

The attached General Counsel's Report recommending that that captioned matter be closed is being recirculated on a no-objection basis. The report has been redrafted in accordance with Commissioner Tiernan's suggestions, and with a further suggestion by the General Counsel's office. The recent history of the matter is as follows:

An earlier draft of the General Counsel's Report with a recommendation to close was presented at the Commission meeting of June 15th. The Commission voted unanimously to close the matter, and for the report to be revised. A revised version was circulated on June 27th on a no-objection basis, at which time Commissioner Tiernan objected and made his suggestions.

Analysis

The copy of the script of the advertisement submitted by the respondent indicates that the notice of authorization required by 2 U.S.C. §441d, was placed in the script. The complainant argued that while a "tiny line of print (too small to read) flashed on the screen for about a second," there was no voice announcement of the sponsor, and therefore the requirements of §441d were not fulfilled.

Under the Commission's present rules and regulations, a televised political advertisement which advocates the election or defeat of a clearly identified candidate must place an authorization statement "at the beginning or end of a broadcast or telecast matter." However, the Commission has not established standards as to the specific form (voice or print) or the exact manner (size or duration) of a telecast authorization statement. (See Part 110.11 of the Commission's regulations and Federal Election Commission Notice 1976-55, Notice of Authorization on Political Communications). This absence of standards, combined with the facts of this matter, provide no basis to determine that respondent's notice of authorization was insufficient.



SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS

David L. Chatfield, the complainant, in a notarized complaint, filed October 24, 1976, alleged that the Concerned New Yorkers for Abe Hirschfeld Inc., the Respondent, sponsored a televised political commercial which gave insufficient information of authorization or non-authorization. The advertisement appeared on September 13, 1976 at 10:30p.m. on television station WTEN in the Albany, New York area.

Evidence

In response to the Commission's preliminary inquiry, the respondent stated that "the required political disclosure appeared" and that the Abe Hirschfeld committee was informed of a requirement of disclosing the sponsor of an advertisement in order for it to appear on the television station. The respondent submitted a copy of the script of the advertisement, showing that the notice of authorization appeared.

Analysis



the respondent, indicates that the notice of authorization required by 2 U.S.C. §441d, was placed in the script. The complainant argued that a voice announcement of the sponsor of a televised political advertisement, which advocates the defeat of a candidate, is necessary to fulfill the requirements of §441d. In light of the Commission's present rules and regulations, however, there has been no determination as to whether a voice announcement of the sponsor of a televised political advertisement is required. (See Federal Election Commission Notice 1976-55, Notice of Authorization on Political Communications) Consequently, there is no present standard by which to determine whether the respondent's notice of authorization is sufficient or not. It is anticipated that this problem will be dealt with by the Commission in the near future.

Recommendation

On the basis of the information received that the notice was on the script, we recommend that no further action be taken and that the file be closed, and send attached letters.

I am in receipt of your letter dated December 29, 1976 and am responding now, my first opportunity since returning from holiday vacation.

Throughout our campaign we were very careful to comply with all aspects of the Federal Election Campaign Act and in particular with the requirements concerning stating the name of the candidate authorizing advertising. All of our advertising conspicuously stated that we were their authority. This requirement is well-known by the television stations broadcasting political advertising. The television stations themselves strictly adhere to Federal Election Commission requirements and do not carry any advertising that does comply therewith. The television stations are excellent monitors of political advertising. This particular advertisement being complained of was carried throughout New York State and not merely on station WTEN where it was viewed by the complainant. Clearly, if this advertisement was deemed acceptable by major television stations in New York City, Albany and Buffalo, it had to comply with Federal requirements.

Occasionally, it happens that a television station will make an error in broadcasting a particular advertising. Sometimes an advertisement will be cut off near the end through the fault of the television station itself. It may be that such an error occurred



Thanks for your letter of October 19, 1976, acknowledging receipt of my complaint about campaign practices of the Hirschfeld for Senate Committee. Personal attention from a person in your position is certainly appreciated in this matter.

Since you observe that I "may be aware" of the complaint procedure, and cite some sort of regulation concerning same, perhaps you assume I was somehow involved in the campaign, or that I am a lawyer. I have never met or talked to Rep. Abzug nor anyone on her staff or involved in her campaign. For that matter, I don't know anyone involved with any candidate in the Senate campaigns. I am not a lawyer, and "2 U.S.C. § 437g (a) (2)" means about as much to me as a Peruvian zip code. I am a private citizen living in a small town in upstate New York, angered by what I perceive to be an unethical campaign practice in a U.S. Senatorial primary race, and seeking redress as a member of the Electorate. Since there are laws governing the conduct of campaigns for Federal offices, I hope that the practice at issue violates those laws, but am not certain what does constitute a violation.

Bella Abzug. A male voice recited a list of wild, undocumented charges against Rep. Abzug, using her name, including assertions that she used "doctored" tapes against her opponent in her last Congressional election, and personally halted construction on Manhattan's West Side Highway. There was no voice announcement of the commercial's sponsor, but a tiny line of print (too small to read) flashed on the screen for about a second. I find this kind of "eleventh hour" smear politics disgusting, regardless of whom the target is. I called WTEN (518) 436-4822 the next morning to find out who sponsored the commercial. I was informed by their Program Department that the

As you requested, I called the above committee to ascertain if they were including non-campaign receipts and expenditures in the disclosure reports of the committee.

Frank Ceo returned my call today. He stated the committee formed an incorporated business to make a profit for the campaign as he specializes in construction projects. He did not tell me just what it was they built - but their reasoning seemed to be tax-motivated.

He further stated that the committee had submitted an advisory opinion to the Commission but never received a response. The only AO I find in the index is AO 1975-62 which requests whether or not the payment of fundraising costs by a contributor constitutes a contribution. Mr. Ceo did not go into detail about the transactions reported in the report - he just mentioned they had a lot of press inquiries. It does seem a bit far-out. I would suggest you consider having one of the senior investigators from AID look into this further.

a reporter from New York called about Hershfeld for Senate Jan. 31 report.

apparently Hershfeld's parking garage company (reporter didn't know if it is corporation) gave the campaign \$190,000 to do sub-contract work in the company's garage - total cost to committee came to about \$120,000 - they are claiming the \$70,000 different apparently as a "profit" ! ! ! !

I told the reporter I couldn't comment on an actual case - particularly one that would depend on technical facts such as whether the company is a corporation, what the personal relationship of the candidate to the company is, what the contract was between the committee and the company, and what the actual nature of the \$70,000 was.

I said that without speaking in any way as to this case, there could be problems of corporate contributions, and of the initial money being treated as an advance or loan rather than a legitimate business transaction, but that again this depended on a more thorough analysis of the actual facts.

apparently the committee is quite open about this situation, and pleased as punch with their finesse in getting around the law. the committee told the reporter "we wondered when someone would get around to galling about this."

The reporter asked to be kept informed. I went through the confidentiality requirements if it was something we looked into. He may call back to ask for an acknowledgment at some time as to whether we are looking into it.

I also said it wasn't clear what we would be doing with any investigatory work because of court suit
