III. BACKGROUND:

Loans Received from the Connected Organization

The Teamsters Local 959 Alaska Labor Independent Voter Education committee ("the Committee") disclosed a loan received from its connected organization, the General Teamsters Local 959 ("the General Fund"), on its 1990 July Quarterly Report. The loan was received on April 12, 1990 and totalled \$8,000 (Attachment 2). The Committee repaid the loan on October 1, 1990 as disclosed on the Committee's 1990 30 Day Post-General Report (Attachment 3). Schedule A of the 1990 30 Day Post-General Report, however, disclosed the receipt of an additional loan totalling \$10,000 from the General Fund on October 4, 1990 (Attachment 4). Schedule A of the Committee's 1991 Mid-Year Report disclosed yet another loan from the General Fund totalling \$1,000 on March 4, 1991 (Attachment 5). Finally, on Schedule B of the Committee's 1991 October Quarterly Report a loan repayment to the General Fund totalling \$11,000 was disclosed as being made on September 10, 1991 (Attachment 6).

On January 7, 1992, the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") analyst sent an Informational Notice to the Committee on the 1991 October Quarterly Report and on January 10, 1992

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Informational Notices were sent for the 1990 July Quarterly and 30 Day Post-General Reports and the 1991 Mid-Year Report. The notices advised the Committee that receipt of funds, including loans, from national banks, corporations, labor organizations and their local chapters was prohibited by 2 U.S.C. §441b (Attachments 7, 8, and 9).

On January 15, 1992, the RAD analyst placed a telephone call to Ms. Jackie Browning, Deputy Treasurer/Controller of the Committee. She was informed that notices had been sent regarding the contributions/loans from their connected organization during the 1990 and 1992 election cycles. The Notices also would explain why this activity was prohibited and what action the Commission would take. She said she would wait until the Notices arrived before responding (Attachment 10).

In a letter dated January 22, 1992 from the Committee, Ms. Browning said she received the Notices and would respond when the new treasurer was able to sign the amended reports (Attachment 11).

On January 31, 1992, the Committee filed an amended 1991 October Quarterly Report. In addition to again showing the repayment of the loan, the Committee also notes in a cover letter that interest was paid on the loan (Attachment 12).





I. GENERATION OF MATTER

This matter was referred to the Office of the General Counsel from the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") in accordance with the RAD Review and Referral Procedures for Unauthorized Committees.

II. FACTUAL AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

The 1990 July Quarterly, 30 Day Post-General and 1991 Mid Year Reports filed by the Teamsters Local 959 Alaska Labor Independent Voter Education (the "Committee") disclose that the Committee accepted contributions of \$8,000, \$10,000 and \$1,000, respectively, from the General Teamsters Local 959 (the "Union"), its connected organization which is a labor union. See Attachment 1, pages 6 -22. These contributions were in the form of loans. Reports filed by the Committee disclose that on October 1, 1990, and on September 10, 1991, the Committee made

1. At the time of the violation, John Creed was the treasurer for the committee.

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loan repayments of \$8,000 and \$11,000, respectively, to the Union. Id. at pages 12 and 21. Additionally, the Committee reports paying \$959.04 in interest payments to the Union. Id. at page 33.

On January 7 and 10, 1992, RAD sent the Committee Requests for Additional Information ("RFAIs") concerning the receipt of the \$19,000 from the Union. Id. at pages 23 - 26. In the response to the RFAIs, a representative for the Committee stated "we did not know this was prohibited." The response noted that the loans were repaid with interest and that the Committee will no longer receive loans from the Union. Id. at page 29.

According to 2 U.S.C. § 441b(a) it is unlawful for a corporation or labor organization to make a contribution or expenditure in connection with any federal election or for any political committee to knowingly accept such contribution. And, 2 U.S.C. § 441b(b) defines contribution or expenditure to include any direct or indirect payment, loan, advance, or any services, or anything of value.

Therefore, the Office of the General Counsel recommends that the Commission find reason to believe Teamsters Local 959 Alaska Labor Independent Voter Education and Mark S. Johnson, as treasurer, and the General Teamsters Local 959 violated 2 U.S.C. § 441b(a).

