Dear Mr. Dickson:

Thank you for the information you provided during our conversation of November 14. As I explained at that time, I represent the WTL- Fund A. Our committee re-registered with the FEC in August, 1988. We filed our pre-primary report on September 20, 1988. That report covered our activities beginning with receipt of funds from National DRIVE on June 24, 1988, and continuing through August 31, 1988. When we received your General Election Report Notice dated October 3, 1988, we understood that if we had no activity, no additional reports would be required until our post general election report covering the period through November 28, 1988. As you explained in our conversation, we should have filed an October quarterly report to cover the period between September 1, 1988 and September 30, 1988. I am enclosing that report, which reflects no receipts or disbursements during the relevant period.

In order to avoid any possibility of error, we are also enclosing a Form 3X to cover our activity between October 1, 1988 and October 19, 1988. We understood from your October 3 release that no pre-election report was required because we had no activity. But we are enclosing a report confirming that there was no activity.

As we agreed during our conversation, by December 8, 1988 we will be mailing a Post-general Report covering October 20, 1988 through November 28, 1988. We will also be filing a Year-End Report in January, 1989.

**I. GENERATION OF MATTER**

The Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") referred the above eleven committees to the Office of the General Counsel on January 12, 1989. The basis for the attached referral is the committees' failure to file the 1988 October Quarterly Reports, or to do so in a timely fashion.

**II. FACTUAL AND LEGAL ANALYSIS**

**A. Filing of Reports**

The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"), provides that for unauthorized committees filing quarterly, such committees shall file quarterly reports in a calendar year in which a regularly scheduled general election is held. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(i). Quarterly Reports are to be filed no later than the 15th day after the last day of each calendar quarter. Thus, the due date for the October Quarterly Report was October 15, 1988. The following committees did not file the 1988 October Quarterly Report by this date:

Dear Mr. Frank:

On May 2, 1989, the Federal Election Commission found that there is reason to believe the Washington Teamsters Legislative League - Fund A ("Committee") and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(i), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). The Factual and Legal Analysis, which formed a basis for the Commission's finding, is attached for your information.

Under the Act, you have an opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against the Committee and you, as treasurer. You may submit any factual or legal materials that you believe are relevant to the Commission's consideration of this matter. Please submit such materials to the General Counsel's Office within 15 days of your receipt of this letter. Where appropriate, statements should be submitted under oath.

In the absence of any additional information demonstrating that no further action should be taken against the Committee and you, as treasurer, the Commission may find probable cause to believe that a violation has occurred and proceed with conciliation.

In order to expedite the resolution of this matter, the Commission has also decided to offer to enter into negotiations directed towards reaching a conciliation agreement in settlement of this matter prior to a finding of probable cause to believe. Enclosed is a conciliation agreement that the Commission has approved.

If you are interested in expediting the resolution of this matter by pursuing preprobable cause conciliation, and if you agree with the provisions of the enclosed agreement, please sign and return the agreement, along with the civil penalty, to the Commission. In light of the fact that conciliation negotiations, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, are limited to a maximum of 30 days, you should respond to this notification as soon as possible.


Requests for extensions of time will not be routinely granted. Requests must be made in writing at least five days prior to the due date of the response and specific good cause must be demonstrated. In addition, the Office of the General Counsel ordinarily will not give extensions beyond 20 days.

If you intend to be represented by counsel in this matter, please advise the Commission by completing the enclosed form stating the name, address, and telephone number of such counsel, and authorizing such counsel to receive any notifications and other communications from the Commission.

This matter will remain confidential in accordance with 2 U.S.C. §§ 437g(a)(4)(B) and 437g(a)(12)(A), unless you notify the Commission in writing that you wish the investigation to be made public.

For your information, we have attached a brief description of the Commission's procedures for handling possible violations of the Act. If you have any questions, please contact Janice Lacy, the attorney assigned to this matter, at (202) 376-8200.

Dear Ms. Weissenborn:

This letter will confirm the contents of our May 16, 1989 conversation. On May 15, 1989 the Washington Teamsters Legislative League (WTLL) received various materials from your office relating to the above-captioned matter. I am the attorney representing the WTLL-Fund A and Arnie Weinmeister, its Treasurer, and am responding on their behalf. The purpose of this letter is to submit factual materials demonstrating why no action should be taken against the Committee and against Mr. Weinmeister.

Your records will reflect that WTLL-Fund A's Statement of Organization was received by your office on August 17, 1988. Before WTLL received any materials from your office regarding our new FEC identification number, we submitted FEC Form 3X. This was dated September 2, 1988 and was a Pre-Primary Report. That report disclosed disbursement of \$12,000.00 out of the initial \$150,000.00 that had been received from DRIVE (the separate segregated fund of the International Brotherhood of Teamsters).

On September 30, 1988, WTLL received from your office the General Election Report Notice, dated October 3, 1988. Mr. Weinmeister's bookkeeper and I consulted regarding the filing dates indicated on that Notice. Because we knew that the Fund did not intend to make any Federal Election contributions, we concluded from our review of the document that our next filing date would be the post-general election filing on December 8, 1988. Enclosed with this letter is an affidavit from Marie Schattenkerk, bookkeeper for Arnie Weinmeister, reiterating that conversation. Attached to her affidavit is a copy of your Notice, which includes a note made by her on October 6, 1988 reciting that I "concurred report for next FEC to be on 12/8/88."

