Failure to Timely File the 1986 July Quarterly Report

The Committee was notified on June 20, 1986 that the report was due on July 15, 1986 (Attachment 2).

On August 6, 1986, a Non-Filer Notice was sent to the Committee for the 1986 July Quarterly Report (Attachment 3). No response was received, therefore, on September 2, 1986, the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") analyst attempted to obtain a telephone number for the Committee from directory assistance. There was no listing for the Committee (Attachment 4).

On September 8, 1986, the Committee filed the 1986 July Quarterly Report (Attachment 5).

PARTIES AND PACS

June 20, 1986

WHO MUST FILE

All Party Committees, Nonconnected Committees and Separate Segregated Funds, except those that file monthly (see below), must file a quarterly report by July 15, 1986.

WHAT MUST BE REPORTED

The report must disclose all financial activity that occurred from the close of books for the last report filed through June 30, 1986. Political committees that have not previously filed a financial disclosure report should report all financial activity through June 30, 1986.* For more detailed instructions, consult your campaign guide.

WHEN TO FILE

Reports sent by registered or certified mail must be postmarked no later than midnight July 15, 1986. Reports hand delivered or mailed first class must be received no later than close of business July 15, 1986.

WHERE AND HOW TO FILE

Committees should consult the instructions on the enclosed FEC Form 3X for details.

MONTHLY FILERS

Committees that file on a monthly schedule must file their next report by July 20, 1986, and disclose all financial activity of their committee from June 1 through June 30, 1986. (See the schedule of monthly reports on the reverse side.)

COMPLIANCE

Political committees are fully liable for failure to file any report required under the Act. Failure to file in a timely fashion is also a serious violation. Offending committees are subject to enforcement action. Committees must also submit legible reports which can be clearly reproduced. Illegible reports and reports submitted on non-FEC forms will not be accepted, and committees filing such documents will be required to refile.

*The first report filed by a committee shall include all amounts received or disbursed prior to becoming a political committee, even if such amounts were not received or disbursed during the current reporting period. See 11 CFR 104.3(a) and (b).

REMINDERS

QUARTERLY FILERS

Committees that make contributions or expenditures (including independent expenditures) in connection with an election, must file a pre-election report, if this activity has not been previously disclosed. See the January 1986 issue of the Federal Election Commission Record for primary election filing requirements.

MONTHLY FILERS

Committees that file monthly reports must follow the schedule below. Pre-general election reports sent by registered or certified mail must be postmarked no later than mid-night October 20, 1986. All other reports sent by registered or certified mail must be postmarked no later than midnight on the filing date in order to be timely. Reports hand delivered or mailed first class must be received by close of business on the filing date.

GENERATION OF MATTER

This case was referred to the Office of the General Counsel on September 22, 1986 by the Reports Analysis Division.

SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS

It appears that there is reason to believe that the National Pro-Life Democrats Political Action Committee ("NPLD") and Fred Hart Jr., treasurer ("the respondents"), violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(i) by failing to file their July 1986 Quarterly Report in a timely manner.

FACTUAL AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

The respondents filed their July 1986 Quarterly Report on September 8, 1986. However, pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(i), they were required to do so by July 15, 1986. Thus, the report was filed fifty-five days late. Therefore, this Office recommends that the Commission find reason to believe that the respondents violated § 434(a)(4)(A)(i).

Dear Mr. Hart:

On October 14, 1986, the Federal Election Commission determined there is reason to believe National Pro-Life Democrats Political Action Committee and you, as Treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(i), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. The General Counsel's factual and legal analysis, which formed a basis for the Commission's finding, is attached for your information.

Under the Act, you have an opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against you and the committee. You may submit any factual or legal materials which you believe are relevant to the Commission's consideration of this matter. Please submit any such materials within fifteen days of your receipt of this letter. Statements should be submitted under oath.

