Re: Complaint against House of Representatives  
candidate Georgianna Lincoln

Dear Mr. Noble:

I would like to make a complaint regarding Georgianna Lincoln's reporting of unitemized contributions, as found in her latest Federal Election Committee ("FEC") report of receipts and disbursements. Ms. Lincoln is running as the Democratic candidate for the United States House of Representatives from Alaska.

As you are aware, the identification of individuals contributing \$200 or less does not have to be reported on a candidate's FEC report. However, individual contributions in excess of \$200 must be identified by name, mailing address, occupation, employer name, and the date of receipt of the contribution. 11 CFR § 104.8(a).

Ms. Lincoln claims in her latest FEC report (dated July 15, 1996) to have received \$41,620.91 in unitemized contributions from individuals. Ms. Lincoln claims to have received a total of \$59,745.91 from all individuals. Thus, Ms. Lincoln's unitemized contributions account for almost 65% of her contributions from all individuals.

Ms. Lincoln's fundraising attempts should be commended. However, her ability to raise these funds in contributions of less than \$200 is highly questionable. Ms. Lincoln is from a village in Alaska with a population of 63 people. This is her first U.S. Congressional race.

I believe a perspective can be gained by analyzing the unitemized contributions of other members of the Alaska Congressional delegation. United States Senator Ted Stevens has over 25 years of experience in the U.S. Senate. Senator Stevens reported on his latest FEC report unitemized contributions from individuals of \$43,518. This

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accounts for only 19.8% of Senator Stevens' receipts from individual contributors.

Congressman Don Young, the current incumbent from Alaska, received \$13,405 in the same reporting time period as Ms. Lincoln. This accounted for 17.4% of Congressman Young's contributions from individuals.

Consideration of other Democratic challengers in prior House of Representatives races also evidences that Ms. Lincoln's numbers for contributions from individual contributors are unrealistic. For example, Tony Smith, who ran for Alaska's House of Representatives seat in 1994, reported total unitemized contributions for a two-year period of \$34,717.41. This accounted for 13.3% of Mr. Smith's contributions from individuals.

Ms. Lincoln's FEC reports detailing her income and election expenditures also provide guidance. Ms. Lincoln claims to have spent only \$2,595.84 on fundraising expenditures. This accounted for only 3.2% of her total contributions of \$80,550.91 as of June 30, 1996. It would appear unlikely that Ms. Lincoln, a relatively unknown candidate, would be able to raise this amount of money while spending only \$2,500. Further, Ms. Lincoln's total claims for mailing costs include "bulk mailing permits" and "general mailing" in the amount of \$2,250.67. At the current rate of 20 cents per bulk mailing piece, the Lincoln for Congress Committee would be able to send out only 11,253 pieces of mail. Accordingly, it does not appear that the Lincoln for Congress Committee is spending the type of money to account for such a large base of support.

Ms. Lincoln is currently a State Senator for Alaska. At the end of 1995 Ms. Lincoln had over \$26,000 cash on hand for her State Senate campaign. She is not required by state law to disclose her current cash on hand until December 31, 1996. While Ms. Lincoln may not be using money from her state campaign for her United States House of Representatives campaign, in the form of unitemized contributions, I believe the citizens of Alaska have a right to know the source of such large amounts of unitemized contributions. Therefore, I would request the Federal Election Commission perform an audit of Ms. Lincoln's unitemized contributions.

Enclosed please find attached as Exhibit "A" Ms. Lincoln's FEC reports. Also, please find attached as Exhibit "B" background information regarding recent U.S. House and Senate campaigns in Alaska with the most current data available. I would appreciate your office







Ms. Ten-Eyck makes one statement in her letter with which I totally agree: "Ms Lincoln's fundraising (sic) attempts should be commended." Indeed they should. Georgianna has worked diligently with a group of volunteers whose efforts go deeper than "grass roots;" it goes deep into our permafrost. She has met with constituents throughout the state personally and by phone. Using the limited resources she has available, Ms. Lincoln has been able to get her message to thousands of people who are excited about her candidacy and her campaign.

Currently Ms. Lincoln represents the largest Senate district in the United States. It encompasses 49 percent of the land area of Alaska -- 91 villages and communities. Alaska is like a small town in many ways. Friendships and loyalties know no geographic bounds. This is particularly true of those people living in our Interior. Ms. Ten-Eyck's comment that Georgianna's home village has only 63 people indicates her lack of understanding of Alaskan peoples. Though Ms. Lincoln lives in a small village, she is genuinely a resident of one large community: Alaska.

