AND MCCAIN-PALIN COMPLIANCE FUND, INC.

Chair Weintraub recognized Ms. Rickida Morcomb of the Audit

Division who stated that the Report contains one finding for the McCain
Palin Compliance Fund, Inc.: failure to file 48-Hour Notices totaling

\$240,700. She also noted that the Report contains an additional issue for McCain-Palin 2008 Inc.: campaign travel billing for the press.

Chair Weintraub recognized Mr. Alex Boniewicz of the Audit Division who stated that the Report contains four findings: 1) misstatement of financial activity; 2) reporting of debts and obligations; 3) disclosure of disbursements; and 4) failure to file notices and properly disclose independent expenditures. He also noted that the Report contains one additional issue: reporting payments from non-federal accounts.

Chair Weintraub recognized Vice Chairman McGahn who

MOVED to approve the Proposed Final Audit Report on the Maine Republican Party as found in Agenda Document No. 13-05-A and authorize the Audit Division to make any technical and conforming edits. The motion carried by a vote of 5-0 with Commissioners Hunter, McGahn, Petersen, Walther, and Weintraub voting affirmatively for the decision.

V. PROPOSED FINAL AUDIT REPORT ON RIGHTMARCH.COM PAC, INC. (A09-25)

MOVED to approve the Proposed Final Audit Report on Rightmarch.com PAC, Inc. as found in Agenda Document No. 13-06-A and authorize the Audit Division to make any technical and conforming edits.

McGahn, Petersen, and Weintraub voting affirmatively for the decision.
