SUBJECT: 30 DAY POST-GENERAL REPORT NON-FILER REFERRALS OF
UNAUTHORIZED COMMITTEES

Attached is a listing of fifteen (15) unauthorized committees which failed to file the 1986 30 Day Post-General Report within thirty (30) days of the date of the Non-Filer Notice. In accordance with Standard 3 of the 1985-1986 RAD Review and Referral Procedures for Unauthorized Committees, further examination is required by your office.

On September 29, 1986, prior notification was sent to all unauthorized committees informing them that all committees, regardless of election activity, must file the 30 Day Post-General Report by December 4, 1986 (Attachment 16). Each committee which failed to submit a report covering the post-election reporting period was sent a Non-Filer Notice on December 23, 1986 (Attachment 17).

The attached printout lists the name, address and treasurer for each committee being referred. Any telephone conversations are referenced under Contacts with Filers. The Summary Pages of late-filed reports and/or letters of explanation are included under Reports Filed/Response(s). In addition, a "C" index accompanies each committee. In a few instances, the aggregate receipt and disbursement figures may be inflated because reports were submitted covering portions of the same reporting period.

WHO MUST FILE THE PRE-GENERAL ELECTION REPORT

ALL COMMITTEES that file monthly reports must file the pre-general election report due October 23, 1986.

All COMMITTEES that file quarterly that have made contributions or expenditures (including independent expenditures and coordinated party expenditures) in connection with the general election must file a pre-election report, if such activity has not previously been reported. See below for post-general filing information.

WHAT MUST BE REPORTED

Quarterly filers must disclose all financial activity from the close of books of the last report, or from the date of registration* (whichever is later), through October 15, 1986. (Monthly filers must disclose all financial activity from October 1 or from the date of registration* (whichever is later), through October 15, 1986.) For more detailed instructions, consult your campaign guide.

WHEN TO FILE

Pre-general election reports sent registered or certified mail must be postmarked no later than midnight October 20, 1986. Reports hand delivered or mailed first class must be received no later than close of business October 23, 1986.

WHO MUST FILE THE POST-GENERAL ELECTION REPORT

ALL COMMITTEES must file the post-general election report due December 4, 1986, regardless of election activity.

WHAT MUST BE REPORTED


The report must disclose all financial activity from the close of books of the last report, or the date of registration* (whichever is later), through November 24, 1986.

WHEN TO FILE

Post-general election reports sent by registered or certified mail must be postmarked no later than midnight December 4, 1986. Reports hand delivered or mailed first class must be received no later than close of business December 4, 1986.

*The first report filed by a committee shall include all amounts received or disbursed prior to becoming a political committee, even if such amounts were not received or disbursed during the current reporting period. See 11 CFR 104.3(a) and (b).

COMPLIANCE

Political committees are fully liable for failure to file any report required under the Act. Failure to file in a timely fashion is also a serious violation. Offending committees are subject to enforcement action. Committees must also submit legible reports which can be clearly reproduced. Illegible reports and reports submitted on non-FEC forms will not be accepted, and committees filing such documents will be required to refile.

I. GENERATION OF MATTER

On March 17, 1987, the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") referred the following 15 unauthorized political committees to the Office of the General Counsel for failure to file the 1986 Post-General Election Report timely:¹

II. FACTUAL AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

(A) The Facts

On September 29, 1986, notification was sent to all unauthorized political committee advising that regardless of

^{2/} The fifteen committees discussed in this report were referred to this Office as a group by the Reports Analysis Division. Each referral in which the Commission decides to open a MUR will be assigned a separate MUR number and handled by the staff person indicated in the attached notification letters.

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15. United San Francisco Republican Committee

On January 29, 1987, a 1986 Year-End Report was filed. The report covered the periods required to be disclosed on the 1986 Post-General Report and the 1986 Year-End Report. Thus, the information required on the 1986 Post-General Election Report was submitted 56 days late. The 1986 Year-End Report disclosed receipts of \$3,000 and disbursements of \$3,030 for the period of October 1, 1986, through December 31, 1986.

(B) The Applicable Law

Pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iii), all political committees other than the authorized committees of a candidate shall file a post-general election report, which shall be filed no later than the 30th day after the general election and which shall be complete as of the 20th day after such general election.

