Congressman Davis's appearance in two public service announcements to benefit the National Kidney Foundation by promoting the Cadillac Invitational Golf Tournament.

Chairman Smith recognized Vice Chair Weintraub who offered the following amendments:

- a) Delete footnotes 2, 3, and 4;
- b) Page 3, Line 22, replace the words "funds do" with "solicitation does";
- c) Page 4, Line 8, replace the word "contributions" with the words "a contribution."

It was agreed without objection to accept the amendments.

MOVED to approve draft Advisory Opinion 2004-14, as submitted in Agenda Document No. 04-52, subject to the amendments noted above.

The Chairman recognized Mr. Albert Kiss of the General Counsel's Office who presented draft Advisory Opinion 2004-12 concerning the application of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act"), and Commission regulations to an entity named the Democrats for the West ("DFW"), referred to as a "regional party organization."

Chairman Smith recognized Vice Chair Weintraub who reviewed her proposed amendments, as set forth in Agenda Document No. 04-53-C.

There was further discussion pertaining to the amendments presented by Vice Chair Weintraub in Agenda Document No. 04-53-C.

The Chairman recognized Vice Chair Weintraub, who

MOVED to approve the amendments in Agenda Document No. 04-53-C, subject to the following modifications:

Page 8, Line 2 at the end of the proposed sentence, include the language on Line 15 beginning with the words..."see also Explanation and Justification..." through the end of the sentence on Line 17.

Page 8, delete Lines 3 through 25, with the exception of the language noted above on <u>Lines 15 through 17</u>, and delete Lines 1 and 2 on Page 9.

The motion carried on the vote of 6-0.

#### B. Draft Advisory Opinion 2004-12 (continued)

It was noted that the amendment submitted by Commissioner
Thomas in Agenda Document No. 04-53-B was included in the
amendments which were approved in Agenda Document No. 04-53-C.

Chairman Smith recognized Commissioner Toner who presented the following amendments to **Question 9** in Agenda Document No. 04-53 and moved their adoption:

- 1. <u>Page 10, Line 19, insert</u> "Yes. The DFW may pay employees with Federal funds raised through events where Federal and non-Federal funds are raised when the costs of such events have been properly allocated using the 'funds received' methods."
- 2. <u>Page 11, Line 3</u>, delete "However, DFW...." through Page 11, Line 6 ....11 CFR 300.33(c)(3)."

by a vote of 4-2 with Commissioners Mason, McDonald, Thomas, and Toner voting affirmatively. Commissioners Smith and Weintraub dissented.
