III. BACKGROUND:

Chronic Late Filing of Reports

The Autozone, Inc. Committee For Better Government (Autozoners for Better Government) ("the Committee") has failed to file eight (8) Reports of Receipts and Disbursements in a timely manner for the 1993-1994 election cycle (see attached chart). The reports were filed between thirty (30) and eighty four (84) calendar days late.

On December 17, 1993, a Chronic Late Filing Notice was sent to the Committee for failing to file the 1993 February, July, October and November Monthly Reports in a timely manner (Attachment 9). The notice advised the Committee that any additional late filing of reports may result in legal enforcement action.

Subsequent to the sending of the Chronic Late Filing Notice, the Committee failed to timely file the 1993 December Monthly Report, the 1993 Year End Report and the 1994 February and March Monthly Reports.

On March 31, 1994, the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") analyst spoke with Donald Rawlins, attorney for the Committee. The analyst discussed the tardiness of the Committee's reports and stressed that the Committee's 1993

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Year End and 1994 February and March Monthly Reports needed to be filed as soon as possible (Attachment 17).

The Commission received a letter from Mr. Rawlins on April 7, 1994. The letter acknowledged the Committee's tardiness in reporting and assured timely filing in the future (Attachment 18).

Committees wishing to change their reporting schedule (for example, from monthly to semiannual) must notify the Commission in writing when filing a report under their current reporting schedule. Committees may change their filing frequencies no more than once per calendar year.

LABEL

Committees should affix the peel-off label from the envelope to Line 1 of the report. Corrections should be made on the label.

This matter was generated based on information ascertained by the Federal Election Commission ("the Commission") in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. See 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(2).

The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, (the "Act") requires treasurers of political committees, other than authorized committees of a candidate, to file periodic reports of receipts and disbursements. In any calendar year, all political committees that choose to file on a monthly basis shall file monthly reports which shall be filed no later than the 20th day after the last day of the calendar month, and a year end report which shall be filed no later than January 31 of the following calendar year. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(B).

The Autozone, Inc. Committee for Better Government ("Autozone") is a political committee not authorized by any candidate and has elected to report on a monthly basis. Pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(B), the due date for Autozone's 1993 February Monthly Report was February 20, 1993; the due date for Autozone's 1993 July Monthly Report was July 20, 1993; the due date for Autozone's 1993 October Monthly Report was October 20, 1993; the due date for Autozone's 1993 November Monthly Report was November 20, 1993; the due date

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for Autozone's 1993 December Monthly Report was December 20, 1993; the due date for Autozone's 1993 Year End Report was January 31, 1994; the due date for Autozone's 1994 February Monthly Report was February 20, 1994; and the due date for Autozone's 1994 March Monthly Report was March 20, 1994.

Autozone was notified on February 5, 1993, that its 1993 February Monthly Report was due on February 20, 1993. On March 22, 1993, Autozone filed its 1993 February Monthly Report, 30 days late, disclosing receipts totaling \$1,099 and \$0 disbursements.

Autozone was notified on February 5, 1993, that its 1993 July Monthly Report was due on July 20, 1993. A Non-Filer Notice was sent to Autozone on August 11, 1993, informing it that the failure to file the report in a timely manner could result in an audit or legal enforcement action. On August 20, 1993, Autozone filed its 1993 July Monthly Report, 31 days late, disclosing receipts totaling \$1,002 and disbursements totaling \$250.

On February 5, 1993, Autozone was notified that its 1993 October Monthly Report was due on October 20, 1993. A Non-Filer Notice was sent to Autozone on November 9, 1993, informing it that the failure to file the report in a timely manner could result in an audit or legal enforcement action. On December 6, 1993, Autozone filed its 1993 October Monthly Report, 47 days late, disclosing receipts totaling \$999 and disbursements totaling \$1,000.

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Autozone was notified on February 5, 1993, that its 1993 November Monthly Report was due on November 20, 1993. A Non-Filer Notice was sent to Autozone on December 15, 1993, informing it that the failure to file the report in a timely manner could result in an audit or legal enforcement action. On December 20, 1993, Autozone filed its 1993 November Monthly Report, 30 days late, disclosing receipts totaling \$992 and \$0 disbursements.

On February 5, 1993, Autozone was notified that its 1993 December Monthly Report was due on December 20, 1993. On December 17, 1993, Autozone was sent a Chronic Late Filer Notice advising it that any additional reports filed untimely could result in legal enforcement action. In addition, on January 28, 1994, a Non-Filer Notice was sent to Autozone informing it that the failure to file the report in a timely manner could result in an audit or legal enforcement action. On February 22, 1994, Autozone filed its 1993 December Monthly Report, 64 days late, disclosing receipts totaling \$990 and \$0 disbursements.

Autozone was notified on February 5 and December 27, 1993, that its 1993 Year Report was due on January 31, 1994. On February 25, 1994, Autozone was sent a Non-Filer Notice informing it that the failure to file the report in a timely manner could result in an audit or legal enforcement action. On April 25, 1994, Autozone filed its 1993 Year End Report, 84 days late, disclosing receipts totaling \$2,726 and \$0 disbursements.

