CONTENTS

This report is intended to provide an overall picture of the involvement of the 303 labor-related political action committees participating in the 1976 campaign. These labor-related political committees reported spending \$20,326,500 during the period January 1, 1975 through December 31, 1976 covered by this study. Because funds were often transferred between political committees gross receipts and expenditures are inflated figures. Removing these transfers creates a total adjusted expenditure of \$17,488,650. Concentrated attention has been given to those committees which reported receiving or expending in excess of \$100,000 during this time. While these 42 committees reflect only 13.9% of the total number of labor-related political action committees, they account for 83.6% of the total amount expended by all of the labor-related political committees. The remaining 261 committees which make up the other 16.4% of the total expended amount are also included in this study in less detail.

In addition, each committee is listed with its reported connected, affiliated, or sponsoring organization. Committees which have reported no connected, affiliated, or sponsoring organization are footnoted to provide identifying data.

Over 86% of the committees have provided the names of an affiliated and/or connected organization. Forty-two committees have either listed "NONE" or failed to answer the section of the Statement of Organization requiring the names of any affiliated or connected organi-

zations. In this later case the word "BLANK" appears under the name of the committee. In neither case should the appearance of these two words under the name of any committee imply noncompliance with the Act on the part of a committee since it may indicate a misunderstanding of the requirements of the Act and the FEC Regulations.

This report is presented in two parts. The two parts present a consolidated picture of the financial activity of all labor-related political action committees and include summary statistics, graphic presentations of the number of various categories of committees plus their reported receipts and expenditures for the two year period by this study and the cash on hand balances as of December 31, 1976.

Part I is a summary of all labor-related committees listing receipts and expenditures and other data.

Part II highlights the 73 labor-related entities with political action committees. This presentation is made in alphabetical sequence by the full name of the labor organization with all related political committees below. In addition, political action committees which also appear to have a relationship with the union have also been included and footnoted as necessary.

DEFINITIONS

INDIVIDUAL CONTRIBUTIONS:

\$0 to and including \$100: This category includes contributions in these amounts and total unitemized contributions.

\$101 - \$499: This category includes all contributions reported in these amounts.

\$500 and over: This category includes all contributions reported in these amounts.

TOTAL RECEIPTS ADJUSTED:

This category includes contributions received from individuals, party committees, unaffiliated non-party committees, loans, interest, and miscellaneous income. Total receipts adjusted does not include refunds, rebates, returned contributions, loan repayments, treasury notes and certificates of deposits which have been bought and redeemed.

TOTAL EXPENDITURES ADJUSTED:

This category includes total reported expenditures less refunds, rebates, returned contributions, loan repayments, treasury notes and certificates of deposits which have been bought and redeemed. Transfers between affiliated committees have been netted out.

CASH ON HAND: (As of December 31, 1976)

This figure is taken directly from the total Cash on Hand listed on the 1976 Year End Report.

MULTICANDIDATE COMMITTEE:

“Multicandidate committee” means a political committee which (i) has been registered with the Commission, Clerk, or Secretary for at least 6 months; (ii) has received contributions for Federal elections from more than 50 persons; and . . . (iii) has made contributions to 5 or more Federal candidates. (Section 114(a)(3))

A committee qualifying as a “multicandidate committee” is permitted to contribute \$5,000 per election per Federal candidate as opposed to \$1,000 per election per candidate; prior to meeting the above requirements.

AFFILIATED COMMITTEE:

“All committees . . . established, financed, maintained, or controlled by the same corporation, labor organization, person, or group of persons including any parent, subsidiary, branch, division, department, or local unit thereof, are affiliated.

(i) Application of the rule of this paragraph means that --

(A) All political committees set up by a single corporation and/or its subsidiaries are affiliated;

(B) All political committees set up by a single national or international union and/or its local unions or other subordinate organization of the national or international union are affiliated;

(C) All of the political committees set up by an organization of national or international unions and all its State and/or local central bodies are affiliated;

(D) All political committees (other than party committees) established by a member organization, including a trade or professional association, see Section 114.8(a), and/or by related State and local entities, are affiliated;

(E) All the political committees established by the same person or group of persons are affiliated;

(ii) For organizations not covered by (i) above, indicia of establishing, financing, maintaining, or controlling, include –

(A) Ownership of a controlling interest in voting shares or securities;

(B) Provisions of bylaws, constitutions, or other documents by which one entity has the authority, power, or ability to direct another entity;

(C) The authority, power, or ability to hire, appoint, discipline, discharge, demote, or remove or otherwise influence the decision of the officers or members of an entity;

(D) Similar patterns of contributions;

