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I contacted Miss Halbmaier the Treasurer of the committee in California and stated that the committee had not filed the 1987 Year End Report. Miss Halbmaier stated that she had not been in association with the committee since October of 1987. She suggested that I should get in contact with Peter Gama the Director of the committee. I advised Miss Halbmaier that as the registered treasurer of the committee she was responsible for insuring that the committee file timely reports. I also advised Miss Halbmaier that this matter would probably be referred to the Office of General Counsel. She stated that she would try to get in contact with Mr. Gama and persuade him to file the Year End Report.

From conversations with Fran Griffin (Gemma), I understand that she now has possession of additional materials received from Attorney Arif, not shipped earlier. I have asked her to go through them, inform me of their nature, and to ship to me what items I request.

Once again, I wish to make it clear that it is our intention to cooperate in every possible way with the Federal Election Commission in supplying past-due reports, and in complying with all reporting procedures in the future. I had repeatedly instructed Mr. Gemma to be prompt in these matters, as recently as my last phone conversation with him last year, and I am very angry to learn now that he apparently ignored my orders.

But as I indicated yesterday, until I come into possession of complete records (including locations and status of any PAC bank account(s)), that will be difficult. I am prepared, if the records are not in my hands within the next several weeks, to take legal action to force Mr. Gemma and/or Miss Halbmaier to comply.

I hope that the F.E.C. Counsel will take my difficult situation at this juncture into consideration when considering any action.

Finally, per our conversation yesterday, I await receipt of photocopies of National Pro-Life PAC's complete F.E.C. file, including all correspondence and reports since its founding, in 1977. I will also be grateful for instructional materials you indicated you would include relative to legal requirements for reporting procedures.

I will be in touch with you as soon as I have located any of the missing records needed to comply. Please call me if necessary about other information or developments.

I. GENERATION OF MATTER

The Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") referred the above nine committees to the Office of the General Counsel on April 7,

1988. The basis for the attached referral is the committees' failure to file the 1987 Year End Report or to do so in a timely fashion.

II. FACTUAL AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

A. Filing of Reports

The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"), provides that for unauthorized committees filing quarterly, such committees shall file the Year End Report for years in which no regularly scheduled elections are held no later than January 31 of the following calendar year. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iv). Thus, the due date for the 1987 Year End Report was January 31, 1988. The following committees did not file the 1987 Year End Report by this date:

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Accordingly, the Office of the General Counsel recommends that the Commission open Matters Under Review and find reason to believe these nine committees and their treasurers violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iv).

B. Changes of Treasurer and Address

The Act provides that any change in information previously submitted in a Statement of Organization shall be reported in accordance with Section 432(g) no later than 10 days after the date of the change. 2 U.S.C. § 433(c).

The materials also indicate that Laura Halbmaier ceased to serve as treasurer of the National Pro-Life PAC in October 1987. An amendment naming Rev. Charles C. Fiore as treasurer was not filed by Rev. Fiore until March 28, 1988. Rev. Fiore also indicated that the address for the committee had changed, apparently more than 10 days prior to his filing of the amended statement. See Attachment 1 at 8e and 8f.

Accordingly, the Office of the General Counsel also recommends that the Commission find reason to believe that the

Dear Rev. Fiore:

On June 7, 1988, the Federal Election Commission found that there is reason to believe the National Pro-Life PAC ("Committee") and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. §§ 433(c) and 434(a)(4)(A)(iv), provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). The Factual and Legal Analysis, which formed a basis for the Commission's findings, is attached for your information.

Under the Act, you have an opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against the Committee and you, as treasurer. You may submit any factual or legal materials that you believe are relevant to the Commission's consideration of this matter. Please submit such materials to the General Counsel's Office, within 15 days of your receipt of this letter. Where appropriate, statements should be submitted under oath.

In the absence of any additional information demonstrating that no further action should be taken against the Committee and you, as treasurer, the Commission may find probable cause to believe that a violation has occurred and proceed with conciliation.

In order to expedite the resolution of this matter, the Commission has also decided to offer to enter into negotiations directed towards reaching a conciliation agreement in settlement of this matter prior to a finding of probable cause to believe. Enclosed is a conciliation agreement that the Commission has approved.

If you are interested in expediting the resolution of this matter by pursuing preprobable cause conciliation and if you agree with the provisions of the enclosed agreement, please sign and return the agreement, along with the civil penalty, to the

Commission. In light of the fact that conciliation negotiations, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, are limited to a maximum of 30 days, you should respond to this notification as soon as possible.


