III. BACKGROUND

Failure to File 48-Hour Notifications

Rangel for Congress Committee ("the Committee") has failed to file 48-Hour Notifications ("48-Hour Notices") for contributions totaling \$55,950 received prior to the 1994 New York Primary Election.

The candidate was involved in the 1994 New York Primary Election held on September 13, 1994. Prior Notice was sent to the Committee on August 8, 1994 (Attachment 2). The Notice includes a section titled "48 Hour Notices on Contributions." This section reads "Notices are required if the committee receives contributions (including contributions and loans from the candidate's personal funds; and endorsements or guarantees of bank loans) of \$1,000 or more, during the period of August 25 through September 10. The notices must reach the appropriate federal and state filing offices within 48 hours of the committee's receipt of the contribution(s)."

Schedule A of the 1994 October Quarterly Report indicates that the Committee has failed to file 48-Hour Notices for contributions received during the aforementioned period (Attachment 3). The following is a list of the contributions for which no 48-Hour Notices were filed:

On December 6, 1994, a Request for Additional Information ("RFAI") was sent to the Committee (Attachment 4). The RFAI notes on an informational basis that the Committee may have failed to file one or more of the required 48-Hour Notices for "last minute" contributions of \$1,000 or more. The notice requests the Committee to review their procedures for checking contributions received during the aforementioned time period. Additionally, the notice states that although the Commission may take legal steps, any response would be taken into consideration.

The Committee submitted an October Quarterly Report amendment on January 17, 1995 (Attachment 5).^{*} The amendment indicates the Committee "is currently in the process of reviewing all of the relevant documentation in connection to contributions of \$1,000 or more received prior to the primary election." The Committee further contends that the contributions may have been inadvertently reported under erroneous dates and more amendments may be needed pending review.

The RAD analyst has phoned the Committee on several occasions between January 11 and April 4, 1995 to discuss the missing 48-Hour Notices (Attachment 6). In the April 4th conversation, the Committee has indicated that records are not available to clarify if the Committee reported the date of receipt or date on the check. The Committee is currently obtaining bank deposit slips in order to clarify this discrepancy since records are not available.



Please amend this report and any previous reports so that all activity is disclosed in the report covering the period in which the activity occurred.

-You must provide the occupation and name of employer for all individuals who contribute more than \$200 in a calendar year. Please amend your report to include the omitted information.

A committee may demonstrate "best efforts" to obtain the required information by providing the Commission with a description of its procedures for requesting the information, accompanied by copies of the solicitations; the committee must request the contributor information in initial solicitations; make follow-up requests (if necessary); report the information; and file amendments to disclose previously unreported information. Each solicitation must include a clear and conspicuous request for the information and must inform the contributor that the reporting of such information is required by federal law. If a committee receives a contribution that exceeds the \$200 threshold but lacks contributor information, the committee must, within 30 days, make an additional written or oral request for the information. 

On June 8, 1995, the Federal Election Commission found that there is reason to believe the Rangel for Congress Committee ("Committee") and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. §434(a)(6)(A), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). The Factual and Legal Analysis, which formed a basis for the Commission's finding, is attached for your information.

You may submit any factual or legal materials that you believe are relevant to the Commission's consideration of this matter. Please submit such materials to the General Counsel's Office within 15 days of your receipt of this letter. Where appropriate, statements should be submitted under oath. In the absence of additional information, the Commission may find probable cause to believe that a violation has occurred and proceed with conciliation.

In order to expedite the resolution of this matter, the Commission has also decided to offer to enter into negotiations directed towards reaching a conciliation agreement in settlement of this matter prior to a finding of probable cause to believe. Enclosed is a conciliation agreement that the Commission has approved.

If you are interested in expediting the resolution of this matter by pursuing preprobable cause conciliation and if you agree with the provisions of the enclosed agreement, please sign and return the agreement, along with the civil penalty, to the Commission. In light of the fact that conciliation negotiations, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, are limited to a maximum of 30 days, you should respond to this notification as soon as possible.



This matter was generated based on information ascertained by the Federal Election Commission ("the Commission") in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. See 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(2).

The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"), requires principal campaign committees of candidates for federal office to notify in writing either the Secretary of the Senate, the Clerk of the U.S. House of Representatives or the Commission, as appropriate, as well as the Secretary of State of the candidate's home state, of each contribution totaling \$1,000 or more, received by any authorized committee of the candidate after the 20th day but more than 48 hours before any election. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(A).

The Act further requires notification to be made within 48 hours of the receipt of the contribution. The notice must include the name of the candidate and office sought, the date of receipt, the amount of the contribution, and the identification of the contributor. Id. Notification of these contributions shall be in addition to all other reporting requirements. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(B).