(E) The transfer of funds between committees which represent a substantial portion of the funds of either the transferor or transferee committee, other than the transfer of funds between the committees which jointly raised the funds so transferred.” (Section 100.14(c)(2))

CONNECTED ORGANIZATION:

“Connected organization” means any organization which is not a political committee but which directly or indirectly establishes, administers, or financially supports the registrant such as a corporation (including those without capital stock), a labor organization, a membership organization or a cooperative, or trade association.” (Section 100.15)

Of the 303 political committees represented in this study, the 23 committees listed below have made contributions to or expenditures on behalf of Federal candidates in excess of \$100,000 during the period 1975-1976. The total for any individual political committee may represent only a partial picture of the Federal campaign finance activity of its sponsoring union because there may be other affiliated committees. A complete listing of these other Federal political committees appears in Part II of this study.

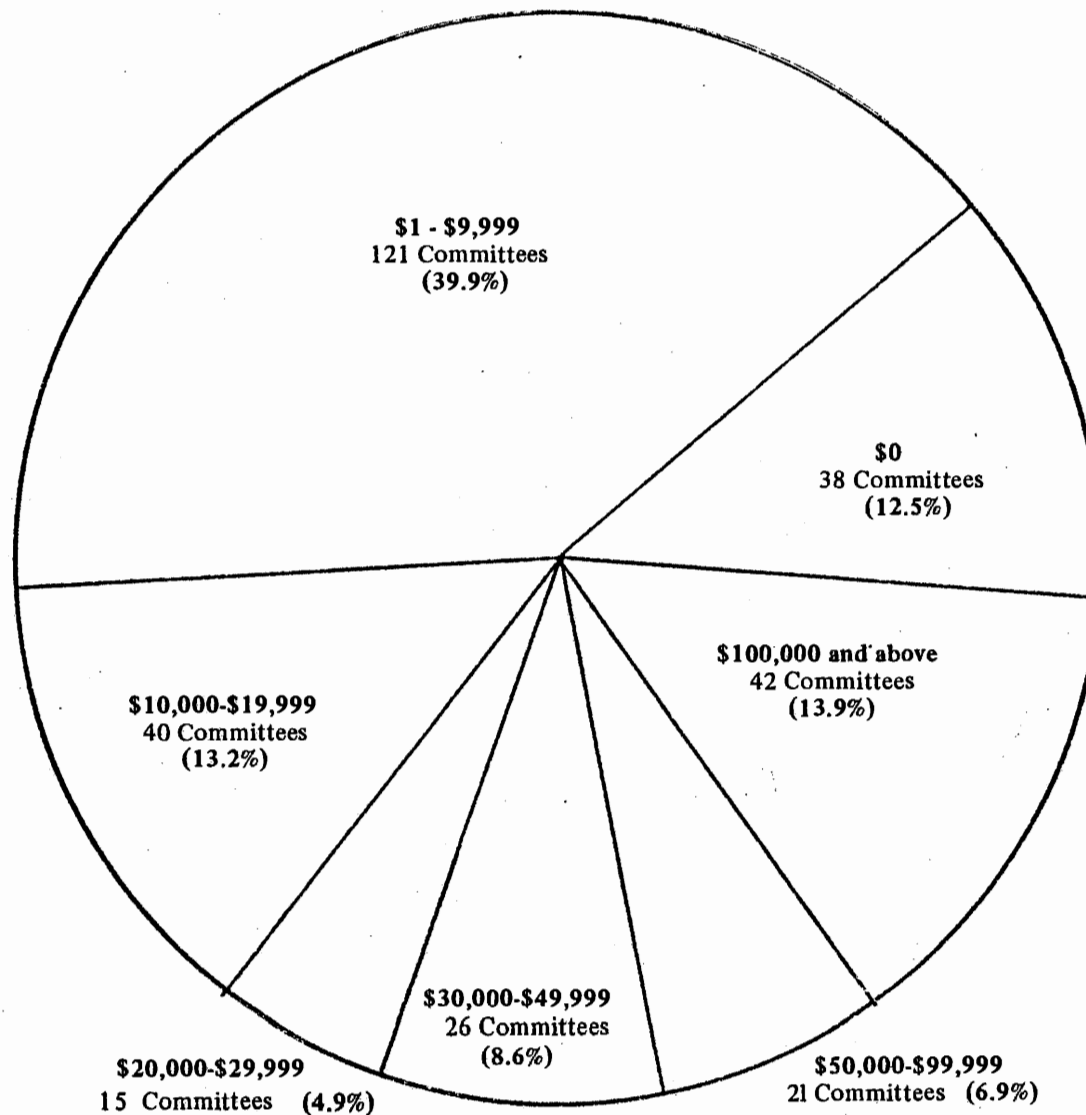

1975 - 1976



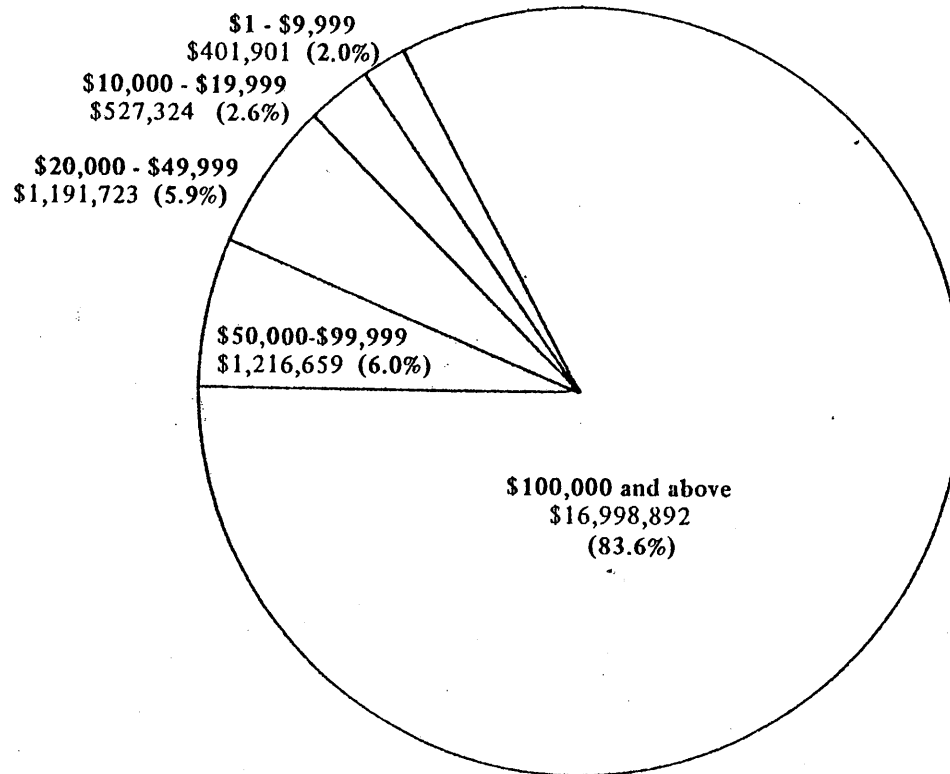
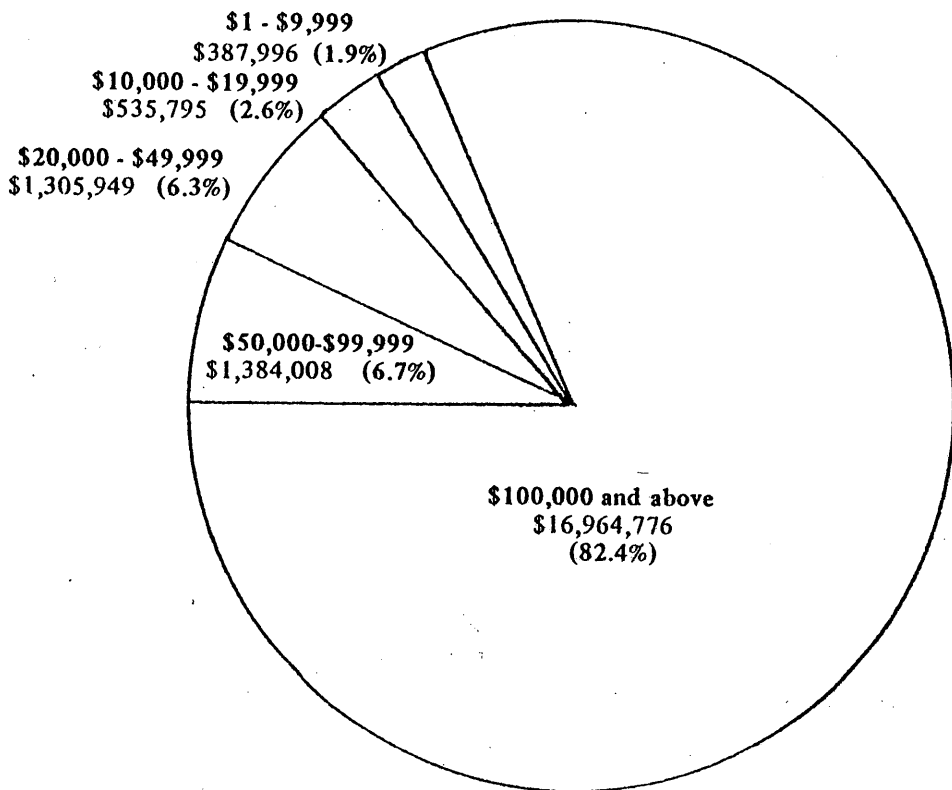