III. DISCUSSION OF CONCILIATION AND CIVIL PENALTY

On May 5, 1992, the Federal Election Commission found that there is reason to believe Teamsters Local 959 Alaska Labor Independent Voter Education (the "Committee") and you, as treasurer, and General Teamsters Local 959 (the "Union") violated 2 U.S.C. § 441b(a), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). The Factual and Legal Analysis, which formed a basis for the Commission's finding, is attached for your information.

Under the Act, you have an opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against the Committee and you, as treasurer, and the Union. You may submit any factual or legal materials that you believe are relevant to the Commission's consideration of this matter. Please submit such materials to the General Counsel's Office within 15 days of your receipt of this letter. Where appropriate, statements should be submitted under oath.

In the absence of any additional information demonstrating that no further action should be taken against the Committee and you, as treasurer, and the Union, the Commission may find probable cause to believe that a violation has occurred and proceed with conciliation.

In order to expedite the resolution of this matter, the Commission has also decided to offer to enter into negotiations directed towards reaching a conciliation agreement in settlement of this matter prior to a finding of probable cause to believe. Enclosed is a conciliation agreement that the Commission has approved.

If you are interested in expediting the resolution of this matter by pursuing preprobable cause conciliation and if you agree with the provisions of the enclosed agreement, please sign and return the agreement, along with the civil penalty, to the Commission. In light of the fact that conciliation negotiations, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, are limited to a maximum of 30 days, you should respond to this notification as soon as possible.

Requests for extensions of time will not be routinely granted. Requests must be made in writing at least five days prior to the due date of the response and specific good cause must be demonstrated. In addition, the Office of the General Counsel ordinarily will not give extensions beyond 20 days.

If you intend to be represented by counsel in this matter, please advise the Commission by completing the enclosed form stating the name, address, and telephone number of such counsel, and authorizing such counsel to receive any notifications and other communications from the Commission.

This matter will remain confidential in accordance with 2 U.S.C. §§ 437g(a)(4)(B) and 437g(a)(12)(A), unless you notify the Commission in writing that you wish the investigation to be made public.

The 1990 July Quarterly, 30 Day Post-General and 1991 Mid Year Reports filed by the Teamsters Local 959 Alaska Labor Independent Voter Education (the "Committee") disclose that the Committee accepted contributions of \$8,000, \$10,000 and \$1,000, respectively, from the General Teamsters Local 959 (the "Union"), its connected organization which is a labor organization. These contributions were in the form of loans. Reports filed by the Committee disclose that on October 1, 1990, and September 10, 1991, the Committee made loan repayments to the Union of \$8,000 and \$11,000, respectively.

On January 7 and 10, 1992, the Commission sent the Committee Requests for Additional Information ("RFAIs") concerning the receipt of the \$19,000 from the Union. In the response to the RFAIs, a representative for the Committee stated "we did not know this was prohibited." The response noted that the loans were repaid with interest and that the Committee will no longer receive loans from the Union.

According to 2 U.S.C. § 441b(a) it is unlawful for a corporation or labor organization to make a contribution or expenditure in connection with any federal election or for any political committee to knowingly accept such contribution. And,

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include any direct or indirect payment, loan, advance, or any services, or anything of value.

Therefore, there is reason to believe Teamsters Local 959 Alaska Labor Independent Voter Education and Mark S. Johnson, as treasurer, and General Teamsters Local 959 violated 2 U.S.C. § 441b(a).

We received your letter dated May 18 on May 26, 1992. While we agree with the facts regarding dates of loans made by Teamsters Local 959 to A.L.I.V.E. - Voluntary and repayments of those loans in 1990 and 1991, we believe there are circumstances you have not considered:

* The loans were made to A.L.I.V.E. - Voluntary (Federal Committee) in error. The accounting department of Teamsters Local 959 was not aware of the prohibition of the labor union placing the loan funds in the Federal Committee account. The loan was made to the Federal Committee only because other allowed contributions currently go through the Federal Committee account and are transferred to A.L.I.V.E. - Regular (State Committee). In prior years, all loans were made, in accordance with the law, to the State Committee.

