**SUBMITTED LATE**

The Information Division proposes the following amendments to the Revised Campaign Guide for Nonconnected Political Committees, Agenda Document No. 02-18.

1. On page 2, under the heading "\$1,000 Registration Threshold," correct the citation at the end of the first paragraph to read 100.5(a), rather than 100.5(c).
2. On page 9, under the heading "Federal Election Purpose," replace the existing paragraph with the following:

In order to deposit undesignated contributions into its federal account, a committee must inform donors that their contributions will be used in connection with federal elections and/or that they are subject to the limits and prohibitions of the Act. 102.5(a)(2)(ii) and (iii).<sup>1</sup> The committee may satisfy this requirement by including that information in its solicitation materials.

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1. In recent enforcement actions and advisory opinions, the Commission has permitted committees to deposit into their federal accounts contributions that satisfy any one of the criteria set forth at 102.5(a)(2)(i), (ii) and (iii). See, for example, AO 2000-25.

**Recommendation**

The Information Division recommends that the Commission adopt the amendments set forth above, and approve the revised Guide for publication.