RECEIPTS AND EXPENDITURES

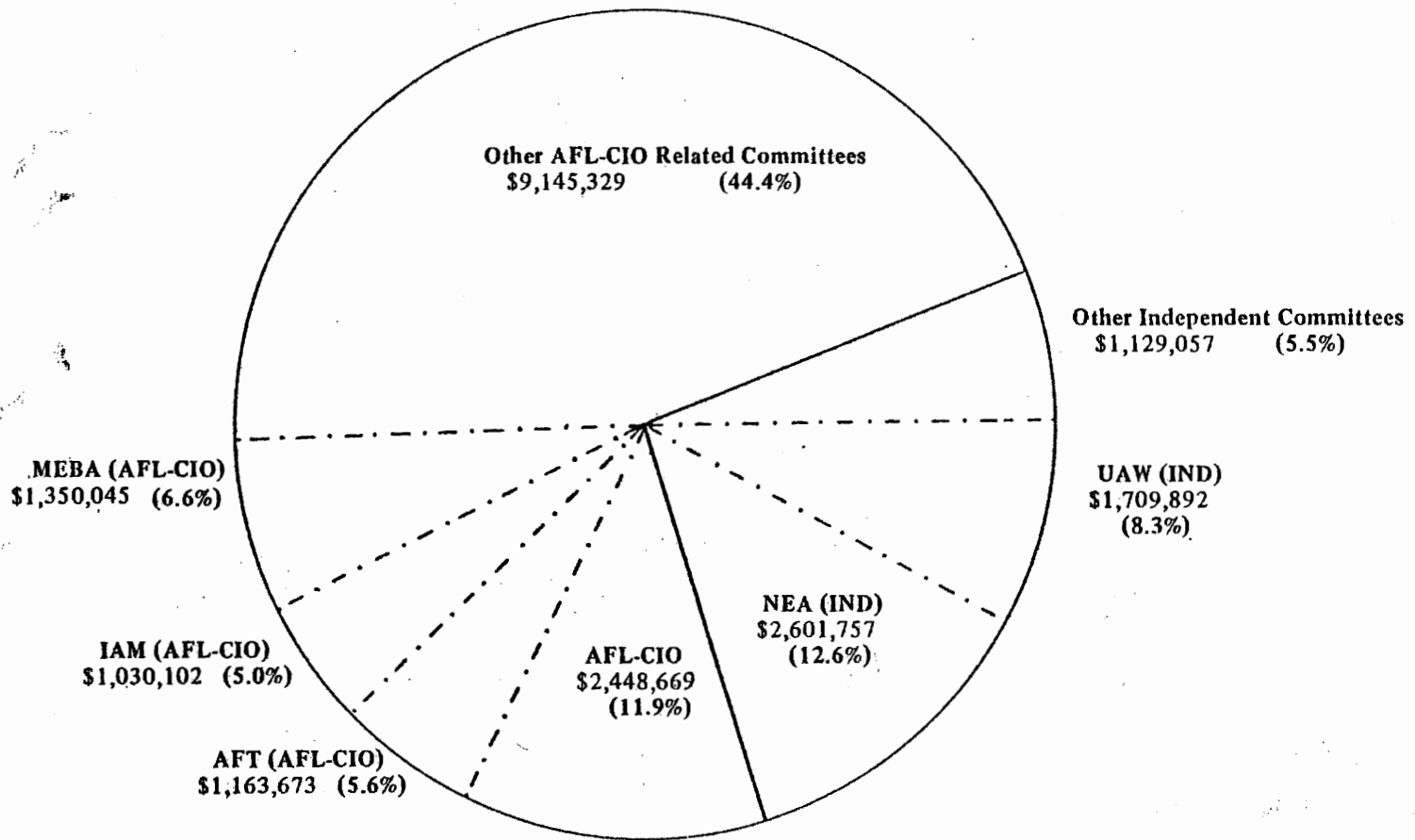

(Gross)