Requests for extensions of time will not be routinely granted. Requests must be made in writing at least five days prior to the due date of the response and specific good cause must be demonstrated. In addition, the Office of the General Counsel ordinarily will not give extensions beyond 20 days.

If you intend to be represented by counsel in this matter, please advise the Commission by completing the enclosed form stating the name, address, and telephone number of such counsel, and authorizing such counsel to receive any notifications and other communications from the Commission.

This matter will remain confidential in accordance with 2 U.S.C. §§ 437g(a)(4)(B) and 437g(a)(12)(A), unless you notify the Commission in writing that you wish the investigation to be made public.

For your information, we have attached a brief description of the Commission's procedures for handling possible violations of the Act. If you have any questions, please contact Susan Beard, the attorney assigned to this matter, at (202) 376-8200.


Future installments will be sent on or by the first of the next four successive months, each in the amount of \$125.00, as per the agreement.

CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

This matter was initiated by the Federal Election Commission ("Commission"), pursuant to information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. The Commission found reason to believe that the National Pro-Life PAC and Rev. Charles C. Fiore, as treasurer, ("Respondents") violated 2 U.S.C. §§ 434(a)(4)(A)(iv) and 433(c).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission and the respondents, having participated in informal methods of conciliation, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, do hereby agree as follows:

I. The Commission has jurisdiction over the Respondents and the subject matter of this proceeding, and this agreement has the effect of an agreement entered pursuant to 2 U.S.C.

§ 437g(a)(4)(A)(i).

II. Respondents have had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.

III. Respondents enter voluntarily into this agreement with the Commission.

IV. The pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:

1. Respondent, National Pro-Life PAC, is a political committee within the meaning of 2 U.S.C. § 431(4).

2. Respondent, Rev. Charles C. Fiore, is the treasurer of the National Pro-Life PAC.

3. Section 434(a)(4)(A)(iv) of Title 2 provides that unauthorized committees filing quarterly shall file a Year End Report for years in which no regularly scheduled elections are held no later than January 31 of the following calendar year.

4. Respondents were required to file the 1987 Year End Report no later than January 31, 1988. Respondents have not filed a complete 1987 Year End Report.

5. Section 433(c) of Title 2 provides that any change in information previously submitted in a Statement of Organization shall be reported in accordance with Section 432(g) no later than 10 days after the date of the change.

6. Rev. Charles C. Fiore replaced Laura Halbmaier as treasurer and the committee moved to a new address. The Respondents did not report these changes to the Commission within 10 days.

V. 1. Respondents failed to file the 1987 Year End Report in a timely fashion in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iv).

2. Respondents failed to report changes in information previously submitted in a Statement of Organization within 10 days of such changes in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 433(c).

VI. 1. Respondents will pay a civil penalty to the Federal Election Commission in the amount of seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$750), pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(5)(A), such penalty to be paid as follows:

2. One initial payment of \$250 due on September 1, 1988;

3. Thereafter, beginning on October 1, 1988, four (4) consecutive monthly installment payments of \$125 each;

4. Each such installment shall be paid on the first day of the month in which it becomes due;

5. In the event that any installment payment is not received by the Commission by the fifth day of the month in which it becomes due, the Commission may, at its discretion, accelerate the remaining payments and cause the entire amount to become due upon ten days written notice to the respondents. Failure by the Commission to accelerate the payments with regard to any overdue installment shall not be construed as a waiver of its right to do so with regard to future overdue installments.

6. Respondents will file an Amended 1987 Year End Report within sixty (60) days from the date this agreement becomes effective. The Amended 1987 Year End Report shall be as complete and accurate as Respondents' records permit at that time. Respondents shall file further amendments to the 1987 Year End Report as additional records become available.

VII. The Commission, on request of anyone filing a complaint under 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1) concerning the matters at issue herein or on its own motion, may review compliance with this agreement. If the Commission believes that this agreement or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute a civil action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.





This is with reference to my letter to you of October 31st, regarding our efforts to procure information regarding two checking accounts formerly held by us with the 1st American Bank of Virginia.

In lieu of complete records, which Peter B. Gemma, Jr., our former Executive Director, has not turned over to me since his termination last year, retrieval of this information from 1st American Bank of Virginia is essential if we are to file a complete and accurate Year-End 1987 Report for this Committee with the F.E.C.

Please refer to my October 31st letter for details.

When, on November 17th, I had not received any of the information requested from 1st American Bank subsequent to my personal visit, October 24th, to its Falls Church and Tyson's Corners branches (cf. letter to the Bank, October 31st, enclosed), I telephoned Ms. Margie Baird, which whom I'd met at Tyson's Corners on October 24th.

