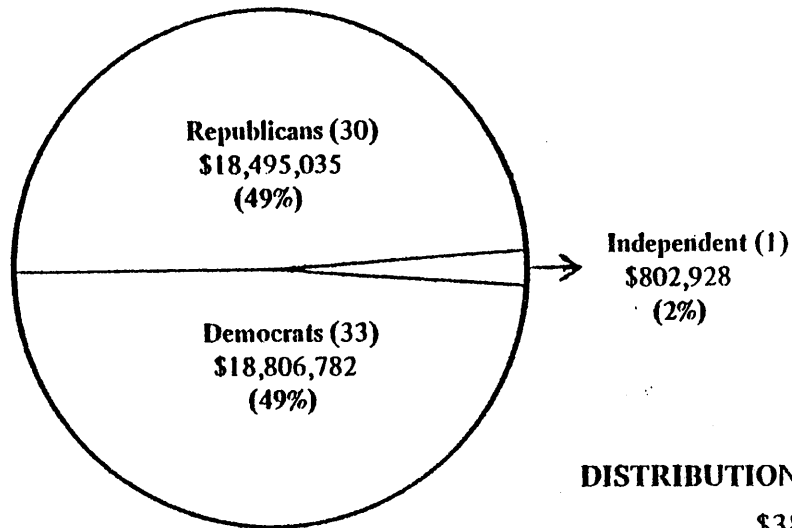

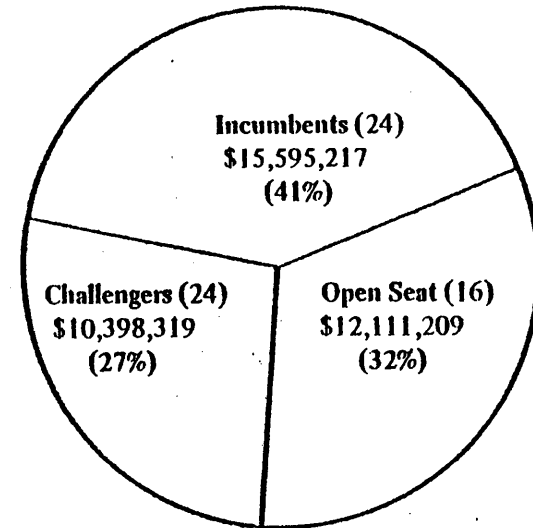
DISTRIBUTION BY PARTY

\$38,104,745



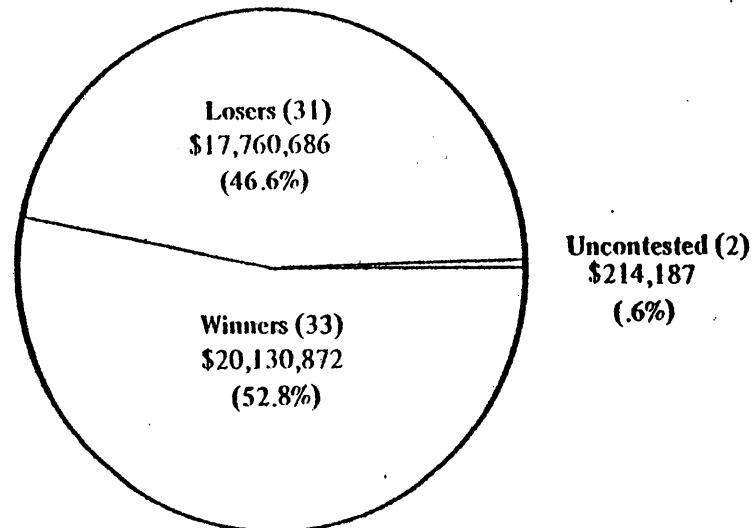
DISTRIBUTION BY STATUS