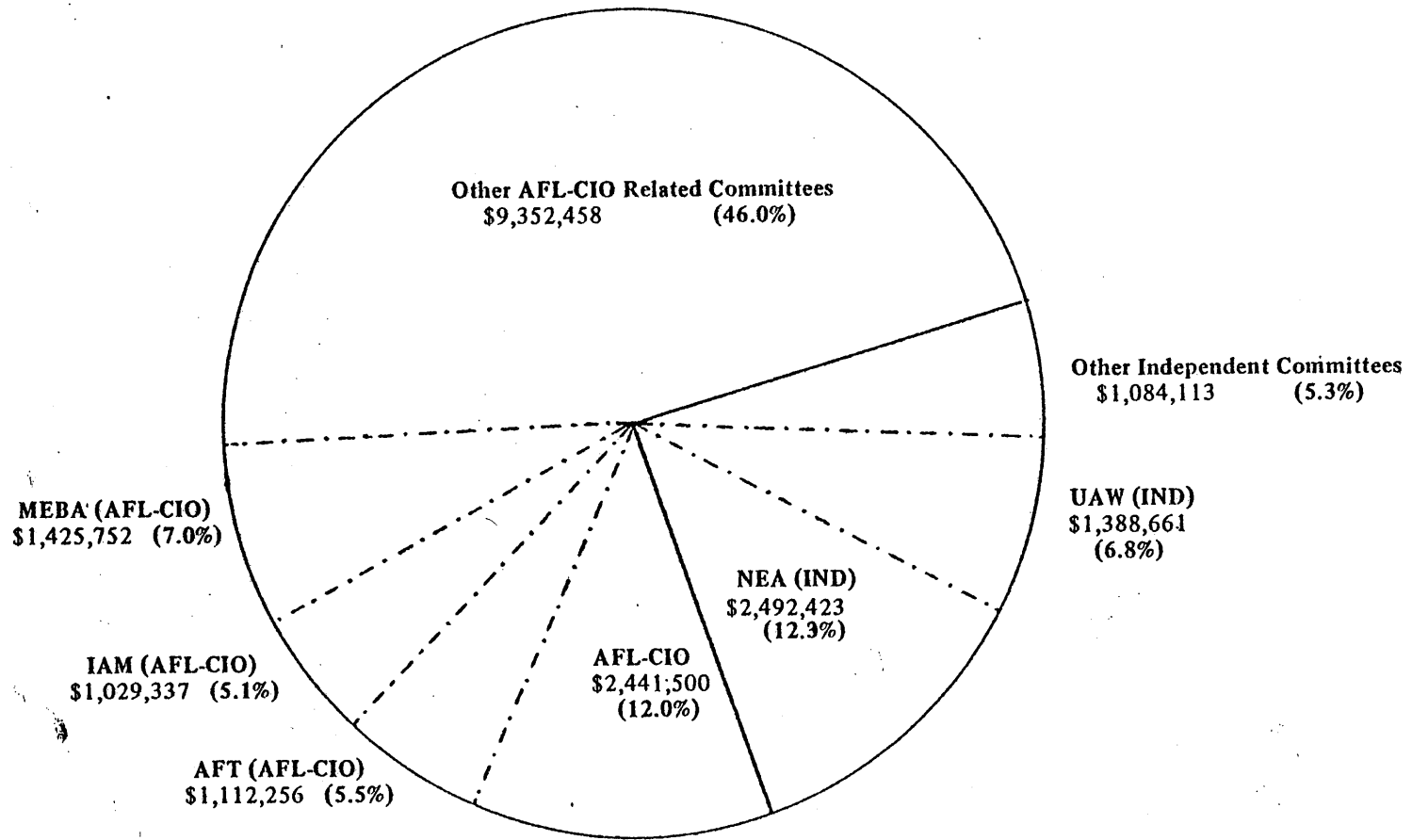
TOTAL RECEIPTS = \$20,578,524

EXPLANATORY NOTES

“Labor organization” as defined in part in the Federal Election Commission’s Regulations and in this study means an organization of any kind or any agency or employee representative committee or plan, in which employees participate and which exists for the purpose, in whole or in part, of dealing with employers concerning grievances, labor disputes, wages, rates of pay, hours of employment, or conditions of work.

Political committees which have stated “None” as to their affiliated or connected organization have “None” listed beneath the committee name. There are eleven political committees in this category.

Political committees which have not identified an affiliated or connected organization have “Blank” listed beneath the committee name. There are thirty-one political committees in this category.

For those committees exceeding \$100,000 in activity, the adjusted receipt and adjusted expenditure figures may differ from the reported figures. In some cases this difference may be very large because the committee has either received a large amount of funds from other political action committees or has transferred a large amount to other political committees.

The symbol “-” is used to represent FEC Form 3a filings for committees whose activity in any quarter does not exceed \$1,000 in receipts or expenditures.

On December 31, 1976, the 224 active and reporting committees represented in this study had \$4,408,513 cash on hand.
