
Dear Mr. Freidman:

**CONCILIATION AGREEMENT**

This matter was initiated by the Federal Election Commission (hereinafter "the Commission"), pursuant to information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. The Commission found reason to believe that The IUE Political Education Committee and Edward Fire, as treasurer ("Respondents") violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(B) by failing to file the 1984 Pre-General Report in a timely manner.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission and Respondents, having participated in informal methods of conciliation, prior to a finding a probable cause to believe, do hereby agree as follows:

I. The Commission has jurisdiction over the Respondents, and the subject matter of this proceeding, and this agreement has the effect of an agreement entered pursuant to 2 U.S.C.

§ 437g(a)(4)(A)(i).

II. Respondents have had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.

III. Respondents enter voluntarily into this agreement with the Commission.

IV. The pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:

1. Respondent, the IUE Political Education Committee, is an unauthorized political committee.

2. Respondent, Edward Fire, is the treasurer of the IUE Political Education Committee.

3. Respondents were required to file the 1984 Pre-General Election Report with the Commission on October 25, 1984.

4. Respondents did not file the required report until November 23, 1984.

V. Respondents late filing of their 1984 Pre-General Election Report is a violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(B).

VI. Respondents will pay a civil penalty to the Treasurer of the United States in the amount of one hundred and seventy-five dollars (\$175), pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(5)(A).

VII. Respondents agrees that they shall not undertake any activity which is in violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, 2 U.S.C. § 431, et seq.

VIII. The Commission, on request of anyone filing a complaint under 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1) concerning the matters at issue herein or on its own motion, may review compliance with this agreement. If the Commission believes that this agreement or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute a civil action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

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IX. This agreement shall become effective as of the date that all parties hereto have executed same and the Commission has approved the entire agreement.

X. Respondents shall have no more than thirty (30) days from the date this agreement becomes effective to comply with and implement the requirements contained in this agreement and to so notify the Commission.

XI. This Conciliation Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties on the matters raised herein, and no other statement, promise, or agreement, either written or oral, made by either party or by agents of either party, that is not contained in this written agreement shall be valid.

**GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT**

On March 6, 1985 the Commission found reason to believe the IUE Political Education Committee ("the Committee") and Edward Fire, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(B) by failing to file the 1984 Pre-General Report within the Act's proscribed time limitations. Responding to notification, the Respondents submitted a letter arguing that no action be taken against them. On April 10, 1985, Respondents requested pre-probable cause conciliation. The General Counsel's Office recommends the Commission accept the Respondents' request.

**DISCUSSION OF CONCILIATION AND CIVIL PENALTY**

The attached proposed argument contains an admission of the violation, an explanation of circumstances surrounding this violation, and the payment of a \$175 civil penalty. Consistent with the handling of similar matters concerning the late filing of reports, the proposed civil penalty in this matter reflects the following:





Dear Chairman McGarry:

I am writing in reference to your letter dated March 13, 1985, in which you state that on March 6, 1985, the Federal Election Commission determined that there is reason to believe the IUE Political Education Committee and Edward Fire, as treasurer, violated 2. U.S.C. §434(a)(4)(B) of the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended, by the late filing of our 1984 Pre-General Report.

The purpose of this letter is to demonstrate why no action should be taken against the IUE Political Education Committee and Edward Fire, as treasurer. Although there is no factual dispute concerning the failure to file the 1984 Pre-General Report, we believe that there are certain procedural deficiencies and mitigating circumstances that warrant no further action by the Commission.

First, contrary to your own non-filer policy and procedures, as set out in Commission Directive No. 1, April 21, 1983, II A,1(b), we were never previously notified of the due date for this report. We so informed you in our letter to you dated November 28, 1984. This failure to notify us of the due date for this report is particularly significant as we were under the mistaken impression, based on information given to us by FEC personnel, that, since we were filing on a monthly basis (our report for October covering the period of the 12 Day Pre-General Report was filed on November 20, 1984), it was unnecessary to file in addition a Pre-General Report. This mistaken information was given to us by an Information Specialist, Office of Public Communications, FEC, at the 1983 Southern Regional Conference co-sponsored by the Federal Election Commission, which took

place on October 23-25, 1983. At workshop E4, on "Common Problems for PACS," on Tuesday, October 25, the Information Specialist told the workshop, which included Carole Wilson from the IUE, that during an election year it would be wise to file on a monthly basis as this obviated the need for filing pre-primary and pre-general election reports. As a result of this suggestion, the IUE Political Education Committee changed its filing status in 1984 from a quarterly to a monthly basis.