My records clearly indicate that \$51,306 was raised in the first two quarters with contributions of \$200 or less (see Addenda 1, 2 and 3). By June 30, we had only 9 contributions of \$1,000. We had two Political Action Committee contributions totaling \$2,050, one for \$2,000 and one of \$50. Individual contributions in excess of \$200 total \$28,103.71 (see Addendum 2). We reported itemized contributions in the first two quarters of \$30,744, confirming that few supporters had accumulated contributions in excess of the \$200 threshold.

Our campaign has made a concerted effort to be a campaign "with the people." We have met with them, listened to them and worked with them. We have not focused on political action committee contributions. We have focused on the people Georgianna will represent.

It is our purpose that "... Ms. Lincoln's unitemized contributions account for almost 65% of her contributions from all individuals (my emphasis). (See Ms. Ten-Eyck's letter.)


As we had no opposition in the primary, we saved our resources for the general election. Our fund-raising efforts in the primary consisted of small get-togethers in supporters' homes throughout the state. The only money spent for media was for limited radio ads and an ad on television that we ran about four times a day the last five days before the election. Most of our "mailings" consisted of thank-you letters.

There is absolutely no basis for the allegations that Ms. Ten-Eyck has brought. We began in January with Zero Dollars -- as the January bank statement clearly indicates. Our deposits are small but frequent. We keep expenses to a bare minimum.

I have enclosed for your review:

1. Copies of our bank statements and reconciliations;
2. Addenda 1 and 2. Ms Aguilar and Ms. Halsey manually reviewed the support documentation for all deposits identifying the amount of each contribution, with accompanying affidavit;

**SENSITIVE**

I. INTRODUCTION.

The cases listed below have been identified as either stale or of low priority based upon evaluation under the Enforcement Priority System (EPS). This report is submitted to recommend that the Commission no longer pursue these cases.

II. CASES RECOMMENDED FOR CLOSURE.

A. Cases Not Warranting Further Action Relative to Other Cases Pending Before the Commission

EPS was created to identify pending cases which, due to the length of their pendency in inactive status or the lower priority of the issues raised in the matters relative to others presently pending before the Commission, do not warrant further expenditure of resources. Central Enforcement Docket (CED) evaluates each incoming matter using Commission-approved criteria which results in a numerical rating of each case.

Closing such cases permits the Commission to focus its limited resources on more important cases presently pending before it. Based upon this review, we have identified 28 cases which do

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not warrant further action relative to other pending matters.<sup>1</sup> Attachment 1 to this report contains summaries of each case, the EPS rating, and the factors leading to assignment of a low priority and recommendation not to further pursue the matter.



Camille Ten-Eyck alleges the possibility that the \$41,620.91 in unitemized contributions reported by the Georgianna Lincoln for U.S. Congress committee (the "Committee") on its July Quarterly Report may be from contributors who aggregated more than \$200 year-to-date contributions and who therefore should have been itemized on the FEC report. She also posits that some of these unitemized contributions may have come from Ms. Lincoln's state committee.

Carolyn Covington, the respondent Committee's treasurer, denies these allegations and performed an audit of the receipts which was verified and attested to under affidavit by Shannon J. Halsey and Shari L. Aguiar. She provides copies of bank statements and tally sheets which totalled the number of contributions of each amount, beginning with less than \$5, \$5, \$10, etcetera, up to \$200. Ms. Halsey and Ms. Aguiar affirmed that they reviewed and accounted for all checks, bank statements and bank deposits and verified the tally sheets, refuting the allegations.

This matter is less significant relative to others pending before the Commission and evidences no serious intent to violate the FECA.

She also posits that some of these unitemized contributions may have come from Ms. Lincoln's state committee.

Carolyn Covington, the respondent Committee's treasurer, denies these allegations and performed an audit of the receipts which was verified and attested to under affidavit by Shannon J. Halsey and Shari L. Aguiar. She provides copies of bank statements and tally sheets which totalled the number of contributions of each amount, beginning with less than \$5, \$5, \$10, etcetera, up to \$200. Ms. Halsey and Ms. Aguiar affirmed that they reviewed and accounted for all checks, bank statements and bank deposits and verified the tally sheets, refuting the allegations.

This matter is less significant relative to others pending before the Commission and evidences no serious intent to violate the FECA.