The primary election in the State of New York was held on September 13, 1994. Pursuant to the Act, Respondents were

required to report, in writing, all contributions of \$1,000 or more received from August 25 to September 10, 1994, within 48 hours of their receipt. A review of the Committee's 1994 October Quarterly Report identified the following 39 contributions of \$1000 or more (totaling \$59,950), received between August 25 and September 10, for which no 48 Hour Notices were submitted by the Committee:

On behalf of the Rangel for Congress Committee ("Committee") and Richard A. Brown, as Treasurer, I am writing in response to the Federal Election Commission's ("FEC" or "Commission") letter dated June 14, 1995, pertaining to the above-referenced matter. This letter notified us that the Commission found reason to believe that my clients failed to file 48-Hour notices for thirty-nine contributions, aggregating in the amount of \$55,950,¹ received not less than twenty days, but more than 48 hours prior to the 1994 primary election in violation of §434 (a)(6)(A) of the Federal Election Campaign Act ("FECA" or the "Act") of 1971, as amended.

It was the practice of the Committee to disclose all information regarding contributions in compliance with reporting requirements under the Act, including the 48-Hour notice reporting requirement at issue here. Regarding this requirement, if a contributor check written for an amount equal to or greater than \$1,000 was received within the 48-Hour notification, the notification was promptly filed with the Clerk of the House. The Committee's knowledge of this requirement and its efforts to comply with it are demonstrated by the fact that the Committee did file notifications for most contributions of \$1,000 or more received during this same period. It was also the general practice of the Committee to deposit contributors checks on the same day that they were received. Thus, the date of deposit is generally the date of receipt for FEC reporting purposes.

¹ The Factual and Legal Analysis report stated that the 39 contributions totaled \$59,950. However, these contributions actually total \$55,950.

A review of the contributions listed in the FEC notice reveals that \$46,450 were not in fact received during the 48-Hour reporting period. The Committee will file amended reports reflecting the correct dates of receipt for these contributions.

1. The following contributions, aggregating \$16,000, were received and deposited (the same day), after September 10, 1994, the last day of the 48-Hour notice reporting period. Thus, the Committee had no obligation to report these contributions on 48-Hour notice forms and did not violate §434 (a)(6)(A) of the Act. However, instead of reporting the date of deposit as the date of receipt on the October 15 Quarterly report -- the next report following the primary, the Committee mistakenly reported the date of the face of the check as the date of receipt. In all of these instances, the date of the face of the check was not the same day as receipt or deposit. This inaccuracy in reporting misled the Commission to believe that such notifications were required, when in fact, the Committee had no obligation to report them. Please find attached copies of these checks. The Committee has requested copies of the deposit receipts and will forward them upon receipt.

2. The following contributions, aggregating \$30,450, were also received and deposited after September 10, 1994. Thus, the Committee had no obligation to report these contributions on 48-Hour notice forms and did not violate §434 (a)(6)(A) of the Act. These contributions were also inadvertently misreported on the October 15 Quarterly report. The date of receipt was reported as the date on the face of the check, not the actual date of receipt and deposit. The Committee is unable to produce copies of these checks for your review. However, we have attached a letter from Carver Bank, where the checks were deposited, stating that copies of the checks are unavailable. In light of the Committee's consistency in complying with 48-Hour notice reporting requirements and its general practice regarding deposit upon receipt, it appears that these contributions fell outside the 48-hour reporting period.

During late August and early September, the bookkeeper for the Committee, Joyce Lussier, was on vacation outside of the country. For the period during which she was gone, Ms. Lussier left copies of 48-Hour notification forms and instructions for Committee staff to complete and fax such forms to the Clerk of the House when they received contributor checks in amounts of \$1,000 or more. The Committee made copies of all checks received during this period and deposited them in American Securities bank in Washington, D.C. During this same period, many fundraisers were held in New York. Due to Ms. Lussier's absence, the fundraisers directly desposited the checks into Carver Bank in New York. Because Ms. Lussier herself did not deposit the checks during her absence, she did not know the exact date of receipt of the checks. Consequently, she used the date on the face of the check as the date of receipt in order to complete the October 15 Quarterly report. Thus, a discrepancy was created between the reporting date and the actual date of receipt. See attached affidavit of Joyce Lussier.

The Committee staff made best efforts to follow Ms. Lussier's procedures and did in fact collect, copy and deposit contributor checks during her absence. Upon review of the contributions in question, other than those listed above, it does appear, however, that the Committee inadvertently did not report on 48-hour notices some of the checks in question. The following contributions appear to have been mistakenly overlooked by Committee staff.







GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

I. BACKGROUND

This matter originated as a referral from the Reports Analysis Division regarding thirty-nine (39) last-minute primary election contributions, totaling \$55,950, for which no 48-Hour Notices were filed. On June 8, 1995, the Commission found reason to believe the Rangel for Congress Committee and Richard A. Brown, as treasurer (collectively the "Rangel Committee") violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(A) and entered into conciliation prior to a finding of probable cause. On the same day the Commission approved a conciliation agreement

II. DISCUSSION

Based on the Rangel Committee's response and discussions between this Office and respondents' counsel, it now appears likely that a number of the contributions at issue were not received within the 48-Hour reporting period. If that is so, the dates of receipt for these contributions were misreported by the Rangel Committee in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(3)(A).

