SUBJECT: QUARTERLY FILERS (UNAUTHORIZED COMMITTEES) WHICH
FAILED TO FILE THE 1986 12 DAY PRE-GENERAL REPORT
BY ELECTION DAY

The attached list of unauthorized committees consists of forty-nine (49) quarterly filers which failed to file a 1986 12 Day Pre-General Report by Election Day, November 4, 1986. In accordance with Standard 3 of the RAD Review and Referral Procedures, further examination is required by your office.

Unlike the mandatory reporting requirement placed upon monthly filers, 2 U.S.C. §434(a)(4)(A)(ii) requires quarterly filers to submit 12 Day Pre-General Reports only if the committees make contributions to or expenditures on behalf of federal candidates involved in the general election. All unauthorized committees were sent prior notification regarding the pre- and post-general filing requirements on September 29, 1986 (Attachment 50).

The Party/Non-Party Branch conducted a thorough examination to identify quarterly filers disclosing contributions or expenditures between October 1 and October 15, 1986. The research revealed committees that submitted:

- a) 12 Day Pre-General Reports in an untimely manner;
- b) 30 Day Post-General Reports indicating that 12 Day Pre-General Reports should have been filed; and
- c) Year End Reports indicating that 12 Day Pre-General Reports should have been filed.





On June 15, 1987, the Federal Election Commission found that there is reason to believe Title Industry Political Action Committee ("Committee") and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). The Factual and Legal Analysis, which formed a basis for the Commission's finding, is attached for your information.

Under the Act, you have an opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against the Committee and you, as treasurer. You may submit any factual or legal materials that you believe are relevant to the Commission's consideration of this matter. Please submit such materials to the General Counsel's Office, within 15 days of your receipt of this letter. Where appropriate, statements should be submitted under oath.

In the absence of any additional information demonstrating that no further action should be taken against the Committee and you, as treasurer, the Commission may find probable cause to believe that a violation has occurred and proceed with conciliation.

If you are interested in pursuing pre-probable cause conciliation, you should so request in writing. See 11 C.F.R. § 111.18(d). Upon receipt of the request, the Office of the General Counsel will make recommendations to the Commission either proposing an agreement in settlement of the matter or recommending declining that pre-probable cause conciliation be pursued. The Office of the General Counsel may recommend that pre-probable cause conciliation not be entered into at this time so that it may complete its investigation of the matter. Further, the Commission will not entertain requests for pre-

probable cause conciliation after briefs on probable cause have been mailed to the respondent.

Requests for extensions of time will not be routinely granted. Requests must be made in writing at least five days prior to the due date of the response and specific good cause must be demonstrated. In addition, the Office of the General Counsel will not ordinarily give extensions beyond 20 days.

If you intend to be represented by counsel in this matter, please advise the Commission by completing the enclosed form stating the name, address, and telephone number of such counsel, and authorizing such counsel to receive any notifications and other communications from the Commission.

The investigation now being conducted will be confidential in accordance with 2 U.S.C. §§ 437g(a)(4)(B) and 437g(a)(12)(A), unless you notify the Commission in writing that you wish the investigation to be made public.

Thus, the committee was required to file a 12-Day Pre-Election Report by October 23, 1986, and complete as of October 15, 1986. The Committee did not file a report disclosing this activity until it filed its 1986 Post-General Election Report on December 29, 1986. Accordingly, the committee and its treasurer have violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii).

This is in response to your letter of June 29, 1987, in which you advised the Title Industry Political Action Committee (TIPAC) and myself as its treasurer that there was reason to believe TIPAC had violated 2 U.S.C. Section 434(a)(4)(A)(ii). This finding was premised upon the records of the Commission reflecting TIPAC's apparent failure to file a Pre-Election Report for the 1986 General Election. Our records reflect that we did not file this report.

The purpose of this letter is to respectfully request conciliation prior to a finding of probable cause.

In support of this request TIPAC wishes to put before the Commission the following facts which it considers relevant to the Commission's determination.

As noted in the Commission's Factual and Legal Analysis, the required information was reported in TIPAC's 1986 Post-General Election Report, filed on December 29, 1986. Also noted was the relatively small dollar amount of \$6,900 given to 14 different candidates during the relevant period. Taken together, I believe it becomes apparent that it was not our intention to mislead the Commission or the public by failing to report. Moreover, the Commission is now in possession of all information and we can take no further action to correct this problem other than the establishment of internal controls which we have undertaken to do.

