## II. <u>FEC REPORTING FORMS - BCRA IMPLEMENTATION</u> (continued)

"The committee may disclose and itemize under 11 CFR 300.36(b)(2)(iv) its receipt of Levin funds either at the time the receipts are first received and deposited or at a later date when the committee makes Levin disbursements out of Levin-eligible funds. If a committee maintains a separate Levin account, the committee must disclose and itemize the Levin receipts when they are deposited in the Levin account."

The motion carried on the vote of 5-0 with Commissioners Mason, McDonald, Thomas, Toner, and Weintraub voting affirmatively.

Chair Weintraub recognized Commissioner Toner,

who

MOVED to amend Agenda Document No. 03-09 as follows:

1. Page 127 delete Lines 6, 7, and Line 8 through the word "funds" and substitute the following in lieu thereof: II. <u>FEC REPORTING FORMS - BCRA IMPLEMENTATION</u> (continued)

"Any State, district, or local party committee that is a political committee and engages in allocable federal election activities must file. Any association or similar group of candidates for State or local office or of individuals holding State or local office that is not a political committee does not have to file this form. Reporting committees may either make all payments...";

Page 153, Line 20, delete the word "made" and insert the words "that have been publicly distributed" in lieu thereof.

The motion carried on the vote of 5-0 with Commissioners Mason, McDonald, Thomas, Toner, and Weintraub voting affirmatively.
