SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS

On March 21, 1983, this Office received a complaint filed by Chadwick R. Gore, Vice President, PAC Researchers, Ltd., alleging that the Virginia Political Report ("the Report"), published by Contemporary Political Consultants, Inc., of Burke, Virginia, had violated 2 U.S.C. § 438(a)(4) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.15 by using individual contributor information itemized in reports filed with the Commission for commercial purposes.

FACTUAL AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

Attached to the complaint was a copy of the January 28, 1983 issue of the Report. (See Attachment 1). This issue contains

political news involving Governor Charles Robb and Senator John Warner (1/2 page), 1982 general election results for northern Virginia (4 1/2 pages), and lists of the names of individual contributors to the campaigns of Frank Wolf and Ira Lechner. The individuals' last names, and first and middle initials are given, as are the amounts contributed; all are listed under the city/town and state where they apparently reside. 1/ No other information (e.g., residential or business address, employer, occupation) is conveyed. A subscription rate of \$100 per year for 10 issues is quoted. At the end of the list of individual contributors is the statement, "The Above Information is from Federal Election Commission Reports and Cannot Be Utilized for Soliciting Political Contributions or any Private Commercial Purpose."

In his response to notification of the complaint, Michael E. Belefski, the publisher of the Report, asserts First Amendment privilege, and argues that "the newsletter is for political information news and that part of the news is that of political contributions." According to Mr. Belefski, the Report has been published since 1979, and includes "various news items of political interest, election returns, book reviews, campaign analysis and political contributors to various state and Federal candidates." 1/ Before identifying individual contributors to the Wolf campaign, The Report states that a "VPR analysis of Friends of Frank Wolf third quarter contributors shows 59.6% come from Fairfax County...."

2 U.S.C. § 438(a)(4) states in part that "any information copied from . . . reports or statements [filed with the Commission] may not be sold or used by any person for the purpose of soliciting contributions or for commercial purposes...." ^{2/} 11 C.F.R. § 104.15(a) generally follows the statutory prohibition, while 11 C.F.R. § 104.5(c) states that the use of information taken from reports, "in newspapers, magazines, books or other similar communications is permissible as long as the principal purpose of such communications is not to communicate any contributor information listed on such reports for the purpose of soliciting contributions or for other commercial purposes."

The language of 2 U.S.C. § 438(a)(4), quoted above, has been a part of the Act since 1971. According to Senator Bellmon, a sponsor of an amendment adding this language, its purpose was to prohibit lists of contributors taken from Commission reports from being used for commercial purposes. He agreed that newspapers could run lists of contributors and amounts, but list brokers could not sell such a list or use it for commercial purposes. 117 Cong. Rec. 30058 (1971). Thus, as was noted in AO 1980-78, "(t)he prevention of list brokering, not the suppression of financial information, is the purpose of 2 U.S.C. § 438(a)(4) and

^{2/} The statutory exception to this prohibition involves the names and addresses of political committees.

11 C.F.R. § 104.15." See also AO 1980-101 and AO 1977-66. 3/
11 C.F.R. § 104.15(c) recognizes the distinction found in the
legislative history between publication for commercial purposes
and communication of political news.

The issue in the present matter is, therefore, whether there
is reason to believe that the Virginia Political Report's
publication of the names of individual contributors, together
with their cities or towns and amounts given, constitutes a
commercial undertaking rather than dissemination of news.

In the present instance, provision of contributor
information is apparently only one part of the Report's service.
In addition, the list of individual contributors in the Report is
followed by the statement that this information cannot be used to
solicit political contributions or for any private commercial
purpose. Although this caveat has no legal significance it would
appear to support the factual claim that the purpose of the
Report is the dissemination of news, not list brokering.

3/ List brokering involves the compilation or purchase of
mailing lists for rental or (re)sale with financial gain, not
dissemination of information, the principal objective.

This Office recommends that the Commission find no reason to believe that the Virginia Political Report/Contemporary Political Consultants, Inc., has violated 2 U.S.C. § 438(a)(4).

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Find no reason to believe that the Virginia Political Report/Contemporary Political Consultants, Inc., has violated 2 U.S.C. § 438(a)(4).
2. Close the file in this matter.
3. Approve attached letters.



Former First Lady Bird Johnson was asked in a recent interview if son-in-law Chuck Robb requested any political advise from her. She said to him that in order to have a successful political career he needed lots of money and warned him that anything you do in politics you're going to get public abuse. Indeed, Governor Robb has come under recent attack by giving his O.K. for Del. Alson H. Smith, Jr. (D-Frederick) to start Virginians for Good Government, Inc. but had forgot to disclose the source of the contributions until recent press reports disclosed that the PAC dispursed campaign and inaugural funds to Democratic candidates and contributed to the out-of-state travel and Christmas greeting expenses of the governor. The "Chuck-PAC" fund came from \$76K for the inaugural, \$57K from surplus campaign funds and \$52K in post-election contributions. Although the fund is technically legal, look for a change in this loophole that allows state candidates to raise and spend post-election income without disclosure and does not require no report from surplus inaugural funds. A "Friends of John Warner '84" committee has been formed with George P. Shafran of Arlington as finance chairman.





Former First Lady Bird Johnson was asked in a recent interview if son-in-law Chuck Robb requested any political advise from her. She said to him that in order to have a successful political career he needed lots of money and warned him that anything you do in politics you're going to get public abuse. Indeed, Governor Robb has come under recent attack by giving his O.K. for Del. Alson H. Smith, Jr. (D-Frederick) to start Virginians for Good Government, Inc. but had forgot to disclose the source of the contributions until recent press reports disclosed that the PAC dispursed campaign and inaugural funds to Democratic candidates and contributed to the out-of-state travel and Christmas greeting expenses of the governor. The "Chuck-PAC" fund came from \$76K for the inaugural, \$57K from surplus campaign funds and \$52K in post-election contributions. Although the fund is technically legal, look for a change in this loophole that allows state candidates to raise and spend post-election income without disclosure and does not require no report from surplus inaugural funds. A "Friends of John Warner '84" committee has been formed with George P. Shafran of Arlington as finance chairman.

NORTHERN VIRGINIA OFFICIAL GENERAL ELECTION RESULTS TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 1982



"2 U.S.C. 438(a)(4) generally allows for inspection and copying of reports and statements filed with the Commission but prohibits the sale or use of such copied information to solicit contributions or for any other commercial purpose with the exception of using the names and addresses of any political action committee to solicit contributions from such committees...."





Former First Lady Bird Johnson was asked in a recent interview if son-in-law Chuck Robb requested any political advise from her. She said to him that in order to have a successful political career he needed lots of money and warned him that anything you do in politics you're going to get public abuse. Indeed, Governor Robb has come under recent attack by giving his O.K. for Del. Alson H. Smith, Jr. (D-Frederick) to start Virginians for Good Government, Inc. but had forgot to disclose the source of the contributions until recent press reports disclosed that the PAC dispursed campaign and inaugural funds to Democratic candidates and contributed to the out-of-state travel and Christmas greeting expenses of the governor. The "Chuck-PAC" fund came from \$76K for the inaugural, \$57K from surplus campaign funds and \$52K in post-election contributions. Although the fund is technically legal, look for a change in this loophole that allows state candidates to raise and spend post-election income without disclosure and does not require no report from surplus inaugural funds. A "Friends of John Warner '84" committee has been formed with George P. Shafran of Arlington as finance chairman.


