

SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS

Complainant alleges that Mr. Haddock, the treasurer of Local 745 D.R.I.V.E. (the separate segregated fund of the labor organization), violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, by using \$328.54 in D.R.I.V.E. funds to make repairs on his personal pick-up truck.<sup>1/</sup>

PRELIMINARY LEGAL ANALYSIS

Although the Act extensively regulates the operations of separate segregated funds of labor organizations and corporations, 2 U.S.C. §441b(b), there is no provision in the Act which would prohibit the activity complained against. Therefore, even if proven to be true, complainant's allegation does not state a violation of the Act.

RECOMMENDATION

1. Find no reason to believe a violation of the Act occurred.
2. Close the file.
3. Send attached letters.

I, charge Mr. Haddock has violated the FEC laws, and purposely used the members funds to enrich himself from the contributions of the Rank-and- File members. It has a tendency to deceive, cheat, and erode the very thought of honesty when it come to the average member in local 745..

I request that you look into this matter and investigate it. I futher request that I to be informed as to what action you take in thas matter, if any, and to the results of the investigation. I also state that I will take this to the Federal Court if some action is not taken by the FEC..

As you know I filed a complaint before on another matter with the Fec, and it looks like you traed to sweep it under the rug. It is now before a Federal Judge in Washington.
