



I. Background

A computer run of individual contributions to the Robert E. Short campaign (MN/S), appeared to indicate that Deil O. Gustafson and Michael Ryan exceeded the contribution limitations of 2 U.S.C. §441a when combining their contributions made directly to the Short for Senate Committee of Volunteers ("SSCV"-Short's principal campaign committee) with contributions made to the Just a Bunch of Plain DFL Folks Who Want Common Sense Government Committee ("JAB"-an unauthorized single candidate committee supporting Short's candidacy).

An investigation of this matter was conducted and based upon information submitted by the respondents, the General Counsel's briefs recommending no probable cause to believe violations of §441a had been committed were mailed to the respondents on April 21, 1980.



GENERAL COUNSEL'S BRIEF

I. Statement of Case

A computer run of individual contributions to the Robert E. Short campaign (MN/S), indicates that Deil O. Gustafson and Michael Ryan have exceeded the contribution limitations of 2 U.S.C. § 441a when combining their contributions made directly to the Short for Senate Committee of Volunteers ("SSCV"-Short's principal campaign committee) with contributions made to the Just a Bunch of Plain DFL Folks Who Want Common Sense Government Committee ("JAB"-an unauthorized, single candidate committee supporting Short's candidacy).

A review of the Commission's G Index and financial reports for 1978 filed by SSCV and JAB indicate that (a) Gustafson contributed \$1,000 on October 18th to SSCV-general election, \$1,000 on October 27th to SSCV-primary election, and \$1,000 to JAB on November 1st-general election, and (b) Ryan contributed \$1,000 on October 18th to SSCV-general election and \$1,000 on October 30th to JAB-general election.

Therefore, when combining their contributions to SSCV and JAB, both Gustafson and Ryan appeared to have exceeded the contribution limitation of § 441a and the Commission on January 9, 1980, approved the General Counsel's recommendation to find reason to believe that such a violation had been committed.

## II. Legal Analysis

As set forth in 2 U.S.C. § 441a, an individual may contribute \$1,000 per election to a federal candidate. Contributions, made either directly or indirectly on behalf of a particular candidate, are considered contributions to that candidate. 2 U.S.C. § 441a (a)(8). The Joint Explanatory Statement of the Committee of Conference, in explaining the provisions of § 441a, stated, "The Conferees also agree that the same limitations on contributions that apply to candidates shall also apply to committees making expenditures solely on behalf of such candidate." (Conf. Rpt. No. 94-1057, p.58, April 28, 1976).

Mr. Ryan, in response to the Commission's reason to believe notification, stated that his first contribution of \$1,000 on October 18th should have been attributed to the primary election account of SSCV. Mr. Ryan has provided this office with a copy of his correspondence to SSCV advising them of the apparent reporting error.

Based on the information submitted by Ryan, there is no evidence to indicate that a violation of § 441a has been committed. Therefore, it is recommended that the Commission find no probable cause to believe that such a violation has been committed by Mr. Ryan.

Mr. Gustafson, in his response to the Commission's reason to believe notification, filed an affidavit, through counsel, stating

that at the time he made the contribution to JAB, he was told that the Committee was a multicandidate committee supporting DFL candidates in the general election, and was not a single candidate committee supporting only Mr. Short's candidacy. Additionally, Gustafson was told by Frank Ryan, a member, but not an officer of JAB, that if Gustafson made the solicited contribution, it would be legal under the Act. According to Gustafson, not only was he told that JAB was a multicandidate committee, but the name of the committee did not indicate that it was a single candidate committee and the party soliciting the contribution was not the same individual who solicited his contribution to SSCV. 1/

Since JAB's statement of Organization on file with the Commission indicates that it is a political committee supporting more than one federal candidate and conforms with what he was told, Gustafson justifiably contributed to JAB with the intention of his contribution being used to support DFL candidates in general and apparently had no knowledge that JAB was a single candidate committee supporting only candidate Short. Therefore, it is recommended that the Commission find no probable cause to believe that Mr. Gustafson violated 2 U.S.C. § 441a.

