The Federal Election Commission notified your clients on May 17, 1984, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). A copy of the complaint was forwarded to your clients at that time. We acknowledge receipt of your clients' explanation of this matter which was dated June 8, 1984.

Upon review of the allegations contained in the complaint and information supplied by your clients, the Commission, on August 14, 1984, determined that there is no reason to believe that Active Ballot Club and its treasurer, Anthony J. Luty, violated 2 U.S.C. § 441a(a)(2)(A), a provision of the Act.

Also, the Commission, on August 14, 1984, determined that there is reason to believe that Active Ballot Club and its treasurer, Anthony J. Luty, violated 11 C.F.R. § 104.14(d) for improper reporting of contributions. However, after considering the circumstances in this matter, the Commission has determined to take no further action and close its file.







GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

I. BACKGROUND

On May 11, 1984, James Edward Antosh, filed a complaint with the Commission alleging that the Active Ballot Club, A Department of United Food & Commercial Workers International Union ("Active Ballot Club") violated 2 U.S.C. § 441a(a)(2)(A) by making excessive contributions to Lechner for Congress during the 1982 general election.

Lechner for Congress is alleged to have violated 2 U.S.C. § 441a(f) by accepting contributions in excess of the limits at 2 U.S.C. § 441a(a)(2)(A) from the Active Ballot Club.

II. LEGAL ANALYSIS

Pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 441a(a)(2)(A), no multicandidate political committee shall make any contribution to any candidate and his authorized political committees with respect to any election for federal office which, in the aggregate, exceeds \$5,000. In addition, pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 441a(f), no candidate or political committee shall knowingly accept any contribution in violation of the \$5,000 aggregate limitation imposed on contributions under this section.

34040471610

11 C.F.R. § 110.1(a) provides that a contribution designated in writing by a contributor for a particular election shall be attributable to that election. Except, that a contribution made after the primary election, shall be allowed only if the recipient committee has outstanding primary debts on the date of the contribution which are equal to or greater than the contribution.

A review of the reports filed with the Federal Election Commission reveals that the following contributions were made to Lechner for Congress:

The Virginia primary election was held on June 8, 1982.

In response to the complaint Active Ballot Club states that the contribution of \$2,628.27 on July 29, 1982, was intended as a contribution to retire primary campaign debts. As contemporaneous evidence the Committee submitted a ledger page from its internal records which indicates that the contribution was intended "FOR PRIMARY DEFICIT."

* Lechner for Congress originally reported this contribution as a contribution for the general election but amended their report in December 1982 to reflect that the contribution was for the primary.

** Pursuant to 11 C.F.R. § 104.5(f) Lechner for Congress reported receipt of the contribution by letter dated October 19, 1982. The contribution appeared on their post-election report as received on November 1, 1982.

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In response to the complaint, Lechner for Congress also submitted Active Ballot Club's ledger sheet as evidence that the contribution was intended for the primary. To further support this, Lechner for Congress points out that the treasurer of the Committee amended the Committee's 1982 October Quarterly report in December of 1982 to report the \$2,628.27 as a contribution for the primary.

Since Lechner for Congress had outstanding debts from the primary election, the Office of General Counsel recommends that the Commission find no reason to believe that Active Ballot Club violated 2 U.S.C. § 441a(a)(2)(A) and find no reason to believe that Lechner for Congress violated 2 U.S.C. § 441a(f).

However, inasmuch as the July 29, 1982, contribution was incorrectly reported by Active Ballot Club, the Office of General Counsel recommends that the Commission find reason to believe that Active Ballot Club violated 11 C.F.R. § 104.14(d), and take no further action.

III. RECOMMENDATION

1. Find no reason to believe that the Active Ballot Club, A Department of United Food & Commercial Workers International Union and its treasurer, Anthony J. Luty, violated 2 U.S.C. § 441a(a)(2)(A).
2. Find no reason to believe that Lechner for Congress and its treasurer, Deena A. Flinchum, violated 2 U.S.C § 441a(f).
3. Find reason to believe that Active Ballot Club, A Department of United Food & Commercial Workers

International Union and its treasurer, Anthony J. Luty, violated 11 C.F.R. § 104.14(d), but take no further action.

4. Send appropriate letters.

I am writing with regard to the complaint filed in MUR 1698 against the Active Ballot Club - a department of the United Food and Commercial Workers International Union. The complaint notes that contributions were made by the Active Ballot Club to candidate Ira M. Lechner which totalled \$7,628.00, \$2,628.00 in excess of the contribution limitation. In fact, a contribution of \$2,628.00, which was sent to the candidate on August 2, 1982, was incorrectly reported to the Federal Election Commission as a contribution to the general election. The internal records of the Union shows that the check was intended as a contribution for the primary deficit of candidate Lechner (see Attachments). We are in the process of filing an amended report with the FEC to correct our earlier mistake in reporting.

Dear Mr. Demougeot:

I am writing concerning the complaint MUR no. 1698, the coversheet of which is enclosed.

Put simply, the \$2,628.²⁷ contribution in question was a contribution to defray the primary debt, as indicated in the enclosed copy of the Check Request dated 7/28/82. The check was drawn on the Active Ballot Club of the UFCW - its "PAC" account.

I had originally mistakenly reported this contribution as being for the general election because, since I did not open the mail myself, I did not see the cover letter. I was later informed that it was a primary contribution.

I had to file an amended report because of an addition error and replaced the entire line 11c section, marking out the general box and marking the primary box for this contribution. I usually replace a whole section if I filed an amended report for any part of the section to make replacing the erroneous pages easier. I am enclosing the 11c section as amended that I have kept in my records.

The preliminary audits of the FEC produced no questions regarding this contribution.

Mr. Lechner turned the enclosed letter of 4/29 from Steven M. Antosh, Executive Director of The Center on National Labor Policy Inc, to me as his treasurer to handle. My answer to him, made

within 5 days of my receiving the letter, is also enclosed, stating that the contribution in question was for the primary.

Based on Complainant's information and belief, Respondents have contributed or received an aggregate in excess of \$5,000.00 (FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS) for the 1982 federal general election in which Ira M. Lechner was a candidate for public office. Complainant bases his belief on a review of the Federal Election Commission Forms 3 and 3X, Schedules "A" and "B" which Ira M. Lechner, Lechner for Congress, and U.F.C.W. - Active Ballot Club filed for the 1982 federal general election.

6. For the 1982 federal general election excessive funds were contributed to Ira M. Lechner, Lechner for Congress and its treasurer by U.F.C.W. - Active Ballot Club and its treasurer.

7. These unlawful contributions constitute a violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act, 2 U.S.C. §441a(a)(2)(A), which provides that a multicandidate political committee may not contribute more than \$5,000.00 (FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS) to any candidate and his authorized political committee with respect to any election for federal office and §441a(f) which prohibits a candidate from receiving illegal contributions.

10. A running total of the amount of contributions received from U.F.C.W. - Active Ballot Club would have put on notice Ira M. Lechner, Lechner for Congress and its treasurer that they had received \$2,628.00 (TWO THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED TWENTY EIGHT DOLLARS) on August 6, 1982. On that date, Ira M. 12. U.F.C.W. - Active Ballot Club contributed the following amounts:

In violation of 2 U.S.C. §441a(a)(2)(A), two \$2,500.00 (TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS) contributions were made to Ira M. Lechner, Lechner for Congress and its treasurer. This amount exceeded the statutory monetary ceiling by \$2,628.00 (TWO THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED TWENTY EIGHT DOLLARS).




