



GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

I. Statement of the Facts

A review by the Reports Analysis Division of the Federal Election Commission ("the Commission") of the 1977 year-end reports and the April quarterly reports of 1978 (Attachment A) filed by The Friends of Dan Rupli ^{1/} ("the Committee") disclosed the receipt of contributions from various labor organizations in the amount of \$463.00

On August 22, 1978, and on May 18, 1979, the Commission found reason to believe that the Committee violated 2 U.S.C. § 441b(a) and so notified the Committee of the Commission's findings. (Attachment B). ^{2/} The Committee responded to the Commission's reason to believe letter of August 22, 1978, on September 3, 1978 (Attachment C) and returned many of the contributions prior to the Democratic primary (Attachment D).

Upon review of the file, it appeared that the Committee was under the impression that it had answered the Commission's first reason to believe notification (Attachments C and E), and

^{1/} The Friends of Dan Rupli was the principal campaign committee of Dan Rupli, an unsuccessful candidate for Congress from Maryland's Sixth District. The primary was in September of 1978.

^{2/} The first reason to believe finding was for those contributions listed on the year-end reports for 1979. The second reason to believe finding was for those contributions listed on the April quarterly reports of 1978.

that it need not take further action. In an effort to clarify this situation, attempts were made to contact the treasurer of the Committee, Anne H. Engler. After these attempts proved to be unsuccessful, Mr. Rupli was contacted. He stated that he was under the impression this matter had been settled. When informed that this was not true, he asked if we could send to him a copy of the contributions not returned and other pertinent documents. This was done by letter dated February 4, 1980.

Mr. Rupli stated in his letter of February 11, 1980 (Attachment F), that his Committee has outstanding legal judgments against it in the amount of \$9,400.00, but, despite this, he would like to resolve this issue by returning, even from his own personal funds, all the union contributions his committee received. Subsequent to this request, Mr. Rupli mailed to all the unions in question personal checks to refund the contributions. All the checks were cashed and then returned through the normal banking channels except for one that has not been cashed or returned. (Attachment G) Mr. Rupli alleges that he has attempted to locate this check and to determine whether the recipient received it and, if so, whether the recipient intends to cash the check. (Attachment H).

II. Legal Analysis

2 U.S.C. § 441b(a) holds:

It is unlawful for ... any ... labor organization to make a contribution or expenditure in connection with any election at which ... (a) Representative [is] to be voted for, or in connection with any

primary election ... or for any candidate, political committee, or other person knowingly to accept or receive any contribution prohibited by this section.


According to its own year-end report for 1977 and its quarterly April report for 1978, the committee accepted contributions in October of 1977 and March of 1978 from the Communications Workers of America, Local 400 of the Retail Store Employees, and Local 11874 of the Textile Workers Union of America. These contributions were made by these unions to support Mr. Rupli's efforts to gain the Democratic nomination for Congress from the Sixth Congressional District of Maryland.

Inasmuch as the committee accepted these contributions, it violated 2 U.S.C. § 441b(a). It must be said, however, in mitigation of the respondent's violation, that Mr. Rupli has returned or made every reasonable effort to return all the union contributions in question. Moreover, the \$473.00 received represents about one percent of the contributions received by the committee. Therefore, the Office of General Counsel recommends that the Commission take no further action in this matter.

III. Recommendations

1. Take no further action.
2. Close the file.
3. Send attached letter.



Dear Mr. Steele:

This is in response to your letter of February 4, 1980.

I have been unable to reach Ann Englar, who has apparently relocated somewhere here in the area.

As I explained to Attorney William Taylor of your staff, my preference concerning the union contributions would be to simply raise some money and return the funds. The main difficulties in accomplishing this, as I see it, are twofold: (1) There are insufficient funds in the campaign treasury to cover the checks to be returned, and (2) There is an outstanding legal judgement against my committee in the neighborhood of \$7,000.00, and I expect another judgement of \$2,400 to be entered around the first of March.

I have run twice for Congress, and I believe that it would be most difficult to raise sufficient monies to both pay off the judgements and repay the \$450.00 in union contributions.

I sought Mr. Taylor's advice concerning some legal device for returning the union funds. I would be happy to establish a new committee to raise money to pay back the union contributions, thereby avoiding the judgements, or I would be happy to simply pay back the contributions out of my own personal funds through a personal account. I don't believe that your regulations would permit either of these remedies, but I will do anything that you instruct in bringing my committee into compliance with FEC regulations.