The former treasurer of TIPAC (who, until this complaint, continued to receive all correspondence from the Commission despite repeated changes) had been in that position for over nine years and had supervised the filings through the past several general elections prior to 1986 and, no doubt, directed these filings to be made. That individual left our Association in December, 1985, and we have had other changes in personnel in the administrative staff responsible for TIPAC recordkeeping. No doubt these changes in personnel contributed to the failure to report. We now have trained personnel in place. Future reports will be filed in a timely manner.

I would note, however, that it had been the custom of the Commission to notify committees of these filing requirements and due dates. We received no such notification prior to the due date for the Pre-General Election Report in question.

I would also note that, by letter dated January 12, 1987 (copy attached), Ms. Lisa J. Stolaruk, Chief of the Party/Non-Party Branch of the Reports Analysis Division advised us of the lateness of the subject report and one other. She stated that "any additional report which is not submitted in a timely manner ... may result in the Commission initiating legal enforcement or audit action." By this statement we have been operating under the assumption that the Commission had accepted our December 29, 1986 report in full satisfaction of our obligations for the relevant period.

Finally, I would point out, with some concern, that the Commission's Factual and Legal Analysis speaks of "unauthorized committees filing quarterly" (emphasis added). We are under the distinct impression, obtained by telephonic instructions from Commission staff (Tammy Rollins), that TIPAC is obligated to file only semi-annually. If this impression is in error, I would greatly appreciate being advised immediately because no first quarter report has been filed in reliance upon this advice.

I respectfully request that the Commission and its staff consider the above in mitigation of TIPAC's failure to file the subject report.





CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

This matter was initiated by the Federal Election Commission ("the Commission"), pursuant to information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. The Commission found reason to believe that Title Industry Political Action Committee and James R. Maher, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(6)(B)(i).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission and the Respondents, having participated in informal methods of conciliation, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, do hereby agree as follows:

I. The Commission has jurisdiction over the Respondents and the subject matter of this proceeding, and this agreement has the effect of an agreement entered pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(4)(A)(i).

II. Respondents have had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.

III. Respondents enter voluntarily into this agreement with the Commission.

IV. The pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:

1. Respondent, Title Industry Political Action Committee, is a political committee within the meaning of 2 U.S.C. § 431(4).

2. Respondent, James R. Maher, is the treasurer of Title Industry Political Action Committee.

3. Respondents filed a 1986 Post-General Election Report on December 29, 1986, which disclosed contributions totalling \$6,900 to 14 candidates. Respondents initially reported these contributions as made during the 1986 pre-general reporting period (October 1 through October 15).

4. Respondents provided supplemental information which demonstrated that the dates for making the 14 contributions were reported inaccurately.

V. In their 1986 Pre-General Election Report Respondents inaccurately disclosed the dates on which 14 contributions were made, in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(6)(B)(i).

VI. a. Respondents will pay a civil penalty to the Federal Election Commission in the amount of Three Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$350) pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(5)(A).

b. Respondents will amend the appropriate disclosure report(s) to disclose the correct dates on which the 14 contributions were made.

VII. The Commission, on request of anyone filing a complaint under 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1) concerning the matters at issue herein or on its own motion, may review compliance with this agreement. If the Commission believes that this agreement or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute a civil


action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

VIII. This agreement shall become effective as of the date that all parties hereto have executed same and the Commission has approved the entire agreement.

IX. Respondents shall have no more than thirty (30) days from the date this agreement becomes effective to comply with and implement the requirements contained in this agreement and to so notify the Commission.



Dear Mr. Noble:

Enclosed please find amended reports for the 1986 Pre- and Post-General Election periods of the above referenced committee. These amended reports are required as the result of a conciliation agreement entered into between TIPAC and the Commission, effective January 7, 1988. That agreement, in paragraph VI(b), required amendments in the report to accurately disclose the dates on which the 14 disputed contributions were made.

As you will note, we have indicated on the 1986 Pre-General Election report that no contributions had been made. This is consistent with the information previously provided to the Commission which indicated that our procedures were such that none of the 14 contributions could have been made during the period covered by this report.

In addition, seven of the subject contribution checks have never been negotiated. We have issued stop-payment orders on these checks though they are so stale now that they are probably non-negotiable anyway--if not lost by the campaign committees who originally received them. These seven checks are not reflected on either of the amended reports. I believe this treatment of these "contributions" is consistent with advice given during a telephone conversation with Staff Attorney Sandra Robinson.