(C) Application of the Law to the Facts

The record in this matter demonstrates that the 15 political committees discussed on pages 3 - 7 above were required to file the 1986 Post-General Election Report by December 4, 1986. The above committees, however, failed to file the report in a timely manner. In consideration of this circumstance it is the recommendation of this office that the Commission open a Matter Under Review and find reason to believe that a violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iii) occurred with respect to the late filing of the 1986 Post-General Election Report by:

Dear Mr. Mark:

On April 23, 1987, the Federal Election Commission found that there is reason to believe United San Francisco Republican Committee ("the Committee") ("Committee") and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iii), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). The Factual and Legal Analysis, which formed a basis for the Commission's finding, is attached for your information.

Under the Act, you have an opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against the Committee and you, as treasurer. You may submit any factual or legal materials that you believe are relevant to the Commission's consideration of this matter. Please submit such materials to the General Counsel's Office within 15 days of your receipt of this letter. Where appropriate, statements should be submitted under oath.

In the absence of any additional information demonstrating that no further action should be taken against the Committee and you, as treasurer, the Commission may find probable cause to believe that a violation has occurred and proceed with conciliation.

If you are interested in pursuing pre-probable cause conciliation, you should so request in writing. See 11 C.F.R. § 111.18(d). Upon receipt of the request, the Office of the General Counsel will make recommendations to the Commission either proposing an agreement in settlement of the matter or recommending declining that pre-probable cause conciliation be

pursued. The Office of the General Counsel may recommend that pre-probable cause conciliation not be entered into at this time so that it may complete its investigation of the matter. Further, the Commission will not entertain requests for pre-probable cause conciliation after briefs on probable cause have been mailed to the respondent.

Requests for extensions of time will not be routinely granted. Requests must be made in writing at least five days prior to the due date of the response and specific good cause must be demonstrated. In addition, the Office of the General Counsel is not authorized to give extensions beyond 20 days.

If you intend to be represented by counsel in this matter, please advise the Commission by completing the enclosed form stating the name, address, and telephone number of such counsel, and authorizing such counsel to receive any notifications and other communications from the Commission.

The investigation now being conducted will be confidential in accordance with 2 U.S.C. §§ 437g(a)(4)(B) and 437g(a)(12)(A), unless you notify the Commission in writing that you wish the investigation to be made public.

For your information, we have attached a brief description of the Commission's procedures for handling possible violations of the Act. If you have any questions, please contact Phillip Wise, at (202) 376-8200.

To Whom It May Concern

I am in receipt of your letter and analysis in the above matter dated May 4, 1987. I, Dennis J. Mark, therefore to the best of my knowledge, state the following facts regarding the above matter as follows:

- 1) I concur with your findings that no 1986 Post-General Election Report was filed, and that a 1986 Year-End Report was filed covering both periods.
- 2) The United San Francisco Republican Committee (herein USFRC) has been a conduit committee which received money from one source and distributed same to the San Francisco Republican County Central Committee (herein SFRCCC).
- 3) I WAS NOT, AND HAVE NEVER BEEN OFFICIALLY APPOINTED TREASURER OF THE USFRC. The committee treasurer was at that time, Harriet Ross (also then-chair of the SFRCCC).
- 4) The books and records of the USFRC were maintained at the then-headquarters of the SFRCCC at 49 Geary Street Room 240, San Francisco, CA 94102.
- 5) In the summer of 1986 (I do not recall the exact date), I was asked by Ms. Ross to be the assistant treasurer of the SFRCCC (not the USFRC). I accepted, and was approved by the members of the SFRCCC. This was to be on a non-paid voluntary basis.
- 6) On several occasions in the latter half of 1986, I was asked (oftentimes at the last minute) by either Ms. Ross or the paid staff of the SFRCCC to prepare statements for both committees. This I did, and the USFRC state-

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ments were prepared as a courtesy and for convenience for Ms. Ross. No one ever asked me to prepare a Post-General Report for the USFRC.