This Report recommends the Commission make a reason to believe finding regarding the Rangel Committee's misreporting in conformance with the revised conciliation agreement, accept the agreement, and close the file in this matter.

A. The Rangel Committee's Response

In its response to the reason to believe notification, the Rangel Committee admitted that it had failed to file 48-Hour Notices for eight (8) contributions totaling \$9,500, denied receiving the remainder of the contributions during the 48-Hour Notice period

According to an affidavit submitted by Committee's bookkeeper, she was on vacation during the 1994 primary election 48-Hour Notice period. Id. at 16. As a result, other staff members collected and deposited contributions during her absence. Id. at 3. After her return, the bookkeeper was unable to establish receipt dates for the contributions, and instead reported the date on the faces of the contribution checks as the date these checks were received by the Committee. Id. at 16. Thus, according to counsel, a discrepancy was created between the reported date of receipt and the actual date of receipt, and almost all of the contributions were received after the close of

the 48-Hour Notice period.¹ Id. at 3. The Rangel Committee, however, was unable to submit any documentation reflecting the actual date of receipt for any of the contributions at issue, except for noting that its general practice is to deposit contributions on the same day they are received. Id.

B. The Law

Under 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(3)(A), each report filed by a political committee must include, inter alia, the date of receipt for each contribution that is in an aggregate amount or value in excess of \$200. Under Commission regulations, the date of receipt is defined as the date a person takes possession of a contribution on behalf of the recipient committee. 11 C.F.R. § 102.8(a). Based on the Rangel Committee's admission that it reported the dates on the faces on the contribution checks (all of which were for \$1000 or more) rather than their actual receipt dates, there is reason to believe that the Rangel for Congress Committee and Richard A. Brown, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(3)(A).

C. Analysis

1. The 48-Hour Notice period for New York's primary election ran from August 25 through September 10, 1994. The Rangel Committee reported on its 1994 October Quarterly Report that the contributions at issue were received throughout this period -- on August 25, 28, 30 and 31, and September 1, 3, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10.

CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

This matter was initiated by the Federal Election Commission ("Commission"), pursuant to information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. The Commission found reason to believe that the Rangel for Congress Committee, and Richard A. Brown, as treasurer ("Respondents"), violated 2 U.S.C. §§ 434(a)(6)(A) and 434(b)(3)(A).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission and Respondents, having participated in informal methods of conciliation, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, do hereby agree as follows:

I. The Commission has jurisdiction over Respondents and the subject matter of this proceeding, and this agreement has the effect of an agreement entered pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(4)(A)(i).

II. Respondents have had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.

III. Respondents enter voluntarily into this agreement with the Commission.

IV. The pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:

1. The Rangel for Congress Committee is a political committee within the meaning of 2 U.S.C. § 431(4), and is the authorized principal campaign committee for Charles Rangel's 1994 congressional campaign.

2. Richard A. Brown is the treasurer of the Rangel for Congress Committee.

3. The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"), requires principal campaign committees of candidates for federal office to notify in writing either the Secretary of the Senate, the Clerk of the U.S. House of Representatives or the Commission, as appropriate, and the Secretary of State of the candidate's home state, of each contribution totaling \$1,000 or more, received by any authorized committee of the candidate after the 20th day but more than 48 hours before any election. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(A). The Act further requires notification to be made within 48 hours after the receipt of the contribution and to include the name of the candidate and office sought, the date of receipt, the amount of the contribution, and the identification of the contributor. Id. The notification of these contributions shall be in addition to all other reporting requirements. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(B).

4. The Act requires political committees to identify each contributor whose contribution or contributions aggregate in excess of \$200 per calendar year together with the date of receipt. 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(3)(A).

5. Respondents received 19 contributions between August 25 and September 10, 1994, of \$1,000 or more, totalling \$25,450, for which no 48 Hour Notices were submitted.

6. Respondents received 20 contributions of \$1,000 or more, for which the dates of receipt were misreported on the Committee's 1994 October Quarterly Report. These contributions totalled \$30,500.

V. Respondents failed to report 19 campaign contributions of \$1,000 or more received after the 20th day, but more than 48 hours before the primary election, within 48 hours of receipt of the contributions, in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(A).

VI. Respondents failed to report accurately the date of receipt for 20 contributions exceeding \$200, in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(3)(A).

VII. 1. Respondents will pay a civil penalty to the Federal Election Commission in the amount of Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$7,500), pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(5)(A).

2. Respondents will file an amended 1994 October Quarterly Report.

VIII. The Commission, on request of anyone filing a complaint under 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1) concerning the matters at issue herein or on its own motion, may review compliance with this agreement. If the Commission believes that this agreement or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute a civil action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

IX. This agreement shall become effective as of the date that all parties hereto have executed same and the Commission has approved the entire agreement.

X. Respondents shall have no more than 30 days from the date this agreement becomes effective to comply with the requirement contained in this agreement.

XI. This Conciliation Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties on the matters raised herein, and no other statement, promise, or agreement, either written or oral, made by either party or by agents of either party, that is not contained in this written agreement shall be enforceable.
