The Chair recognized Mr. Jonathan Levin of the General Counsel's Office who presented draft Advisory Opinion 2003-11 concerning the application of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"), and Commission regulations to MDSCC's provision of "fringe benefits" such as insurance and retirement benefits to its employees. During his presentation, Mr. Levin offered the following amendment:

On Page 3, Line 13, insert
"("FEA")" after the word
"activity."

A discussion followed.

Chair Weintraub recognized Commissioner Toner, who presented the following amendments to Agenda Document No. 03-53:

- Page 4, Line 12: insert the words "who benefits from them." after the word "employee.";
- Page 4, Line 16: delete the word "compensation" and substitute the words "compensated time";
- 3. <u>Page 5: Delete Lines 6 and 7</u>, begin the sentence on <u>Line 8</u> by inserting the words "The Commission";
- 4. Page 5, Line 9: insert "i.e.," after the word "employee" and delete the words "For instance,";
- 5. Page 5, Line 10: delete the words "under such an approach";
- 6. Page 5, delete the sentence which begins on Line 15 and ends on Line 17; on Line 17, delete the first word in the next sentence "Accordingly" and begin that sentence with "The";

- 7. Page 5, Lines 20 and 21: delete the words "must be treated in the same manner as 'salaries and wages.'" replace with the words: "fall into the category of compensated time.";
- 8. Page 5, Line 21: Insert the word "Therefore," at the beginning of the sentence before "when."
