III. BACKGROUND:

Failure to File Forty-Eight Hour Notifications

The Wynn-PAC ("the Committee") has failed to file 13 of 19, or 68%, of the required Forty-Eight Hour Notifications ("48-Hour Notices") for contributions totalling \$21,000 received prior to the 1992 General Election.

The candidate was involved in the 1992 General Election held on November 3, 1992. Prior Notice was sent to the Committee on September 28, 1992 (Attachment 2). The Notice includes a section titled "48 Hour Notices on Contributions". This section reads "Notices are required if the committee receives contributions (including contributions and loans from the candidate's personal funds; and endorsements or guarantees of bank loans) of \$1,000 or more, during the period of October 15 through October 31. The notices must reach the appropriate federal and state filing offices within 48 hours of the committee's receipt of the contribution(s)."

Schedule A of the 1992 30 Day Post-General Report indicates that the Committee failed to file thirteen (13) 48-Hour Notices for contributions received during the aforementioned period (Attachment 3). The following is a list of the contributions for which no 48-Hour Notices were filed:

The Notice notes on an informational basis that the Committee may have failed to file one or more of the required 48-Hour Notices for "last minute" contributions of \$1,000 or more. The notice requests the Committee to review their procedures for checking contributions received during the aforementioned time period. In addition, the notice states that although the Commission may take legal steps, any response would be taken into consideration.

The Committee's June 30th response does not address this matter.

The notices must reach the appropriate federal and state filing offices within 48 hours of the committee's receipt of the contribution(s).

LABEL

Committees should affix the peel-off label from the envelope to Line 1 of the report. Corrections should be made on the label.



Although the Commission may take legal action, any response you wish to make concerning this matter will be taken into consideration. (11 CFR §104.5(2))

I. GENERATION OF MATTER

The Office of the General Counsel received a referral from the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") on August 17, 1993. Attachment 1. The basis for the attached referral is the failure of Wynn-PAC, now known as Re-Elect Albert Wynn to Congress, and Charles E. Moulden, as treasurer, ("Respondents")¹ to timely file forty-eight hour notifications ("48 Hour Notices") for thirteen (13) contributions totaling \$21,000. The \$21,000 is comprised of five (5) contributions from individuals totaling \$6,000 and eight (8) contributions from political action committees totaling \$15,000. Mr. Wynn

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won the 1992 General Election in the fourth (4th) Congressional District in the State of Maryland with seventy-six percent (76%) of the vote.

Based on the Factual and Legal Analysis, Attachment 2, this Office recommends the Commission find reason to believe Respondents violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(A).

On February 8, 1994, the Federal Election Commission found that there is reason to believe Re-Elect Albert Wynn to Congress and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(A), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). The Factual and Legal Analysis, which formed a basis for the Commission's finding, is attached for your information.

You may submit any factual or legal materials that you believe are relevant to the Commission's consideration of this matter. Please submit such materials to the General Counsel's Office within 15 days of your receipt of this letter. Where appropriate, statements should be submitted under oath. In the absence of additional information, the Commission may find probable cause to believe that a violation has occurred and proceed with conciliation.

In order to expedite the resolution of this matter, the Commission has also decided to offer to enter into negotiations directed towards reaching a conciliation agreement in settlement of this matter prior to a finding of probable cause to believe. Enclosed is a conciliation agreement that the Commission has approved.

If you are interested in expediting the resolution of this matter by pursuing preprobable cause conciliation and if you agree with the provisions of the enclosed agreement, please sign and return the agreement, along with the civil penalty, to the Commission. In light of the fact that conciliation negotiations, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, are limited to a maximum of 30 days, you should respond to this notification as soon as possible.

This matter was generated based on information ascertained by the Federal Election Commission ("the Commission") in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. See 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(2).

The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, ("the Act") requires principal campaign committees of candidates for federal office to notify in writing either the Secretary of the Senate, the Clerk of the U.S. House of Representatives or the Commission, as appropriate, and the Secretary of State, of each contribution totaling \$1,000 or more received by any authorized committee of the candidate after the 20th day but more than 48 hours before any election. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(A). The Act further requires notification to be made within 48 hours after the receipt of the contribution and to include the name of the candidate and office sought, the date of receipt, the amount of the contribution, and the identification of the contributor. Id. The notification of these contributions shall be in addition to all other reporting requirements. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(B).