Second, our monthly report for October, covering the period of the 12 Day Pre-General Report was filed on November 20, 1984. As soon as we received your letter dated November 16, 1984, which was not received until November 19, 1984, we acknowledged our error, and rectified it by filing the 12 Day Pre-General Report on November 28, 1984. In that letter, as stated above, we pointed out that we had never previously been notified of the due date for this report and had not filed the report because of faulty advice by FEC personnel.

Third, to our knowledge, this is the only instance in which the IUE Political Education Committee has failed to file a timely report.

In these circumstances, based on this single, isolated instance, which occurred as the result of misadvice from a commission employee, and the failure by the Commission to comply with its own procedures concerning due date notification, we believe that no further action on the matter is warranted. The IUE Political Education Committee acted in good faith in this matter, with no intent to violate the Federal Election Campaign Act.

As we stated in our November 28, 1984, filing to you, you have our assurance that the failure to file will not happen again.



**GENERATION OF THE MATTER**

The Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") referred this matter to the Office of the General Counsel on January 16, 1985. The source of this attached referral is the late filing of the 1984 Pre-General Report by the IUE Committee on Political Education ("the Committee").

**FACTUAL BASIS AND LEGAL ANALYSIS**

The Act requires all unauthorized committees filing monthly reports to file a Pre-General election report in any year when a regularly scheduled general election is held. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(B). Such reports must be filed no later than 12 days before the general election. Id.

The Committee failed to submit this report in a timely manner. The Pre-General Report was required to be filed 12 days before (or posted by registered or certified mail no later than 15 days before) the November 6, 1984 election. It was not filed with the Commission until November 30, 1984.

SUBJECT: NON-FILER REFERRALS OF MONTHLY UNAUTHORIZED COMMITTEES

In accordance with Standard 3 of the RAD Review and Referral Procedures for Unauthorized Committees, the attached list of monthly filers is being forwarded to your offices, for failing to file a report covering the pre-election period by election day.

Since the number of committees being referred is relatively large, we felt it best to arrange the information in chart format. You will note that the attached printouts list the names, addresses, and treasurers for thirty-five (35) committees with "C" Indices provided for each.<sup>1/</sup> Any telephonic communications have been referenced under Contacts with Filers. The Summary Pages of the late filed reports and/or explanatory letters have been referenced under Response(s).

Two committees have been deleted from the list, because they meet the expedited audit referral threshold. Should the Commission not approve to audit these committees, they will be referred to your office at a later date. The attachments for these committees have also been deleted causing two gaps in the sequence.

All unauthorized committees were sent prior notification on October 1, 1984, which specifically informed monthly filers of the requirement to file a 12 Day Pre-General Election Report by October 25, 1984 (Attachment 38). The committees, which failed to submit either a 12 Day Pre-General Report or a November Monthly Report, were sent Non-Filer Notices on November 16, 1984

<sup>1/</sup> In some cases, the aggregate receipt and disbursement figures may be inflated because committees submitted reports covering portions of the same periods (e.g., a November Monthly covering October 1, 1984 through October 31, 1984 and a Pre-General Report covering October 1, 1984 through October 17, 1984.)

**WHO MUST FILE THE PRE-GENERAL ELECTION REPORT**

All committees that file monthly reports must file the pre-general election report due October 25, 1984.

In addition all quarterly filing committees that have made contributions or expenditures (including independent expenditures) in connection with the general election must file a pre-election report, if such activity has not previously been reported. See below for post-general filing information.

**WHAT MUST BE REPORTED**

The report must disclose all financial activity of the committee from the later of, the last report filed or the date of registration\* through October 17, 1984. (Monthly filers must disclose all financial activity from the later of October 1 or the date of registration\* through October 17, 1984.)

**WHEN TO FILE**

Pre-general election reports sent registered or certified mail must be postmarked no later than October 22, 1984. Reports hand delivered or mailed first class must be received no later than close of business October 25, 1984.

\* \* \* \* \*

**WHO MUST FILE THE POST-GENERAL ELECTION REPORT**

All committees must file the post-general election report due December 6, 1984, regardless of election activity.

**WHAT MUST BE REPORTED**

The post-general election report must cover all financial activity of the committee from either the date of the last report filed or the date of registration, whichever is later\* through November 26, 1984.

**WHEN TO FILE**

Post-general election reports sent by registered or certified mail must be postmarked no later than December 6, 1984. Reports hand delivered or mailed first class must be received no later than close of business December 6, 1984.

\*The first report filed by a committee shall include all amounts received or disbursed prior to becoming a political committee, even if such amounts were not received during the current reporting period. See 11 CFR 104.3(a) and (b).
