Chairman Lenhard recognized Mr. Robert Knop of the General Counsel's Office who presented draft Advisory Opinion 2007-20, concerning the application of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act"), and Commission regulations to the provision of free air time to presidential candidates during the 2008 election cycle.