The General Election in the state of Maryland was held on November 3, 1992. Pursuant to the Act, Respondents were required to notify the Commission, in writing, of all contributions of \$1,000 or more received from October 15 through October 31, 1992,

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within 48 hours of their receipt. A review of the Committee's 1992 30 Day Post-General Report identified thirteen (13) contributions received between October 15 and October 31, 1992, of \$1,000 or more totaling \$21,000. 

On April 4, 1994, the Federal Election Commission accepted the signed conciliation agreement and civil penalty submitted by Re-Elect Albert Wynn to Congress and you, as treasurer, in settlement of a violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(A), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). Accordingly, the file has been closed in this matter.

The confidentiality provisions at 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(12) no longer apply and this matter is now public. In addition, although the complete file must be placed on the public record within 30 days, this could occur at any time following certification of the Commission's vote. If you wish to submit any factual or legal materials to appear on the public record, please do so as soon as possible. While the file may be placed on the public record before receiving your additional materials, any permissible submissions will be added to the public record upon receipt.

Please be advised that information derived in connection with any conciliation attempt will not become public without the written consent of the respondents and the Commission. See 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(4)(B). The enclosed conciliation agreement, however, will become a part of the public record.

CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

This matter was initiated by the Federal Election Commission ("Commission"), pursuant to information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. The Commission found reason to believe that Re-Elect Albert Wynn to Congress and its treasurer ("Respondents") violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(A).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission and Respondents, having participated in informal methods of conciliation, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, do hereby agree as follows:

I. The Commission has jurisdiction over Respondents and the subject matter of this proceeding, and this agreement has the effect of an agreement entered pursuant to 2 U.S.C.

§ 437g(a)(4)(A)(i).

II. Respondents have had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.

III. Respondents enter voluntarily into this agreement with the Commission.

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IV. The pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:

1. Wynn-PAC, now known as Re-Elect Albert Wynn to Congress, is a political committee within the meaning of 2 U.S.C. § 431(4). On December 16, 1993, the Committee changed its name from Wynn-PAC to Re-Elect Albert Wynn to Congress. Wynn-PAC was the authorized principal campaign committee for Albert Wynn's 1992 congressional campaign, and Re-Elect Albert Wynn to Congress is the authorized principal campaign committee for Albert Wynn's 1994 congressional campaign.

2. The present treasurer of Re-Elect Albert Wynn to Congress is Delphine Hall-Anderson. Charles E. Moulden was the treasurer of Wynn-PAC during the time period relevant to this matter.

3. The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, ("the Act") requires principal campaign committees of candidates for federal office to notify, in writing, either the Secretary of the Senate, the Clerk of the U.S. House of Representatives or the Commission, as appropriate, and the Secretary of State, of each contribution totaling \$1,000 or more received by any authorized committee of the candidate after the 20th day but more than 48 hours before any election. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(A). The Act further requires notification to be made within 48 hours after the receipt of the contribution and to include the name of the candidate and office sought, the date of receipt, the amount of the contribution, and the identification of the contributor. Id.

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The notification of these contributions shall be in addition to all other reporting requirements. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(B).

4. Between October 15 and October 31, 1992, Respondents received thirteen (13) contributions of \$1,000 or more totaling \$21,000. Respondents did not submit 48 Hour Notices for these contributions.

V. Respondents failed to report campaign contributions of \$1,000 or more received after the 20th day, but more than 48 hours before the General Election, within 48 hours of receipt of the contributions, in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(A).

VI. Respondents will pay a civil penalty to the Federal Election Commission in the amount of three thousand, nine hundred dollars (\$3,900), pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(5)(A).

VII. The Commission, on request of anyone filing a complaint under 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1) concerning the matters at issue herein or on its own motion, may review compliance with this agreement. If the Commission believes that this agreement or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute a civil action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

VIII. This agreement shall become effective as of the date that all parties hereto have executed same and the Commission has approved the entire agreement.

IX. Respondents shall have no more than 30 days from the date this agreement becomes effective to comply with and implement the requirement contained in this agreement and to so notify the Commission.


