This acknowledges receipt of your letter of June 18, 1976, alleging violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, by the Burroughs Corporation.

As you may be aware, the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, requires that all complaints be signed, sworn, and notarized by the person(s) making the complaint (see 2 U.S.C. Section 437g(a)(2)). Under our new procedures, we also require that a complaint contain: (1) the full name, address and telephone number of the complainant; (2) a clear and concise statement of the facts upon which the assertion of jurisdiction of the Commission is based; (3) a clear and concise statement of the acts which are alleged to constitute a violation of the Federal Election Campaign Laws; (4) copies of any evidence available to you which sustains the allegations of the complaint. In the event you wish to file a complaint, please comply with these requirements within 15 days.