This is in response to your letter of February 4, 1980.

I have been unable to reach Ann Englar, who has apparently relocated somewhere here in the area.

As I explained to Attorney William Taylor of your staff, my preference concerning the union contributions would be to simply raise some money and return the funds. The main difficulties in accomplishing this, as I see it, are twofold: (1) There are insufficient funds in the campaign treasury to cover the checks to be returned, and (2) There is an outstanding legal judgement against my committee in the neighborhood of \$7,000.00, and I expect another judgement of \$2,400 to be entered around the first of March.

I have run twice for Congress, and I believe that it would be most difficult to raise sufficient monies to both pay off the judgements and repay the \$450.00 in union contributions.

I sought Mr. Taylor's advice concerning some legal device for returning the union funds. I would be happy to establish a new committee to raise money to pay back the union contributions, thereby avoiding the judgements, or I would be happy to simply pay back the contributions out of my own personal funds through a personal account. I don't believe that your regulations would permit either of these remedies, but I will do anything that you instruct in bringing my committee into compliance with FEC regulations.





SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS

A review by the Reports Analysis Division of the 1977 year-end reports and the April quarterly reports filed by the Friends of Dan Rupli ("the Committee") disclosed the receipt of contributions from various labor organizations in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 441b(a).

FACTUAL AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

On August 22, 1978, the Commission found reason to believe that the Committee violated 2 U.S.C. § 441b(a) and sent a letter to the Committee notifying it of the Commission's finding. The Committee responded to the Commission's reason to believe letter on September 3, 1978, (Attachment A) and returned many of the contributions 1/ it received prior to the Democratic primary. 2/ The matter was referred to the Office of General Counsel by the Reports Analysis Division on January 7, 1980.

1/ Approximately \$450 has not been returned.

2/ Rupli was an unsuccessful candidate for the Democratic nomination for Congress in Maryland's Sixth District. The primary was in September of 1978.

Upon review of the file, it appeared that the Committee was under the impression that it had answered the Commission's reason to believe notification (see letters of September 3, 1978, and March 29, 1979, Attachment A and B) and that it need not take further action. In an effort to clarify this situation, attempts were made to contact the Treasurer of the Committee, Anne H. Englar. After these attempts proved to be unsuccessful, Mr. Rupli was contacted. He stated that he was under the impression this matter had been settled. When informed that this was not true, he asked if we could send a copy of the contributions not returned and other pertinent documents. He added that he would attempt to reach the Treasurer of the Committee, who had moved, and would, if possible, try to resolve this matter.

Today I went over the information with Ms. Englar that had not been supplied or which had been incomplete on previous reports. I explained each item requested on the April 10, then the Year-end 77 report. An amendment had been filed for the year-end but it was incomplete. The committee had received a contribution from the Volunteers in Politics Baltimore Labor Council for \$70 which was not a registered PAC. I asked Ms. Englar to clarify this contribution.

Yesterday I checked with the Non-filer team to see if any reports were outstanding. Shawn Woodhead told me the 30Day Primary, October 10 and Year-end Report Still had not been filed. I advised Ms. Englar of the reports outstanding and asked if she had mailed the reports yet and she said no. I told her it is very important that she gets those reports in right away. She said she had mailed a letter of explanation for the 30Day Primary. I told her the letter would be entered and filed in the folder but it could not be accepted for the reports due. This letter is prompted by the Commission's analysis of disclosure reports undertaken in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities under the Federal Election Campaign Act. During review of the April 10, 1978 Quarterly Report of Receipts and Expenditures, we noticed entries indicating that you may have accepted contributions from labor organizations. Labor organization contributions are prohibited by the Act, unless made from separate segregated funds established by the labor organization. A copy of that portion of your report is attached for your review and clarification.

If you have accepted prohibited contributions, you must return the full amounts to the donors. The return of the contributions should be reported immediately by letter and should be reflected as contribution refunds on your next report of receipts and expenditures. If you find that the sources of these contributions are permissible under the Federal Election Campaign Act, please submit a statement for the public record which would clarify the sources of these contributions and the exact nature of the accounts upon which the checks were drawn. If the sources of these contributions have been reported incompletely or incorrectly, please amend your original report.

Please notify the Commission within fifteen (15) days from the date of this letter of any determination you make on this matter. Enforcement action may be initiated by the Commission for: failure to respond within fifteen (15) days; failure to refund any impermissible contributions; and/or acceptance of labor organization contributions.
