



GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

BACKGROUND

On August 20, 1979, the Commission adopted the recommendation of the General Counsel and found reason to believe that the First National Bank of Lincolnwood, Illinois violated 2 U.S.C. §441b by making contributions/expenditures to local political organizations. On August 22, a letter was sent notifying the bank of the Commission's finding.

ANALYSIS

This violation of 2 U.S.C. §441b involves contributions/expenditures totalling \$490.00 over a two year period. The expenditures were primarily for the purchase of political ads. In response to the letter of notification, Harold Cohn, President of the respondent bank indicated that the bank did not believe the contributions/expenditures for ads were in violation of the Act. (Attachment A). Mr. Cohn indicated that Comptroller rulings on campaign contributions by national banks in 1974 and 1976 failed to make the Act clear. 1/ In fact, the 1976 circular to which Mr. Cohn seems to make reference makes no reference to the purchase of political ads by national banks. (Attachment B).

1/ The Office of the Comptroller and this office are currently preparing a public notice to all national banks making them aware of the prohibitions contained in §441b.

Mr. Cohn has also indicated that the bank was made whole for the contributions/expenditures by its directors and that steps have been taken to preclude any further activity of this type. Although only reimbursement by the recipients would constitute proper compliance, in light of the fact that the bank appeared uninformed that \$441b covers the purchase of political ads and that the bank officers have made restitution of the \$490, the General Counsel recommends that the Commission take no further action and close the file.

RECOMMENDATION

1. Take no further action against the First National Bank of Lincolnwood, Illinois.
2. Close the file.
3. Send the attached letter.

TO: Presidents of All National Banks

SUBJECT: Campaign Contributions by National Banks

On May 11, 1976, the Congress enacted P.L. 94-283 which included Amendments to the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 as amended.<sup>1/</sup> The amendments continue to declare it unlawful for a national bank to make a contribution or expenditure in connection with any election to any political office or in connection with any primary election or political convention or caucus held to select candidates for any political office. This prohibition on national banks applies equally to Federal, State or local elections.<sup>2/</sup> The term "contribution" excludes a bona fide loan of money by a national bank made in accordance with applicable banking laws and regulations and in the ordinary course of business.<sup>3/</sup>

The Federal Election Commission is given exclusive primary jurisdiction with respect to civil enforcement of the Act.<sup>4/</sup>

The new statute likewise gives exclusive authority to the Commission to provide advisory and binding opinions as to



violations of the Campaign Act.<sup>5/</sup> This provision insulates any person who seeks and obtains an advisory opinion from the Commission from being subject to any sanction provided by the Act so long as the requesting party's behavior conforms to the Commission's conclusions. Requests for advisory opinions must originate in writing with one of the following:

1. any individual holding Federal Office;
2. any candidate for Federal Office;
3. any political committee; or
4. the national committee of any political party.

Where an advisory opinion has not been sought and the Act may have been violated, there are provisions by which the Commission will attempt to correct the violations of the Act. This Circular is being issued to alert the national banks to the changes in the law and the availability of the Commission for advisory opinion.<sup>6/</sup> All inquiries regarding political contributions should be directed to the Federal Election Commission by an authorized individual or entity in compliance with the provisions of the new Act.



SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS

BACKGROUND

As a result of information discovered during the course of a recent examination of the First National Bank of Lincolnwood, Illinois, the Senior Deputy Comptroller for Bank Supervision referred this matter to the Commission alleging possible violations of the Act.

FACTS

The respondent bank made thirteen contributions to various local Democratic organizations in Illinois between July, 1976 and July, 1978 totalling \$490.00. Specifically, expenditures were made for the purchase of advertising space in local political "ad books".

ANALYSIS

Under 2 U.S.C. §441b of our Act, national banks are prohibited from making any "contribution or expenditure" in connection with any election to any political office. 2 U.S.C. §441b(b)(2) provides that:

". . . [T]he term 'contribution or expenditure' shall include any direct or indirect payment, distribution, loan, advance, deposit, or gift of money. . . or anything of value . . . to any candidate, campaign committee, or political committee or organization in connection with any election. . . ."

It appears that the expenditures by the First National Bank of Lincolnwood constitute a "contribution or expenditure" in connection with an election and therefore is in violation of 2 U.S.C. §441b of our Act.

RECOMMENDATION

1. Find reason to believe that the First National Bank of Lincolnwood, Illinois violated 2 U.S.C. §441b of our Act.
2. Send the appropriate letter.

Dear Mr. Oldaker:

During the course of the most recent examination of the First National Bank, Lincolnwood, Illinois, commencing September 17, 1978, by the Comptroller's Regional Office in Chicago, several possible violations of 2 U.S.C. 441b were revealed. Specifically, thirteen political contributions made between July 30, 1976 and July 24, 1978 to various Democratic Organizations were disclosed, in the aggregate amount of \$490. All these funds were apparently extended for the purchase of advertisements in local "ad books."

In light of the Federal Election Commission's jurisdiction over potential violations of 2 U.S.C. 441b, we believe that this information should be referred to you for your independent investigation and review. If we can be of any further assistance please contact the Enforcement and Compliance Division of the Office of the Comptroller of the Currency at 447-1983.