* All proceeds of the loan were subsequently transferred to the State Committee to be used in state and local elections. No proceeds of the loan received from Local 959 were used to directly or indirectly influence a federal election. Your Factual and Legal Analysis states "According to 2 U.S.C. S 441b(a) it is unlawful for a corporation or labor organization to make a contribution or expenditure in connection with any federal election or for any political committee to knowingly accept such contribution. And, include any direct or indirect payment, loan, advance, or any services, or anything of value." Again, the loan was not made in connection with any federal election. The only contribution made since 1988 to influence a federal election was a \$250 contribution to Bennett Johnston in June of 1990; the Federal Committee had sufficient funds to make this contribution without using the proceeds of the loan from Local 959. Again, the purpose of the loans was to provide funds in support of state and local elections, and the Federal

Committee account was used only to deposit the funds and transfer them to the State Committee (again, an accounting error).

* The loan made in 1990 was not addressed by the F.E.C. until 1992. Had we been informed of this violation in 1990 or 1991, the 1991 loan would not have been made to the Federal Committee


Local 959 and A.L.I.V.E. have always been conscious of the law prohibiting the use of the labor union's funds to influence federal elections. The loans were discovered by the Federal Election Commission because they were properly reported on the required F.E.C. reports. There was no effort made to conceal the loans, again because we did not know making the loans to the Federal Committee was in violation of the law.

We are anxious to resolve this matter and are willing to come to Washington, D.C. to discuss this matter in an attempt to resolve it.





CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

This matter was initiated by the Federal Election Commission ("Commission"), pursuant to information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. The Commission found reason to believe that Teamsters Local 959 Alaska Labor Independent Voter Education and Mark S. Johnson, as treasurer, and General Teamsters Local 959 ("Respondents") violated 2 U.S.C. § 441b(a).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission and the Respondents, having participated in informal methods of conciliation, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, do hereby agree as follows:

I. The Commission has jurisdiction over the Respondents and the subject matter of this proceeding, and this agreement has the effect of an agreement entered pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(4)(A)(i).

II. Respondents have had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.

III. Respondents enter voluntarily into this agreement with the Commission.

IV. The pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:

1. Teamsters Local 959 Alaska Labor Independent Voter

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Education is a political committee within the meaning of 2 U.S.C. § 431(4).

2. Mark S. Johnson is the treasurer of Teamsters Local 959 Alaska Labor Independent Voter Education.

3. General Teamsters Local 959 is a labor organization which has established Teamsters Local 959 Alaska Labor Independent Voter Education as a separate segregated fund.

4. The 1990 July Quarterly, 30 Day Post-General and 1991 Mid Year Reports filed by the Teamsters Local 959 Alaska Labor Independent Voter Education (the "Committee") disclose that the Committee accepted contributions of \$8,000, \$10,000 and \$1,000, respectively, from the General Teamsters Local 959 (the "Union"). These contributions were in the form of loans.

5. Reports filed by the Committee disclose that on October 1, 1990, and September 10, 1991, the Committee made loan repayments to the Union of \$8,000 and \$11,000, respectively.

V. General Teamsters Local 959 made and the Teamsters Local 959 Alaska Labor Independent Voter Education and Mark S. Johnson, as treasurer, knowingly accepted contributions totaling \$19,000 in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 441b(a).

VI. Respondents will pay a civil penalty to the Federal Election Commission in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000), pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(5)(A).

VII. The Commission, on request of anyone filing a complaint under 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1) concerning the matters at issue herein or on its own motion, may review compliance with this agreement. If the Commission believes that this agreement

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or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute a civil action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

VIII. This agreement shall become effective as of the date that all parties hereto have executed same and the Commission has approved the entire agreement.

IX. Respondents shall have no more than 30 days from the date this agreement becomes effective to comply with and implement the requirements contained in this agreement and to so notify the Commission.

X. This Conciliation Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties on the matters raised herein, and no other statement, promise, or agreement, either written or oral, made by either party or by agents of either party, that is not contained in this written agreement shall be enforceable.