Frankly, at the time Ms. Schattenkerk and I conferred, I did not realize that the pre-election report was to be in addition to, rather than in lieu of, the quarterly filings. I was particularly confused because we had reported for the period through August 31, 1988 in


In addition to the absence of improper motive, there was a total absence of prejudice to the public's interest in being notified of political expenditures. There were no political expenditures to be reported during the relevant period. At all times, the exact status of the WTLF-Fund A accounts was conscientiously reported, albeit to the State PDC, rather than to the FEC.

In light of all these facts, we would ask that no action be taken against the WTLF-Fund A or against Mr. Weinmeister, as Treasurer.

Please contact me at your earliest convenience to discuss the status of this matter.

Thank you both for your prompt response to my May 15 phone call and for your continuing attention to this matter.

1. That I am over the age of eighteen (18) and am  
competent to testify in the matters stated herein.

2. I serve as the bookkeeper for Mr. Arnie  
Weinmeister with respect to the Washington Teamster  
Legislative League and the Washington Teamster Legislative  
League-Fund A.

3. On or about September 12, 1988 I received a large  
body of materials from the Federal Election Commission in  
response to our Statement of Organization that had been  
submitted in mid-August, 1988.

4. From my review of those materials, I assumed that  
the WTLL-Fund A was required to make quarterly reports as  
well as pre and post-election reports for the calendar year,  
1988.

5. On September 30, 1988, I received a General  
Election Report Notice from the Federal Election Commission  
regarding reporting in connection with the general election.  
From my review of the Notice, I inferred that the FEC was  
reducing the reporting obligations of non-active SSF's so  
that quarterly filers who did not make general election

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contributions were not required to report until they submitted their post-general election report on December 8, 1988.

6. I forwarded the General Election Report Notice to Mr. Oswald and we conferred regarding the document. Mr. Oswald and I agreed that the December 8, 1988 Report would cover the period from the close of books in the last report filing (August 30, 1988), through November 28, 1988.

7. Attached as Exhibit A to this Affidavit is a copy of the General Election Report Notice that I received, along with my notes from my October 6, 1988 telephone conversation with Mr. Oswald. Those notes were made on October 6, 1988, immediately after my conversation with him.

8. Until November 14, 1988, when we received a notice from the FEC, I was unaware that the WTLL-Fund A was out of compliance, based on our failure to file the report for September 1 through September 30, 1988.

9. During September and October, 1988, I prepared for Mr. Weinmeister's signature periodic reports to the Washington State Public Disclosure Commission. Those reports are attached as Exhibits B, C, and D to this Affidavit. Those reports fully and accurately reflect all receipts and expenditures by WTLL Fund-A during the month of September, 1988. In fact, there were no such receipts or expenditures, so all reports reflect a zero in both categories.

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10. On November 14, 1988 I received a Notice from the Federal Election Commission that our third quarter report was delinquent. I reported this matter to Mr. Oswald and began preparation of the requested reports.

11. The third quarter report was completed by our office on November 16, 1988 and mailed to the FEC on that date, along with a explanatory letter by Mr. Oswald to Paul Dickson of the FEC.

12. At all times, both before and since the end of November 14, 1988 I, along with Mr. Weinmeister, have conscientiously attempted to comply with all Federal and State disclosure requirements.



If this inquiry is not properly directed to you, I would be grateful if you could direct it to the proper office and advise me of the person to whom it has been directed.



1. In the alternative, the Respondents have requested that the Commission take no further action against them. In support of this request, they point to the fact that they had just come under the Commission's jurisdiction one month prior to when the report was due, to their confusion as to the meaning of a notice received from the Commission, and to the fact that they continued to make timely reports to the Washington State Public Disclosure Committee, thus evincing their commitment to satisfying all reporting requirements.

The Federal Election Campaign Act is very specific in addressing when quarterly reports are due and when pre-election reports are due. See 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(i), (ii). Moreover, the notice which served as the basis for the Respondents' confusion addressed the filing of the pre- and post-general reports, and in no way sought to advise political committees as to their obligations regarding quarterly reports. Thus, while Respondents' alleged confusion is unfortunate, it does not justify taking no further action.

13 unauthorized committee filing quarterly shall file quarterly  
14 reports in a calendar year in which a regularly scheduled election  
15 is held. Quarterly reports are to be filed no later than the 15th  
16 day after the last day of each calendar quarter.

17 4. Respondents were required to file the 1988 October  
18 Quarterly Report no later than October 15, 1988. Respondents did  
19 not file the October Quarterly Report until November 21, 1988,  
20 37 days late, disclosing \$0 in receipts and \$0 in disbursements.

21 V. Respondents failed to file the 1988 October Quarterly  
22 Report in a timely fashion in violation of 2 U.S.C.  
23 § 434(a)(4)(A)(i).

1 VI. 1. Respondents will pay a civil penalty to the Federal  
2 Election Commission in the amount of two hundred fifty dollars  
3 (\$250.00), pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(5)(A).

4 VII. The Commission, on request of anyone filing a complaint  
5 under 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1) concerning the matters at issue herein  
6 or on its own motion, may review compliance with this agreement.  
7 If the Commission believes that this agreement or any requirement  
8 thereof has been violated, it may institute a civil action for  
9 relief in the United States District Court for the District of  
10 Columbia.

11 VIII. This agreement shall become effective as of the date  
12 that all parties hereto have executed same and the Commission has  
13 approved the entire agreement.

14 IX. Respondents shall have no more than 30 days from the  
15 date this agreement becomes effective to comply with and implement
