III. BACKGROUND:

Failure to Timely File the 1989 Mid-Year Report

The Oregon Republican Party (the "Party") failed to file the 1989 Mid-Year Report of Receipts and Disbursements covering the period from January 1, 1989 to June 30, 1989 in a timely manner. The Party was notified that the report was due on July 31, 1989 (Attachment 2). A Non-Filer Notice was sent to the Party on August 23, 1989 (Attachment 6).

On September 13, 1989, the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") analyst called the treasurer of the Party, Mr. Fred G. Capell. Mr. Capell was not available so the analyst left a message that the Commission had not received the Party's 1989 Mid-Year Report (Attachment 4). Later this same day, Mr. Bob Kelsey called the analyst. Mr. Kelsey said the Party mailed the 1989 Mid-Year Report to the Commission by certified mail. The analyst told Mr. Kelsey to mail a copy of the 1989 Mid-Year Report and a photocopy of the certified mail receipt (Attachment 5).

On September 25, 1989, Mr. Kelsey called the RAD analyst and stated that he had not been able to mail the 1989 Mid-Year Report because of a family emergency. The RAD analyst told Mr. Kelsey to mail the 1989 Mid-Year Report, a photocopy of the certified mail receipt, and a cover letter explaining the delay as soon as possible (Attachment 6).

On September 28, 1989, the Commission received the Committee's 1989 Mid-Year Report. The report covered the period from January 1, 1989 to June 2, 1989 (Attachment 7). This report was designated as a Termination Report. Additionally, there appears to be a mathematical discrepancy between the ending cash-



Dear Mr. Capell:

On November 14, 1989, the Federal Election Commission found that there is reason to believe the Oregon Republican Party ("Committee") and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iv), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). The Factual and Legal Analysis, which formed a basis for the Commission's finding, is attached for your information.

Under the Act, you have an opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against the Committee and you, as treasurer. You may submit any factual or legal materials that you believe are relevant to the Commission's consideration of this matter. Please submit such materials to the General Counsel's Office within 15 days of your receipt of this letter. Where appropriate, statements should be submitted under oath.

In the absence of any additional information demonstrating that no further action should be taken against the Committee and you, as treasurer, the Commission may find probable cause to believe that a violation has occurred and proceed with conciliation.

In order to expedite the resolution of this matter, the Commission has also decided to offer to enter into negotiations directed towards reaching a conciliation agreement in settlement of this matter prior to a finding of probable cause to believe. Enclosed is a conciliation agreement that the Commission has approved.

If you are interested in expediting the resolution of this matter by pursuing probable cause conciliation and if you agree with the provisions of the enclosed agreement, please sign and return the agreement, along with the civil penalty, to the

Commission. In light of the fact that conciliation negotiations, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, are limited to a maximum of 30 days, you should respond to this notification as soon as possible.

Requests for extensions of time will not be routinely granted. Requests must be made in writing at least five days prior to the due date of the response and specific good cause must be demonstrated. In addition, the Office of the General Counsel ordinarily will not give extensions beyond 20 days.

If you intend to be represented by counsel in this matter, please advise the Commission by completing the enclosed form stating the name, address, and telephone number of such counsel, and authorizing such counsel to receive any notifications and other communications from the Commission.

This matter will remain confidential in accordance with 2 U.S.C. §§ 437g(a)(4)(B) and 437g(a)(12)(A), unless you notify the Commission in writing that you wish the investigation to be made public.

For your information, we have attached a brief description of the Commission's procedures for handling possible violations of the Act. If you have any questions, please contact Sandra H. Robinson, the attorney assigned to this matter, at (202) 376-8200.

Please be advised that information derived in connection with any conciliation attempt will not become public without the written consent of the respondent and the Commission. See 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(4)(B). The enclosed conciliation agreement, however, will become a part of the public record.

CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

This matter was initiated by the Federal Election Commission ("Commission"), pursuant to information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. The Commission found reason to believe that the Oregon Republican Party and its treasurer, ("Respondents") violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iv).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission and the Respondents, having participated in informal methods of conciliation, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, do hereby agree as follows:

I. The Commission has jurisdiction over the Respondents and the subject matter of this proceeding, and this agreement has the effect of an agreement entered pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(4)(A)(i).

II. Respondents have had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.

III. Respondents enter voluntarily into this agreement with the Commission.

IV. The pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:

1. The Oregon Republican Party is a political committee within the meaning of 2 U.S.C. § 431(4).

2. Nancy E. Steinhoff is the treasurer of the Oregon Republican Party.

3. The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act") provides that for political committees which are not authorized committees and file quarterly, such committees shall file a Mid-Year Report for any calendar year in which there is not a regularly scheduled election. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iv). The Mid-Year Report shall cover the period from January 1 through June 30 and shall be filed no later than July 31.

4. The 1989 Mid-Year Report was due on July 31, 1989. The Respondents did not file the 1989 Mid-Year Report until September 28, 1989, 59 days late.

V. Respondents failed to timely file the 1989 Mid-Year Report in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iv).

VI. Respondents will pay a civil penalty to the Federal Election Commission in the amount of three hundred and seventy-five dollars (\$375.00), pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(5)(A).

VII. The Commission, on request of anyone filing a complaint under 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1) concerning the matters at issue herein or on its own motion, may review compliance with this agreement. If the Commission believes that this agreement or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute a civil action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

VIII. This agreement shall become effective as of the date that all parties hereto have executed same and the Commission has approved the entire agreement.

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IX. Respondents shall have no more than 30 days from the date this agreement becomes effective to comply with and implement the requirement contained in this agreement and to so notify the Commission.

X. This Conciliation Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties on the matters raised herein, and no other statement, promise, or agreement, either written or oral, made by either party or by agents of either party, that is not contained in this written agreement shall be enforceable.
