However, after considering the circumstances of this matter, the Commission has determined to take no further action and on June 5, 1986, closed its file as it pertains to you and your committee. GENERATION OF MATTER

This matter was referred to the Office of General Counsel by the Reports Analysis Division.

SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS

The Wisconsin Freeze Voters Political Action Committee ("the Committee") and Trudy Karlson, acting as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iv) by failing to file timely the 1985 Year End Report. The Committee violated 2 U.S.C. § 433(c) by failing to amend its Statement of Organization to reflect a change of information.

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FACTUAL AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A) sets forth in pertinent part that all political committees other than authorized committees of a candidate shall, in other than election years, file semi annual reports due no later than July 31 and January 31 of the following year. (See also 11 C.F.R. § 104.5(c)(2)).

2 U.S.C. § 433(c) requires that any change of information in a Statement of Organization be reported within 10 days of the change.

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According to RAD, the Committee failed to file the 1985 Year End Report. RAD's referral stated that on December 20, 1985, the Committee was notified of the Year End Report's due date. The RAD analyst who spoke with the Committee's acting treasurer was told that the individual registered as treasurer is no longer treasurer of the Committee. The analyst advised the acting treasurer, Ms. Trudy Karlson, to amend the Statement of Organization accordingly and to file the required disclosure report. The acting treasurer called later to request a copy of the Committee's 1985 Mid Year Report in order to file the 1985 Year End Report.

On April 25, 1986, after RAD's referral and during the preparation of this General Counsel's report, the Committee filed the 1985 Year End Report. The Year End Report, due January 31, 1986, was filed 84 days late.

Because the Committee failed to file the 1985 Year End Report on time, and because the Committee has not amended the


Statement of Organization to show the change in treasurers, the Office of General Counsel recommends that the Commission open a Matter Under Review and find reason to believe.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Open a Matter Under Review.
2. Find reason to believe that the Wisconsin Freeze Voters Political Action Committee and Trudy Karlson, acting as treasurer, violated:
 - a) 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A);

Dear Ms. Karlson:

On , 1986, the Federal Election Commission determined that there is reason to believe that the Wisconsin Freeze Voters Political Action Committee and you, acting as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. §§ 434(a)(4)(A) and 433(c), provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). The General Counsel's factual and legal analysis, which formed a basis for the Commission's finding, is attached for your information.

Under the Act, you have an opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against you and the committee. You may submit any factual or legal materials which you believe are relevant to the Commission's consideration of this matter. Please submit any such materials within fifteen days of your receipt of this letter.

In the absence of any additional information which demonstrates that no further action should be taken against your committee and you, acting as treasurer, the Commission may find probable cause to believe that a violation has occurred and proceed with conciliation.

If you are interested in pursuing pre-probable cause conciliation, you should so request in writing. See 11 C.F.R. § 111.18(d). Upon receipt of the request, the Office of General Counsel will make recommendations to the Commission either proposing an agreement in settlement of the matter or

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recommending declining that pre-probable cause conciliation be pursued. The Office of General Counsel may recommend that pre-probable cause conciliation not be entered into at this time so that it may complete its investigation of the matter. Further, requests for pre-probable cause conciliation will not be entertained after briefs on probable cause have been mailed to the respondent.

Requests for extensions of time will not be routinely granted. Requests must be made in writing at least five days prior to the due date of the response and specific good cause must be demonstrated. In addition, the Office of General Counsel is not authorized to give extensions beyond 20 days.

If you intend to be represented by counsel in this matter, please advise the Commission by completing the enclosed form stating the name, address and telephone number of such counsel, and a statement authorizing such counsel to receive any notifications and other communications from the Commission.

The investigation now being conducted will be confidential in accordance with 2 U.S.C. §§ 437g(a)(4)(B) and 437g(a)(12)(A), unless you notify the Commission in writing that you wish the investigation to be made public.

For your information, we have attached a brief description of the Commission's procedures for handling possible violations of the Act. If you have any questions, please contact Frances B. Hagan, the staff member assigned to this matter, at (202) 376-8200.

SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS

The Wisconsin Freeze Voters Political Action Committee ("the Committee") and Trudy Karlson, acting as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iv) by failing timely to file the 1985 Year End Report. The Committee and its acting treasurer violated 2 U.S.C. § 433(c) by failing to amend its Statement of Organization to reflect a change of information.

FACTUAL AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A) sets forth in pertinent part that all political committees other than authorized committees of a candidate shall, in other than election years, file semi annual reports due no later than July 31 and January 31 of the following year. (See also 11 C.F.R. § 104.5(c)(2)).

2 U.S.C. § 433(c) requires that any change of information in a Statement of Organization be reported within 10 days of the change.

According to the Reports Analysis Division, the Committee failed to file the 1985 Year End Report. RAD's referral stated that on December 20, 1985, the Committee was notified of the Year

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End Report's due date. The RAD analyst who spoke with the Committee's acting treasurer was told that the individual registered as treasurer is no longer treasurer. The analyst advised the acting treasurer, Ms. Trudy Karlson, to amend the Statement of Organization accordingly and to file the required disclosure report. The acting treasurer called later to request a copy of the Committee's 1985 Mid Year Report in order to file the 1985 Year End Report.

On April 25, 1986, after RAD's referral to the Office of General Counsel, the Committee filed the 1985 Year End Report. The Year End Report, due January 31, 1986, was filed 84 days late.

Because the Committee failed to file the 1985 Year End Report on time, and because the Committee has not amended the Statement of Organization to show the change in treasurers, the Office of General Counsel recommended that the Commission open a Matter Under Review and find reason to believe that the Committee and Trudy Karlson, acting as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. §§ 434(a)(4)(A) and 433(c).

III. BACKGROUND:

Non-Filing of the 1985 Year End Report

The Wisconsin Freeze Voter Political Action Committee (the "Committee") failed to file the 1985 Year End Report of Receipts and Disbursements in a timely manner. The Committee was notified on December 20, 1985, that the report was due on January 31, 1986 (Attachment 2).

On February 25, 1986, a Non-Filer Notice was sent to the Committee (Attachment 3). No response was received and therefore on March 20, 1986, the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") analyst attempted to obtain a telephone number for the Committee. Upon calling the number, it was discovered to be that of the Wisconsin Nuclear Weapons Freeze and not the Committee. Ms. Liz McBride of that organization stated that she knew Mr. Byron Merrick, treasurer of the Committee, but did not have a telephone number for him. However, she did have the number for Ms. Trudy Karlson who was also with the Committee (Attachment 4).

The RAD analyst attempted to contact Ms. Karlson on March 20, 1986 and again on March 21, 1986. On both occasions there was no answer (Attachments 5 and 6).

On April 1, 1986 the RAD analyst spoke with Ms. Karlson. She stated that Mr. Merrick was no longer treasurer and had moved from the state. Ms. Karlson explained she is now acting as treasurer and is in possession of all records (Attachment 7).

Ms. Karlson was informed that the 1985 Year End Report had not been filed and was instructed to file the report and an amended Statement of Organization, listing herself as treasurer. She then stated that the Committee had no activity and wished to terminate. Ms. Karlson was told to file the Year End Report and in addition, the 1986 April Quarterly Report which should be designated as a termination report.

Ms. Karlson stated she would file the reports as soon as she received the forms she requested. The RAD analyst sent the forms to Ms. Karlson on April 1, 1986.

On April 9, 1986 Ms. Karlson called to say Mr. Merrick did not provide her with a copy of the previous report, the 1985 Mid-Year Report. She requested a copy be sent to her. The RAD analyst sent a copy of the requested report that day (Attachment 8). As of this date, the Committee has not filed the 1985 Year End Report.

PARTIES AND PACS

December 20, 1985

WHO MUST FILE

ALL PARTY COMMITTEES, NON-CORRELATED COMMITTEES, AND SEPARATE SEGREGATED FUNDS must file a year-end report by January 31, 1986.

WHAT MUST BE REPORTED

The report must disclose all financial activity that occurred from the close of books for the last report through December 31, 1985. Political committees which have not previously filed a financial disclosure report should report all financial activity from the date of registration* through December 31, 1985. For more detailed instructions, consult your campaign guide.