I. Summary

During the course of the most recent examination of referenced Bank, commencing September 17, 1978, several possible violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (2 U.S.C. §413, et seq.), were revealed. Possible contributions to political committees were reflected in the advertising expense records of the Bank, as follows:

II. Evidence

For your reference, we are enclosing copies of all of the expense checks involved, as well as several receipts issued by the respective political organization. In addition, we also enclose a copy of the advertising expense ledger for the three years in question. As the receipts and expense checks indicate, it appears that all of these funds were extended for the purchase of advertisements in local "ad books." We enclose a copy of a typical example of such an advertisement which appeared in an "ad book" entitled "Niles Township Regular Democratic Organization, Annual Dinner Dance, November 19, 1977."

III. Analysis

It would appear that these payments to the organizations listed above constitute "contributions" as defined in the Act. See 2 U.S.C. §431(e). Accordingly, it would appear that the Bank has violated the provisions of Section 441b(a), prohibiting contributions by national banks to political candidates and organizations.

We refer these matters to your attention for the action you deem appropriate.





BACKGROUND

As a result of information discovered during the course of a recent examination of the First National Bank of Lincolnwood, Illinois, the Senior Deputy Comptroller for Bank Supervision referred this matter to the Commission alleging possible violations of the Act.

FACTS

The prospective respondent bank made thirteen contributions to various local Democratic organizations in Illinois between July, 1976 and July, 1978 totalling \$490.00. Specifically, expenditures were made for the purchase of advertising space in local political "ad books".

ANALYSIS

Under 2 U.S.C. §441b of our Act, national banks are prohibited from making any "contribution or expenditure" in connection with any election to any political office. 2 U.S.C. §441b(b)(2) provides that:

". . . [T]he term 'contribution or expenditure' shall include any direct or indirect payment, distribution, loan, advance, deposit, or gift of money. . . or anything of value . . . to any candidate, campaign committee, or political committee or organization in connection with any election . . . "

It appears that the expenditures by the First National Bank of Lincolnwood constitute a "contribution or expenditure" in

connection with an election and therefore is in violation of

During the course of the most recent examination of the First National Bank, Lincolnwood, Illinois, commencing September 17, 1978, by the Comptroller's Regional Office in Chicago, several possible violations of 2 U.S.C. 441b were revealed. Specifically, thirteen political contributions made between July 30, 1976 and July 24, 1978 to various Democratic Organizations were disclosed, in the aggregate amount of \$490. All these funds were apparently extended for the purchase of advertisements in local "ad books."

In light of the Federal Election Commission's jurisdiction over potential violations of 2 U.S.C. 441b, we believe that this information should be referred to you for your independent investigation and review. If we can be of any further assistance please contact the Enforcement and Compliance Division of the Office of the Comptroller of the Currency at 447-1983.



## I. Summary

During the course of the most recent examination of referenced Bank, commencing September 17, 1978, several possible violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (2 U.S.C. §413, et seq.), were revealed. Possible contributions to political committees were reflected in the advertising expense records of the Bank, as follows:

II. Evidence

For your reference, we are enclosing copies of all of the expense checks involved, as well as several receipts issued by the respective political organization. In addition, we also enclose a copy of the advertising expense ledger for the three years in question. As the receipts and expense checks indicate, it appears that all of these funds were extended for the purchase of advertisements in local "ad books." We enclose a copy of a typical example of such an advertisement which appeared in an "ad book" entitled "Niles Township Regular Democratic Organization, Annual Dinner Dance, November 19, 1977."

III. Analysis

It would appear that these payments to the organizations listed above constitute "contributions" as defined in the Act. See 2 U.S.C. §431(e). Accordingly, it would appear that the Bank has violated the provisions of Section 441b(a), prohibiting contributions by national banks to political candidates and organizations.

We refer these matters to your attention for the action you deem appropriate.

Dear Mr. Oldaker:

During the course of the most recent examination of the First National Bank, Lincolnwood, Illinois, commencing September 17, 1978, by the Comptroller's Regional Office in Chicago, several possible violations of 2 U.S.C. 441b were revealed. Specifically, thirteen political contributions made between July 30, 1976 and July 24, 1978 to various Democratic Organizations were disclosed, in the aggregate amount of \$490. All these funds were apparently extended for the purchase of advertisements in local "ad books."

In light of the Federal Election Commission's jurisdiction over potential violations of 2 U.S.C. 441b, we believe that this information should be referred to you for your independent investigation and review. If we can be of any further assistance please contact the Enforcement and Compliance Division of the Office of the Comptroller of the Currency at 447-1983.



## I. Summary

During the course of the most recent examination of referenced Bank, commencing September 17, 1978, several possible violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (2 U.S.C. §413, et seq.), were revealed. Possible contributions to political committees were reflected in the advertising expense records of the Bank, as follows:

II. Evidence

For your reference, we are enclosing copies of all of the expense checks involved, as well as several receipts issued by the respective political organization. In addition, we also enclose a copy of the advertising expense ledger for the three years in question. As the receipts and expense checks indicate, it appears that all of these funds were expended for the purchase of advertisements in local "ad books." We enclose a copy of a typical example of such an advertisement which appeared in an "ad book" entitled "Niles Township Regular Democratic Organization, Annual Dinner Dance, November 19, 1977."

III. Analysis

It would appear that these payments to the organizations listed above constitute "contributions" as defined in the Act. See 2 U.S.C. §431(e). Accordingly, it would appear that the Bank has violated the provisions of Section 441b(a), prohibiting contributions by national banks to political candidates and organizations.

We refer these matters to your attention for the action you deem appropriate.