1/ The criteria set forth in 11 CFR 110.1(h), which pertain making contributions directly to a candidate and also to a political committee supporting that same candidate, are applicable here. In light of the fact that JAB is registered with the Commission as a political committee which supports more than one federal candidate, the contributor did not have access to information indicating that JAB was acting as a single candidate committee. Thus, the standards in 110.1(h)(1), (2), and (3) have been met.

III. General Counsel's Recommendations

1. Find no probable cause to believe that Michael Ryan violated 2 U.S.C. § 441a.

2. Find no probable cause to believe that Deil O. Gustafson violated 2 U.S.C. § 441a.

On January 9, 1980, the Commission found reason to believe that Deil O. Gustafson and Michael Ryan may have violated 2 U.S.C. § 441a when combining their contributions to the Short for Senate Committee of Volunteers ("SSCV" -- Robert Short's principal campaign committee) and the Just A Bunch of Plain DFL Folks Who Want Common Sense Government Committee ("JAB" -- an unauthorized single candidate committee acting on behalf of Robert Short's Senate candidacy). The respondents were notified of the Commission's determination on January 15, 1980.


Mr. Ryan responded by stating that his contribution to SSCV was mistakenly attributed to the general election when it was earmarked for the purpose of liquidating primary debts from Short's campaign. This office has advised Mr. Ryan that he should submit a written statement to SSCV indicating that his contribution was incorrectly attributed to the general election. Mr. Ryan will forward a copy of his letter to SSCV to this office.

Mr. Gustafson responded to the Commission's finding by stating that he contributed to JAB after he had already contributed his maximum to SSCV because he was told by a JAB representative that JAB was a multicandidate committee and that it would be permissible for him to make an additional contribution.



as follows:

1. That he received a letter dated January 15, 1980 from Mr. Charles N. Steele of the Federal Election Commission in which Mr. Steele requested his response to an allegation that he may have violated Section 441a of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, by contributing \$1,000 on October 18, 1978 to the Short for Senate Committee Volunteers and contributing \$1,000 on November 1, 1978 to Just a Bunch of Plain DFL Folks Who Want Common Sense Government Committee.

2. That it is his understanding that the basis of the alleged violation is that the Just a Bunch of Plain DFL Folks Who Want Common Sense Government Committee was in fact an unauthorized single candidate committee, and that therefore the \$1,000 contribution to that committee caused him to exceed his contribution limits by \$1,000.

3. 





GENERATION OF MATTER

A computer run of individual contributors to the Robert E. Short campaign (MN/S), indicates that two individuals may have exceeded the contribution limitations of 2 U.S.C. § 441a when combining their contributions made directly to the Short for Senate Committee of Volunteers ("SSCV" - Short's principal campaign committee) with contributions made to the Just a Bunch of Plain DFL Folks Who Want Common Sense Government Committee ("JAB" - an unauthorized, single candidate committee supporting Short's candidacy). Attachment 1.

LEGAL ANALYSIS.

As set forth in 2 U.S.C. § 441a, an individual may contribute \$1,000 per election to a federal candidate. Contributions, made either directly or indirectly on behalf of a particular candidate, are considered contributions to that candidate. 2 U.S.C. § 441a(a)(8). The Joint Explanatory Statement of the Committee of Conference, in explaining the provisions of § 441a, stated, "The conferees also agree that the same limitations on contributions that apply to candidates shall also apply to committees making expenditures solely on behalf of such candidate." (Conf. Rept. No. 94-105 M, p.58, April 28, 1976).

The Commission, in Re: AOR 1976-20, made its position clear regarding the contribution limitations in § 441a. The opinion states that an individual may "contribute \$1,000 per election to an unauthorized single candidate committee that makes independent expenditures on behalf of the candidate" provided that the individual has not also contributed directly to the candidate or his authorized committees. (11 C.F.R. § 110.1(h)).

A review of the Commission's G Index and financial reports filed by SSCV and JAB indicate that (a) Deil O. Gustafson contributed \$1,000 to SSCV and \$1,000 to JAB on October 18th and November 1, 1978, respectively and (b) Michael Ryan contributed \$1,000 to SSCV and \$1,000 to JAB on October 18th and 30, 1978, respectively. Each of the above-listed contributions are attributed by the recipients as being contributed to the general election. Therefore, it appears that when combining their contributions to SSCV and JAB, both Gustafson and Ryan have exceeded the contribution limitation of § 441a by \$1,000 each. 1/

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the Commission:

1. find reason to believe that Deil O. Gustafson may have violated 2 U.S.C. § 441a;
2. find reason to believe that Michael Ryan may have violated 2 U.S.C. § 441a; and
3. send attached notification letters.

