- III. BACKGROUND:

Failure to Timely File Reports

The GOP Women's Political Action League (GOP Women's PAL PAC) ("the Committee") failed to file three (3) Reports of Receipts and Disbursements in a timely manner for the 1987-1988 election cycle (see Chart). The reports were filed between thirty-one (31) and fifty-nine (59) calendar days late.

On September 12, 1988, Ms. Julie Geddes telephoned about the 1988 July Quarterly Report. Ms. Geddes was told the report was late and should be filed immediately (Attachment 7).

On September 26, 1988, a Chronic Late Filing Notice was sent to the Committee for failure to file the 1988 April Quarterly and 1988 July Quarterly Reports in a timely manner (Attachment 9). The Notice advised the Committee that any additional late filing of reports may result in legal enforcement action.

On March 10, 1989, Ms. Gaylord telephoned from the Committee. She stated that the person responsible for filing reports had been let go and wanted to know what should be done about the 1988 Year End Report. The Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") analyst told Ms. Gaylord the report was late and should be filed immediately (Attachment 12).

^{1/} All prior notices and late filing notices were sent to P.O. Box 15477, Washington, DC 20003. This was the address of record until March 14, 1989, when an amended Statement of Organization was filed.





Dear Ms. Armstrong:

On May 16, 1989, the Federal Election Commission found that there is reason to believe the GOP Women's Political Action League (GOP Women's PAL PAC) ("Committee") and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(i), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). The Factual and Legal Analysis, which formed a basis for the Commission's finding, is attached for your information.

Under the Act, you have an opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against the Committee and you, as treasurer. You may submit any factual or legal materials that you believe are relevant to the Commission's consideration of this matter. Please submit such materials to the General Counsel's Office within 15 days of your receipt of this letter. Where appropriate, statements should be submitted under oath.

In the absence of any additional information demonstrating that no further action should be taken against the Committee and you, as treasurer, the Commission may find probable cause to believe that a violation has occurred and proceed with conciliation.

In order to expedite the resolution of this matter, the Commission has also decided to offer to enter into negotiations directed towards reaching a conciliation agreement in settlement of this matter prior to a finding of probable cause to believe. Enclosed is a conciliation agreement that the Commission has approved.

If you are interested in expediting the resolution of this matter by pursuing preprobable cause conciliation and if you agree with the provisions of the enclosed agreement, please sign and return the agreement, along with the civil penalty, to the Commission. In light of the fact that conciliation negotiations, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, are limited to a maximum of 30 days, you should respond to this notification as soon as possible.


Requests for extensions of time will not be routinely granted. Requests must be made in writing at least five days prior to the due date of the response and specific good cause must be demonstrated. In addition, the Office of the General Counsel ordinarily will not give extensions beyond 20 days.

If you intend to be represented by counsel in this matter, please advise the Commission by completing the enclosed form stating the name, address, and telephone number of such counsel, and authorizing such counsel to receive any notifications and other communications from the Commission.

This matter will remain confidential in accordance with 2 U.S.C. §§ 437g(a)(4)(B) and 437g(a)(12)(A), unless you notify the Commission in writing that you wish the investigation to be made public.

For your information, we have attached a brief description of the Commission's procedures for handling possible violations of the Act. If you have any questions, please contact Sandra J. Dunham, the staff member assigned to this matter, at (202) 376-8200.

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



CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

This matter was initiated by the Federal Election Commission ("Commission"), pursuant to information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. The Commission found reason to believe that the GOP Women's Political Action League (GOP Women's PAL PAC) ("Respondents") violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) (4) (A) (i).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission and the Respondents, having participated in informal methods of conciliation, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, do hereby agree as follows:

I. The Commission has jurisdiction over the Respondents and the subject matter of this proceeding, and this agreement has the effect of an agreement entered pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g (a) (4) (A) (i).

II. Respondents have had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.

III. Respondents enter voluntarily into this agreement with the Commission.

IV. The pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:

1. The GOP Women's Political Action League (GOP Women's PAL PAC) is a political committee within the meaning of 2 U.S.C. § 431(4).

2. Alexandra Armstrong is the treasurer of the GOP Women's Political Action League (GOP Women's PAL PAC).

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3. Respondents failed to file three (3) reports of receipts and disbursements in a timely manner.

4. The reports were filed between 31 and 59 days late as follows:

5. The 1988 April Quarterly Report disclosed \$6,426 in receipts and \$8,736 in disbursements; the 1988 July Quarterly Report disclosed \$5,010 in receipts and \$3,829 in disbursements; and the 1988 Year End Report disclosed \$0 in receipts and \$152 in disbursements.

V. 1. Respondents failed to timely file reports in violation of 2 U.S.C. 434 (a) (4) (A) (i).

2. Respondents have taken corrective action to insure there will be no further problems in filing reports in a timely manner.

VI. Respondents will pay a civil penalty to the Federal Election Commission in the amount of Nine Hundred dollars (\$900.00), pursuant to 2 U.S.C. 437g(a) (5) (A).

VII. The Commission, on request of anyone filing a complaint under 2 U.S.C. 437g (a) (1) concerning the matters at issue herein or on its own motion, may review compliance with this agreement. If the Commission believes that this agreement or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute a civil

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action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

VIII. This agreement shall become effective as of the date that all parties hereto have executed same and the Commission has approved the entire agreement.

IX. Respondents shall have no more than 30 days from the date this agreement becomes effective to comply with and implement the requirements contained in this agreement and to so notify the Commission.

X. This Conciliation Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties on the matters raised herein, and no other statement, promise, or agreement, either written or oral, made by either party or by agents of either party, that is not contained in this written agreement shall be enforceable.