- 7) In late September or early October, Ms. Ross was informed that funds used to maintain the office would no longer be forthcoming, which meant closure of the SFRCCC office was imminent. For all practical purposes, the office was abandoned in December with the contents being removed in January.
- 8) At the organizational meeting of the new SFRCCC on January 5, 1987, I was elected treasurer of the SFRCCC (but not the USFRC). A new chairman was elected. No mention was made of the USFRC.
- 9) My first duty as I saw it, was to ensure that all filings (campaign statements, payroll tax returns, etc) were filed on time. I was quite surprised to go into that office and find no coherent order in the files. Financial data was scattered everywhere and I could not determine where we stood financially speaking. As a volunteer employed elsewhere, I had to spend many evenings in January putting records in order to enable me to file the statements and to vacate the office.
- 10) During the clean-up of the office, I discovered your notice dated December 23, 1986. Since the position of Treasurer of the USFRC had for all practical purposes been vacated, I voluntarily decided to file the Year End Report. Since the information contained in that report would have contained all the information contained in the Post-General Report, I merely filed the report as a Year End Report. No activity occurred between November 24 and December 31, 1986. (In fact, no activity has occurred since then).
- 11) Since the headquarters had closed, I did not receive your correspondence directed to Ms. Ross dated January 27, 1987 until after I had filed the year end report on January 29. Headquarters mail was being forwarded to another address. It was my best belief at the time that since no activity occurred after the Post-General period, that one report would suffice. I did not receive any communication from your office since then, until now.

In summary, I believe the above mentioned facts demonstrate that I was acting voluntarily and in good faith. I am willing to accept responsibility for any negligence on my part, but for my own defense, I do not believe I am responsible for this report not being filed. Not one of the SFRCCC's paid staff or chairwoman requested that I prepare the report. Only by finding your notice in the office (by chance) did I become aware of the fact that it had not been filed, and acting in good faith did I believe the Year End Report would suffice.

Lastly, I believe there was no intent by Ms. Ross or any paid staff member of the SFRCCC to ignore the filing. The SFRCCC has been beset by some grave problems in the past year and in


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the midst of these problems (including the office closure), this matter was probably overlooked.

Enclosed you will find a report for the period 10-1-86 to 10-15-86 and a report from 10-16-86 to 11-24-86. The first report is to bridge the gap between the last statement date 9-30-86 and the beginning of the Post-General period. I would hope these report would satisfy the filing requirements of the FEC.

Again, I accept full responsibility for any action (or lack thereof) on my part which is contrary to law, but the above facts should vindicate me from any wrongdoing. Since we would all like to settle this matter, please do not hesitate to call or write to me should you need to, in order to resolve this case.







CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

This matter was initiated by the Federal Election Commission ("the Commission"), pursuant to information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. The Commission found reason to believe that United San Francisco Republican Committee and Dennis J. Mark, as treasurer, ("Respondents") violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iii).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission and the Respondents, having participated in informal methods of conciliation, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, do hereby agree as follows:

I. The Commission has jurisdiction over the Respondents and the subject matter of this proceeding, and this agreement has the effect of an agreement entered pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(4)(A)(i).

II. Respondents have had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.

III. Respondents enter voluntarily into this agreement with the Commission.

IV. The pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:

1. Respondent, United San Francisco Republican Committee, is a political committee within the meaning of 2 U.S.C. § 431(4).

2. Respondent, Dennis J. Mark, is the treasurer of United San Francisco Republican Committee.

3. Respondents were required to file their 1986 Post-General Election Report by December 4, 1986. On January 29, 1987, a 1986 Year End Report was filed. The report covered the period required to be disclosed on the 1986 Post-General Election Report. Thus, the information required on the 1986 Post-General Election Report was submitted 56 days late.

4. Respondent, Dennis J. Mark, was not the treasurer of United San Francisco Republican Committee at the time the 1986 Post-General Election Report and the 1986 Year End Report were due. Since the treasurer had for all practical purposes, abandoned the position, Mr. Mark in good faith, took it upon himself to voluntarily file the 1986 Year End Report after he had learned that the reports had not been filed.

V. Respondents failed to file their 1986 Post-General Election Report in a timely manner in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iii).

VI. Respondents will pay a civil penalty to the Federal Election Commission in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty dollars (\$250.00), pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(5)(A).

VII. The Commission, on request of anyone filing a complaint under 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1) concerning the matters at issue herein or on its own motion, may review compliance with this agreement. If the Commission believes that this agreement or any

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
requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute a civil action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

VIII. This agreement shall become effective as of the date that all parties hereto have executed same and the Commission has approved the entire agreement.

IX. Respondents shall have no more than thirty (30) days from the date this agreement becomes effective to comply with and implement the requirements contained in this agreement and to so notify the Commission.