FILING DATE

Reports sent by registered or certified mail must be postmarked no later than midnight January 31, 1986. Reports hand delivered or mailed first class must be received no later than close of business January 31, 1986.

WHERE TO FILE

Committees should consult the instructions on the enclosed FEC Form 3X for details.

COMPLIANCE

Political committees are fully liable for failure to file any report required under the Act. Failure to file in a timely fashion is also a serious violation. Offending committees are subject to enforcement action. Committees must also submit legible reports which can be clearly reproduced. Illegible reports and reports submitted on non-FEC forms will not be accepted, and committees filing such documents will be required to refile.


1986 FILING REQUIREMENTS

See the January 1986 issue of the FEC Record for filing requirements during 1986. A committee that wishes to change its reporting schedule (e.g. from semiannually in 1985 to monthly—rather than quarterly in 1986) must notify the Commission by submitting a letter with the next report due under its current reporting schedule.

*The first report filed by a committee shall include all amounts received or disbursed prior to becoming a political committee, even if such amounts were not received during the current reporting period. See 11 CFR 104.3(a) and (b).

Non-Filing of the 1985 Year End Report

The Wisconsin Freeze Voter Political Action Committee (the "Committee") failed to file the 1985 Year End Report of Receipts and Disbursements in a timely manner. The Committee was notified on December 20, 1985, that the report was due on January 31, 1986 (Attachment 2).

On February 25, 1986, a Non-Filer Notice was sent to the Committee (Attachment 3). No response was received and therefore on March 20, 1986, the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") analyst attempted to obtain a telephone number for the Committee. Upon calling the number, it was discovered to be that of the Wisconsin Nuclear Weapons Freeze and not the Committee. Ms. Liz McBride of that organization stated that she knew Mr. Byron Merrick, treasurer of the Committee, but did not have a telephone number for him. However, she did have the number for Ms. Trudy Karlson who was also with the Committee (Attachment 4).

The RAD analyst attempted to contact Ms. Karlson on March 20, 1986 and again on March 21, 1986. On both occasions there was no answer (Attachments 5 and 6).

On April 1, 1986 the RAD analyst spoke with Ms. Karlson. She stated that Mr. Merrick was no longer treasurer and had moved from the state. Ms. Karlson explained she is now acting as treasurer and is in possession of all records (Attachment 7).

Ms. Karlson was informed that the 1985 Year End Report had not been filed and was instructed to file the report and an amended Statement of Organization, listing herself as treasurer. She then stated that the Committee had no activity and wished to terminate. Ms. Karlson was told to file the Year End Report and in addition, the 1986 April Quarterly Report which should be designated as a termination report.

Ms. Karlson stated she would file the reports as soon as she received the forms she requested. The RAD analyst sent the forms to Ms. Karlson on April 1, 1986.

On April 9, 1986 Ms. Karlson called to say Mr. Merrick did not provide her with a copy of the previous report, the 1985 Mid-Year Report. She requested a copy be sent to her. The RAD analyst sent a copy of the requested report that day (Attachment 8). As of this date, the Committee has not filed the 1985 Year End Report.

Reports sent by registered or certified mail must be postmarked no later than midnight January 31, 1986. Reports hand delivered or mailed first class must be received no later than close of business January 31, 1986.

WHERE TO FILE

Committees should consult the instructions on the enclosed FEC Form 3X for details.

COMPLIANCE


Political committees are fully liable for failure to file any report required under the Act. Failure to file in a timely fashion is also a serious violation. Offending committees are subject to enforcement action. Committees must also submit legible reports which can be clearly reproduced. Illegible reports and reports submitted on non-FEC forms will not be accepted, and committees filing such documents will be required to refile.

1986 FILING REQUIREMENTS

See the January 1986 issue of the FEC Record for filing requirements during 1986. A committee that wishes to change its reporting schedule (e.g. from semiannually in 1985 to monthly—rather than quarterly in 1986) must notify the Commission by submitting a letter with the next report due under its current reporting schedule.

*The first report filed by a committee shall include all amounts received or disbursed prior to becoming a political committee, even if such amounts were not received during the current reporting period. See 11 CFR 104.3(a) and (b).