She said she had no additional data for me since our meeting more than three weeks earlier. I again emphasized that she had said the information would be sent to me "in a week to ten days" after our visit, but that I still had not received it. I asked her to find out the status of my request and call me back. She did not.

I called 1st American Bank at Tyson's Corner again on November 22nd, speaking with Ms Peggy Marcy, an officer in Customer Services. I outlined our problems, the precise information I still needed, and emphasized that I had to have the information several days before the end of the month in order to file a Report on December 1st. She said she would check for me, but did not call me back. I called her again on November 25th, but she was unavailable and did not return my call.

Two days ago, on Monday, November 28th, I received a telephone message while I was out from Brian McDonough of 1st American Bank, informing me that the information was "being mailed today."

I returned his call within the hour it was received, and requested that the information be sent via overnight express mail or similar method. Mr. McDonough was noncommittal, despite my explanation of the importance of the matter, saying only, "I'll see what I can do."

As of today, we have received nothing, and if the data was sent via regular mail, I daresay it will not arrive until Friday or Saturday at the earliest.

I have just telephoned Mr. Eric Erdossy, President of 1st American Bank, Tyson's Corner's. He was unavailable, but his secretary took notes of my complaints, and said she would call me back.

On the basis of what information 1st American Bank sends me, I will complete a 1987 Year-End Report for the Committee, will revise 1988 Reports submitted earlier this year, and will file our Post-Election Report on or before December 8th.

I hope this will be satisfactory. I don't know what more I can possibly do at this time.

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



Dear Ms. Beard:

This is to inform the Commission that, despite our best efforts---including numerous telephone calls and travel to Washington---I have, to date, been unable to retrieve more than partial information about the financial transactions of National Pro-Life PAC, for the purpose of submitting a final, complete End-of-Year Report for 1987.

As you know, I fired Mr. Peter B. Gemma, Jr. as Executive Director of the PAC last year, but he did not comply with our repeated demands that he turn over all records and checkbooks immediately. To date, we still do not have complete records.

Repeated phone calls to him have gone unanswered (except by an answering machine); a phone call to Ms. Laura Halbmaier, former PAC Treasurer and Mr. Gemma's secretary, also was unproductive.

Seven months ago, I telephoned Ms. Alma Kasulaitis, an executive of the Falls Church branch of 1st American Bank of Virginia, the previous PAC depository, but she claimed that retrieving the information I requested (deposit and disbursement records) would be slow and expensive. I requested the information regardless.

When I had not been supplied with this information by October 1st, I again telephoned Ms. Kasulaitis, and again was informed of the difficulty of locating the information. I told her that I would go to Court, if necessary, and would personally come to Virginia to help locate this information.

As you know, I did indeed travel to Washington last week for this purpose as well as others.

When I met Ms. Kasulaitis, she supplied me only with records of deposits for the latter half of 1987, but no records of checks disbursed for that period. I again demanded that this information be given me within two weeks' time.

She also informed me for the first time that, contrary to information she had given me months ago, Mr. Gemma had not closed the PAC checking accounts in the final quarter of 1987, but had kept them open and had transacted business through them during 1988, closing one of them (#0624-7008) on April 25th, 1988, and the other (#0624-6850) on August 8th, 1988.

Had Ms. Kasulaitis not supplied me with erroneous information, I personally would have closed both accounts last November.

This new information about Mr. Gemma's illegal activities (as one fired from the PAC in 1987), now necessitates the retrieval of information from 1st American Bank records for the first three quarters of 1988 as well, so that we can amend our Reports for this year to date.

After speaking with Ms. Kasulaitis, I went to speak with Ms. Margie (Margarita R.) Baird, an officer of 1st American Bank at its records processing office, on Chain Bridge Road in McLean, Virginia.

Ms. Baird supplied me with deposit transaction records for 1987, but not for 1988. I informed her that I need to have records of all disbursements from both PAC accounts as soon as possible. She promised that she would supply them to me in "several weeks." I am sending a letter to Ms. Baird today via certified mail, reminding her of our request and underscoring its importance. A copy of that letter is enclosed.

I am requesting the Commission's permission to delay compliance with this aspect of our Conciliation Agreement (MUR#2627) for an additional thirty days, or until December 1st, 1988, by which time I should have complete information from the 1st American Bank.

I will expedite the completion of NP-L PAC's 1987 Year-End Report, and amended Reports for the first three quarters of 1988, necessitated by the erroneous information supplied to me by 1st American Bank about the dates when the PAC accounts were closed.

I will be in touch with you at my first opportunity once the Bank has fulfilled my requests. Please call me if you have any other questions.