1/ Since JAB was not an authorized committee of candidate Short, it was not required to file reports with Short's PCC pursuant to § 434(a)(2). Therefore, neither JAB nor SSCV were in a position to know whether its contributors had reached their contribution limit.

GENERATION OF MATTER

A computer run of individual contributors to the Robert E. Short campaign (MN/S), indicates that two individuals may have exceeded the contribution limitations of 2 U.S.C. § 441a when combining their contributions made directly to the Short for Senate Committee of Volunteers ("SSCV" - Short's principal campaign committee) with contributions made to the Just a Bunch of Plain DFL Folks Who Want Common Sense Government Committee ("JAB" - an unauthorized, single candidate committee supporting Short's candidacy). Attachment I.

LEGAL ANALYSIS

As set forth in 2 U.S.C. § 441a, an individual may contribute \$1,000 per election to a federal candidate. Contributions, made either directly or indirectly on behalf of a particular candidate, are considered contributions to that candidate. 2 U.S.C. § 441a(a)(8). The Joint Explanatory Statement of the Committee of Conference, in explaining the provisions of § 441a, stated, "The conferees also agree that the same limitations on contributions that apply to candidates shall also apply to committees making expenditures solely on behalf of such candidate." (Conf. Rept. No. 94-105 M, p.58, April 28, 1976).

The Commission, in Re: AOR 1976-20, made its position clear regarding the contribution limitations in § 441a. The opinion states that an individual may "contribute \$1,000 per election to an unauthorized single candidate committee that makes independent expenditures on behalf of the candidate" provided that the individual has not also contributed directly to the candidate or his authorized committees. (11 C.F.R. § 110.1(h)).

A review of the Commission's G Index and financial reports filed by SSCV and JAB indicate that (a) Deil O. Gustafson contributed \$1,000 to SSCV and \$1,000 to JAB on October 18th and November 1, 1978, respectively and (b) Michael Ryan contributed \$1,000 to SSCV and \$1,000 to JAB on October 18th and 30, 1978, respectively. Each of the above-listed contributions are attributed by the recipients as being contributed to the general election. Therefore, it appears that when combining their contributions to SSCV and JAB, both Gustafson and Ryan have exceeded the contribution limitation of § 441a by \$1,000 each. 1/

RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the Commission:

1. find reason to believe that Deil O. Gustafson may have violated 2 U.S.C. § 441a;
2. find reason to believe that Michael Ryan may have violated 2 U.S.C. § 441a; and
3. send attached notification letters.

1/ Since JAB was not an authorized committee of candidate Short, it was not required to file reports with Short's PCC pursuant to § 434(a)(2). Therefore, neither JAB nor SSCV were in a position to know whether its contributors had reached their contribution limit.





Based on information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities, the Federal Election Commission has found reason to believe that you may have violated section 441a of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). This section of the Act makes it unlawful for an individual to contribute in excess of \$1,000 per candidate per election. Specifically, Commission records indicate that you contributed \$1,000 to the Short for Senate Committee of Volunteers (SSCV) and \$1,000 to the Just a Bunch of Plain DFL Folks Who Want Common Sense Government Committee (JAB) on October 18 and November 1, 1978, respectively. Both contributions were attributed by the recipient committee as general election contributions.

Since the contribution limitations contained in § 441a also apply to unauthorized, single candidate committees, it appears that you have exceeded your contribution limitation by \$1,000.

We have numbered this matter MUR 1052. Please refer to this number in all future correspondence.

Under the Act, you have an opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against you. Please submit any factual or legal materials which you believe are relevant to the Commission's analysis of this matter. Where appropriate, statements should be submitted under oath.

The Commission is under a duty to investigate this matter expeditiously. Therefore, your response should be submitted within ten days after your receipt of this notification. If no response is received, the Commission may take further action based on the information at hand.