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On December 27, 1993 and February 16, 1994, Autozone was notified that that its 1994 February Monthly Report was due on February 20, 1994. Autozone was sent a Non-Filer Notice on March 18, 1994, informing it that failure to file the report in a timely manner could result in an audit or legal enforcement action. On April 25, 1994, Autozone filed its 1994 February Monthly Report, 64 days late, disclosing receipts totaling \$1,384 and \$0 disbursements.

Autozone was notified on December 27, 1993, and February 16, 1994, that its 1994 March Monthly Report was due on March 20, 1994. Autozone was sent a Non-Filer Notice on April 12, 1994, informing it that failure to file the report in a timely manner could result in an audit or legal enforcement action. 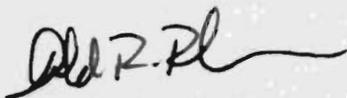

On April 6, 1995, the Federal Election Commission accepted the signed conciliation agreement submitted on behalf of AutoZone, Inc., Committee for Better Government and John Pontius, as treasurer, in settlement of a violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(B), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). Accordingly, the file has been closed in this matter.

The confidentiality provisions at 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(12) no longer apply and this matter is now public. In addition, although the complete file must be placed on the public record within 30 days, this could occur at any time following certification of the Commission's vote. If you wish to submit any factual or legal materials to appear on the public record, please do so as soon as possible. While the file may be placed on the public record before receiving your additional materials, any permissible submissions will be added to the public record upon receipt.

Information derived in connection with any conciliation attempt will not become public without the written consent of the respondent and the Commission. See 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(4)(B). The enclosed conciliation agreement, however, will become a part of the public record.

CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

This matter was initiated by the Federal Election Commission ("Commission"), pursuant to information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. The Commission found reason to believe that AutoZone, Inc., Committee for Better Government and John Pontius, as treasurer, ("Respondents") violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(B).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission and the Respondents, having participated in informal methods of conciliation, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, do hereby agree as follows:

I. The Commission has jurisdiction over the Respondents and the subject matter of this proceeding, and this agreement has the effect of an agreement entered pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(4)(A)(i).

II. Respondents have had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.

III. Respondents enter voluntarily into this agreement with the Commission.

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IV. The pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:

1. AutoZone, Inc., Committee for Better Government is a political committee within the meaning of 2 U.S.C. § 431(4), and is not an authorized committee of any candidate.

2. John Pontius has been the treasurer of AutoZone, Inc., Committee for Better Government since March 1994. Prior to March 1994, the treasurer of AutoZone, Inc., Committee for Better Government was Robert Olsen.

3. Political committees that elect to file monthly reports shall file them no later than the 20th day after the last day of the month, and a year end report shall be filed no later than January 31 of the following calendar year. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(B).

4. Pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(B), Respondents' 1993 February Monthly Report was due on February 20, 1993. Respondents filed the 1993 February Monthly Report on March 22, 1993, 30 days late, disclosing receipts totaling \$1,099 and \$0 disbursements.

5. Pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(B), Respondents' 1993 July Monthly Report was due on July 20, 1993. Respondents filed the 1993 July Monthly Report on August 20, 1993, 31 days late, disclosing receipts totaling \$1,002 and disbursements totaling \$250.

6. Pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(B), Respondents' 1993 October Monthly Report was due on October 20, 1993.

Respondents filed the 1993 October Monthly Report on December 6, 1993, 47 days late, disclosing receipts totaling \$999 and disbursements totaling \$1,000.

7. Pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(B), Respondents' 1993 November Monthly Report was due on November 20, 1993. Respondents filed the 1993 November Monthly Report on December 20, 1993, 30 days late, disclosing receipts totaling \$992 and \$0 disbursements.

8. Pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(B), Respondents' 1993 December Monthly Report was due on December 20, 1993. Respondents filed the 1993 December Monthly Report on February 22, 1994, 64 days late, disclosing receipts totaling \$990 and \$0 disbursements.

9. Pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(B), Respondents' 1993 Year End Report was due on January 31, 1994. Respondents filed the 1993 Year End Report on April 25, 1994, 84 days late, disclosing receipts totaling \$2,726 and \$0 disbursements.

10. Pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(B), Respondents' 1994 February Monthly Report was due on February 20, 1994. Respondents filed the 1994 February Monthly Report on April 25, 1994, 64 days late, disclosing receipts totaling \$1,384 and \$0 disbursements.

11. Pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(B), Respondents' 1994 March Monthly Report was due on March 20, 1994. Respondents filed the 1994 March Monthly Report on April 25, 1994, 36 days late, disclosing receipts totaling \$1,509 and disbursements totaling \$3,000.

V. Respondents failed to file timely their 1993 February, July, October, November, and December Monthly Reports; their 1993 Year End Report; and their 1994 February and March Monthly Reports, in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(B).

VI. Respondents will pay a civil penalty to the Federal Election Commission in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1,000), pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(5)(A).

VII. The Commission, on request of anyone filing a complaint under 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1) concerning the matters at issue herein or on its own motion, may review compliance with this agreement. If the Commission believes that this agreement or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute a civil action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

VIII. This agreement shall become effective as of the date that all parties hereto have executed same and the Commission has approved the entire agreement.

IX. Respondents shall have no more than 30 days from the date this agreement becomes effective to comply with and implement the requirement contained in this agreement and to so notify the Commission.

This Conciliation Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties on the matters raised herein, and no other statement, promise, or agreement, either written or oral, made by either party or by agents of either party, that is not contained in this written agreement shall be enforceable.