In the absence of any additional information which demonstrates that no further action should be taken against your committee and you, as treasurer, the Commission may find probable cause to believe that a violation has occurred and proceed with conciliation.

If you are interested in pursuing pre-probable cause conciliation, you should so request in writing. See 11 C.F.R. § 111.18(d). Upon receipt of the request, the Office of General Counsel will make recommendations to the Commission either proposing an agreement in settlement of the matter or recommending declining that pre-probable cause conciliation be pursued. The Office of General Counsel may recommend that pre-probable cause conciliation not be entered into at this time so

that it may complete its investigation of the matter. Further, requests for pre-probable cause conciliation will not be entertained after briefs on probable cause have been mailed to the respondent.


Requests for extensions of time will not be routinely granted. Requests must be made in writing at least five days prior to the due date of the response and specific good cause must be demonstrated. In addition, the Office of General Counsel is not authorized to give extensions beyond 20 days.

If you intend to be represented by counsel in this matter, please advise the Commission by completing the enclosed form stating the name, address and telephone number of such counsel, and a statement authorizing such counsel to receive any notifications and other communications from the Commission.

The investigation now being conducted will be confidential in accordance with 2 U.S.C. §§ 437g(a)(4)(B) and 437g(a)(12)(A), unless you notify the Commission in writing that you wish the investigation to be made public.

For your information, we have attached a brief description of the Commission's procedures for handling possible violations of the Act. If you have any questions, please contact John Drury, the attorney assigned to this matter at (202) 376-8200.

I. BACKGROUND

This case was referred to the Office of the General Counsel on September 22, 1986. On October 8, 1986, the office forwarded a report to the Commission regarding possible violations of 2 U.S.C. § 434. On October 14, the Commission found reason to believe the respondents violated § 434(a)(4)(A)(i). On October 20, 1986, the FEC forwarded a notification letter to the respondents. On November 28, 1986, this Office received a letter from the respondents requesting pre-probable cause conciliation.

II. LEGAL ANALYSIS

Pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(i), the respondents were required to file their July 1986 Quarterly Report by July 15, 1986. They did not do so until September 8, 1986, fifty-five days late.

III. DISCUSSION OF CONCILIATION PROVISIONS AND CIVIL PENALTY





CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

This matter was initiated by the Federal Election Commission (hereinafter "the Commission"), pursuant to information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. Reason to believe was found that the National Pro-Life Democrats Political Action Committee and Fred Hart, Jr., as treasurer ("Respondents") violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(i) by failing to file their July 1986 Quarterly report in a timely manner.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission and Respondents, having participated in informal methods of conciliation, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, do hereby agree as follows:

I. The Commission has jurisdiction over the Respondents, and the subject matter of this proceeding, and this agreement has the effect of an agreement entered pursuant to 2 U.S.C.

§ 437g(a)(4)(A)(i).

II. Respondents have had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.

III. Respondents enter voluntarily into this agreement with the Commission.

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IV. The pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:

1. Respondent, the National Pro-Life Democrats Political Action Committee is a non-party political committee, and respondent Fred Hart, Jr., is the treasurer of that political committee.

2. Respondents were required by 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(i) to file their 1986 July Quarterly report by July 15, 1986.

3. Respondents failed to file said report until September 8, 1986.

V. Respondents' failure to file their 1986 July Quarterly report in a timely manner violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(i).

VI. Respondents will pay a civil penalty to the Federal Election Commission in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250) pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(5)(A).

VII. The Commission, on request of anyone filing a complaint under 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1) concerning the matters at issue herein or on its own motion, may review compliance with this agreement. If the Commission believes that this agreement or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute a civil action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

VIII. This agreement shall become effective as of the date all parties hereto have executed the same and the Commission has approved the entire agreement.

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

This Conciliation Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties on the matters raised herein, and no other statement, promise, or agreement, either written or oral, made by either party or by agents of either party, that is not contained in this written agreement shall be valid.


