

SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS

The complainant alleges that a postcard he received in the mail, which advocated the election of Governor Julian Carroll for U.S. Senator and stated that it was "Paid For By An Interested Kentucky Citizen", failed to contain sufficient information under federal law.

Furthermore, Mr. Perry alleges that since the back of the postcard was printed "some printer ... has information concerning this"; and that the postmark on the card is stamped Bowling Green, Kentucky, October 31, pm, 1979 (sic).

RECOMMENDATION

Since the complainant makes an allegation against an unknown respondent and provides no information on which to base an investigation, the Office of the General Counsel recommends that no action be taken in this matter, that the file be closed, and to send the attached letter.


Re: Official Complaint

I do hereby file a formal complaint of the appropriate Federal legislation, and state in support of my complaint that I am not a candidate or filing this complaint at the direction of any candidate or any organization supporting any candidate. I received by United States Mail, November 2, 1979, the enclosed post card. The post card purports to be in support of the candidacy for Julian Carroll, Governor of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, for position of United States Senator now held by the Honorable Wendel Ford. By way of a disclosure statement, the post card, as a bottom line, contains the information that it is "paid for by an interested Kentucky citizen." I do not believe this to be sufficient under Federal law.

It is obvious that the post card was prepared by some individual of low mentality since the name of Governor Carroll is misspelled on the back, and since the name of my street, a very common name, is misspelled on the front. The address on the front is handwritten, and this is a standard U.S.P.S. postal card, but the information on the back was printed. Obviously there is some printer who has information concerning this. The back of the card carries a post mark, or meter cancellation, showing Bowling Green, Kentucky, October 31, p.m., 1979. The meter cancellation also contains an additional logo of "Give the United Way".

I do hereby solemnly state and swear that the statements contained herein are true to the best of my knowledge and belief on this day.
