

GENERATION OF MATTER

On October 10, 1979, the National Rifle Association of America (the Association) was referred to the Office of General Counsel by the Reports Analysis Division (RAD) for failure to file timely reports in violation of 2 U.S.C. §434(a).

EVIDENCE

On March 1, 1979, two monthly reports of communication costs were filed by the Association which covered October and November of 1978.<sup>1/</sup> As indicated in these reports, the Association spent \$148,701.04 in October and \$50,810.72 in November.

In his cover letter attached to these reports, Mr. Daniel Miller of the Association's General Counsel's office, stated that it took two months to assemble computer costs, printing expenses, etc. and another two months to put the reports together.

ANALYSIS

2 U.S.C. §431(f)(4)(C) requires the reporting of costs incurred by a membership organization or corporation for a communication which expressly advocates a clearly identified candidate, if those costs exceed \$2,000 per election.

<sup>1/</sup> It should be noted that instead of these reports, the Association was required to file pre and post general election reports which were due October 28 and December 7, 1978, respectively.

11 C.F.R. §100.7(b)(5)(vii) requires these costs to be reported in accordance with the filing dates provided for in §104.4 which requires the filing of a pre-election report no later than the tenth day before the election and a post-election report no later than the thirtieth day after the election. (See 2 U.S.C. §434(a)(1)(A)).

As these two monthly reports cover the periods which would have been covered in the pre and post general election reports, these reports should be considered as such. However, due to the fact that the reports filed were considerably late, the Office of General Counsel recommends the Commission find reason to believe the Association violated 2 U.S.C. §434(a)(1)(A).

RECOMMENDATION

1. Find reason to believe the Association violated 2 U.S.C. §434(a)(1)(A).
2. Send the attached letter.

The attached forty-five pages represent the October and November 1978 reports of communication costs by the National Rifle Association of America to its members.

The Association sent letter ratings of all federal candidates to each member in mid-October. Because NRA membership figures in each state vary widely, and because the number of rated candidates ranged from 73 in California to one in Vermont, the per candidate costs range from \$75.41 to \$2423.99.

In 1976 the Association was the only membership association to comply with the cost reporting requirement of the FECA. We may well be in the same position for 1978. Because of our recognition of a duty to accurately and fully report, our association spent two months assembling computer costs, printing expenses, postage, mailing room costs, actual number of rating-sheets mailed and the number of candidates rated. Regarding the entry of a payment for a "Connally Dinner" to Mrs. Hugh L. O'Neill, that \$500 contribution should have been allocated evenly among the following three candidates: John Warner, Senate-Virginia; Jack Herrity, VA-8; and Frank Wolf, VA-10. This amounts to a contribution of \$166.66 to each candidate. Please consider this to be an amendment to the Pre-General report.

### 30 Day Post-General Report

Regarding the 30 Day Post-General Report, you suggest that our descriptions of certain Schedule B, Line 20a expenses was inadequate. The expenses are three payments to the Swift Mailing House. These expenses represent the payment by the NRA Political Victory Fund of costs of "communications to members" under Section 431 (f)(4)(c), which permits membership organizations to communicate with members using corporate funds so long as they are reported when a \$2,000 threshold is exceeded. Although these mailing costs could have been borne by the National Rifle Association of America, they were paid by the NRA-PVF. These payments are not "expenditures" within the meaning of Section 431 (f) but should be reported as "Operating Expenditures - Itemized" as shown on Line 20a. No amendment to the report is necessary.

The 30 Day Post-General Report should be amended to clarify Line 22c of Schedule B. The previously combined amounts for postage, data processing, and a letter advocating the election of R. Boschwitz, A. Quie, and H. Knutson should more properly reflect expenditures on behalf of the federal candidate

only, Rudy Boschwitz. One third of each expenditure was devoted to his campaign. Therefore, the following changes in page 1 of 1, Schedule B, Line 22c should be made:

These Boschwitz expenditures were reported as in-kind contributions, out of an abundance of caution, because NRA employees had some contact with the staff of the Boschwitz campaign, prior to the election.

Year End Report

Further explanation of certain Year End Report Schedule B, Line 20a, expenditures was also requested. The Western Union bill for mailgrams was paid by the NRA-PVF although it was for "communications to members" within the meaning of Section 431(f)(4)(c). A full report of these mailgrams was made on FEC Form 7 filed by the National Rifle Association of America in its November 1978 report. These expenses should be considered operating expenses as should all other expenses on those two pages representing line 20a expenses. The total is properly reported on the summary page under Operating Expenses. The Becker Research Corporation telephone poll of voters in the Massachusetts-5th District constituted an operating expense of our committee. The results

were not released to any other committee and therefore need not be reported as a contribution or expenditure or apportioned. No amendment of our report is necessary in these cases.

The expenses were never debts. They represent payment, in the regular course of business of bills received for services performed or goods supplied and the payment date depended on when the bill was rendered. The goods or services were supplied before the election in late October or early November. Billing reaching us in late November, and payment was made on December 1 and December 4. Obviously, some time may pass before a bill is rendered for payment. The NRA Institute for Legislative Action, like any other supplier of goods and services, bills PVF in the regular course of business.

The Year End Report needs clarification concerning line 22c expenditures in the same manner as the 30 Day Post-General Report.

March 1979 Report

You have requested clarification of our March 1979 Monthly Report, particularly of two checks to the NRA Institute for Legislative Action.

The first check, drawn February 16, 1979, for "Communications to members advocating election or defeat of various candidates in 1978 gen elections" was a payment to the NRA-ILA for computer services rendered immediately before the November, 1978, election but billed in February, 1979. This payment was not a contribution (in-kind or independent) under the Act but an operating expense paid in the regular course of business.

The February 15, 1979, check to the NRA Institute for Legislative Action for "Labels for comm. advocating elect. of R. Boschwitz, A. Quie, and H. Knutson Minn." should have been reported as an in-kind contribution to Boschwitz and the remainder of the cost as an operating expense.

The Schedule B, Line 22c expenditure for lables paying the NRA Institute for Legislative Action should be amended as follows:

Although the NRA-PVF did not agree in advance to pay for the direct mailing or advertisements conceived by these groups, when we were asked for financial assistance, we chose to pay the cost of those expenses. Our analysis of the Act led to the conclusion that they should be reported as independent expenditures, with a listing of the candidates supported by these groups. This method of reporting constituted, in our view, the most complete form of disclosure.

There was never a debt outstanding and no amendment is needed.

Year End Report Amendment

Regarding the amendment to our Year End Report, you have asked for a clarification of Schedule E, Line 23 entries.

These entries concern independent expenditures opposing Abner Mikva (IL-10) and John Buckley (MA-5) and supporting Jack Herrity (VA-8). As we explained in our May 31 letter amending our Year End Report,

Documents supporting these expenditures and the particulars thereof did not reach this office until after the report of November expenditures was filed December 7, 1978, in our Post Election Report. Our accountant, Mr. William LeStrange, advises us that prior to preparing the Year End Report he received advice by telephone from the Commission that these expenditures could be reported in the Year End Report, rather than amending the Post Election Report . . ."

These items did not represent debts.

March Monthly Report Amendment

Please consider the above discussion of "debts" to also cover the first question regarding our March monthly amendment. The February expenditures questioned and further explained in our May 31 amendment were for payment of pre-election expenditures not billed until late January or early February. The payments to the NRA Institute for Legislative Action were in payment of expenses incurred by NRA employees disseminating communications urging the defeat or election of certain candidates.
