

General Counsel's Report

I. Allegations

Information obtained during a routine (random) Commission audit indicated that respondent corporations (see Attachment 1) all made contributions in violation of 2 U.S.C. §441b(a) to the Bud Shuster for Congress Committee (hereinafter the "Shuster Committee"). At the time of the audit, the Shuster Committee stated that it was unaware of the receipt of any corporate contributions.

II. Evidence

On November 10, 1977, the Commission found reason to believe that the Shuster Committee and the respondent corporations had violated 2 U.S.C. §441b(a). Since that time each of the "corporations" and the Shuster Committee have responded to the Commission's inquiries. The evidence regarding each respondent is set forth below:

A. Shuster Committee

The Committee, upon notification of the receipt of possible corporate contributions, has furnished the Commission with all correspondence relevant to solicitations and contributions of

respondent corporations. Additionally, the Committee has evidenced repayment to each of the respondent corporations. (It should be noted that the Committee refunded these contributions as soon as they were made aware of the possible violations.)

The information submitted by the Committee reveals that the Committee, upon receipt of apparent corporate contributions, made a conscious effort to return all such contributions. (See Attachment 2.) The Committee allegedly was unaware of the receipt of these corporate contributions cited by the Commission in its reason to believe letter of November 10, 1977. In fact, with regard to the cited F & F Drycleaners contribution, the Committee had purportedly been informed by F & F Drycleaners that no corporate contribution was being made.

B. Respondent Corporations

John C. Bolger Associates Funeral Home: Mr. Bolger has admitted the fact of a \$50 contribution on April 5, 1976 from his professional corporation to the Shuster Committee. Mr. Bolger states that he was unaware that professional corporations were prohibited from making political contributions and since discovery of this apparent unlawful contribution has had his accountant treat the check as a personal loan to him for the purpose of making a contribution to the Shuster Committee. Additionally, Mr. Bolger evidences receipt of repayment by the Shuster Committee.

Baumgardner Oil Co.: Mr. Baumgardner has stated that the contribution made to the Shuster Committee was prior to the date of incorporation of Baumgardner Oil. Upon reference to the corporate division of the Pennsylvania Secretary of State, it was verified

that Baumgardner Oil Co. became incorporated on November 4, 1976 (not 1946 as originally reported). As the date of contribution by Baumgardner Oil Co. to the Shuster Committee was August 27, 1976, there is no apparent corporate contribution.

F & F Drycleaners, Inc.: On October 12, 1976 (approximate date), the Shuster Committee returned a contribution check to F & F Drycleaners on the basis that it was in violation of 2 U.S.C. §441b(a). Following this, F & F Drycleaners furnished the Shuster Committee with another contribution for the same amount (\$50) made on a different non-corporate account. The Internal Revenue Service verifies that there is in fact an F & F Drycleaners registered as a sole proprietorship assigned the Employer Identification Number cited by Mr. Freeman in his letter explaining his contribution. (See Attachment 3.) As the check to the Shuster Committee was drawn on the non-corporate F & F Drycleaner's entity there appears to be no violation of the law.

Glenn O. Hawbaker, Inc.: Ms. Marie Porter, vice-president of the respondent corporation, states that on September 19, 1975, Glenn O. Hawbaker, Inc. made a \$50 contribution to the Shuster Committee in response to a September, 1975 solicitation by the Committee. At the time of the contribution the respondent was unaware of the ban on corporate contributions to candidates for federal offices. She also states that this contribution was returned to the corporation by the Committee on November 18, 1977.

Lafferty Brothers, Inc.: Mr. G. Digby Lafferty states that on April 23, 1976, he did make a contribution of \$100, drawn

on his Lafferty Brothers, Inc. account to the Shuster Committee. While admitting that he now realizes this was in violation of §441b, Mr. Lafferty notes that he became a corporation only the month before the contribution was made and was not aware of the §441b problem at that time. Additionally, Mr. Lafferty has recontributed to the Shuster Committee out of his own personal account and expressed his apologies for the mistake.

Manbeck Construction Co.: Mr. William H. Manbeck, president of the respondent corporation, admitted making, on August 28, 1976, a \$25 contribution to the Shuster Committee. Mr. Manbeck states that this was an inadvertent violation of the law and encloses a copy of the Shuster Committee's repayment check as evidence of his company's and the Shuster Committee's good faith efforts at compliance with the Act.

McConnellsburg Foodline, Inc.: Mr. Ray S. Koontz admits making, on March 27, 1976, a contribution of \$100 to the Shuster Committee from his corporate account. As evidence of his good faith efforts at compliance with the law he evidences a repayment of \$100 from his personal account to his corporate account, and, additionally, encloses the repayment check from the Shuster Committee. He further states that he owns all the stock in the respondent corporation.

Pryor's Tire Service, Inc.: Mr. Kenneth E. Pryor, sole owner of Pryor's Tire Service, Inc., admits making, on September 14, 1976, a \$25 contribution to the Shuster Committee on the corporate account. Upon notification by the Commission, this disbursement from the corporation's account was charged to the personal account

of Mr. Pryor and treated as part of Mr. Pryor's corporate salary.

Sheetz Kwik Shopper: Mr. Robert Sheetz states that his contributions of \$400 to the Shuster Committee were drawn on his personal "real estate" account and not on his corporate account. The Central Counties Bank of Altoona, Pa. has verified that these checks were in fact drawn on a personal account of Mr. Robert Sheetz.

Sinking Springs Farm, Inc.: Mr. C. Galen Detwiler states that his farm, Sinking Springs, is not incorporated and thus the contributions made to the Shuster Committee were within the law. The Corporate Division of the Pennsylvania Secretary of State verifies that the Sinking Springs Farm registered as a corporation is owned by Ms. Helen Appel of York, Pa.; not the Detwilers of Everett, Pa.

III. Analysis

It appears from the responses of the Shuster Committee and the individual respondent corporations that the committee's acceptance of corporate monies was probably inadvertent, rather than a "knowing" violation of §441b(a). In any event, the Committee's present actions in returning the monies and its cooperation with the Commission throughout this matter are additional reasons for closing the file in this matter.

As for the groups involved, they appear to have been small corporations which may have been ignorant of the law. Again, although a violation does appear to have been committed, the prompt responses by the corporations involved, their apparent ignorance, and the small size of the contributions involved, mitigate against a further commitment of Commission resources to this matter.

IV. Recommendation

As per our phone conversation on November 15, 1977. I am forwarding copies of the checks in question as well as the following explanation:

The first check dated October 16, 1975 was issued from my drawing account at Lafferty Brothers which was, at that time, a proprietorship. The amount of the check was \$200.00 and reported along with other taxable income on my tax return for the year 1975.

The second check dated April 23, 1976 in the amount of \$100.00 was handled in the same manner and reported as income on my 1976 tax return. However, as you pointed out, this was a direct violation since I had converted the proprietorship to a Sub Chapter S corporation on January 28, 1976.

I inadvertantly allowed this check to be written at this time because of (1) the habit of allowing personal payment to be made from the proprietorship and charged to my account, and (2) I believe at the time the election code of 1976 was unfamiliar to me and I mistakenly viewed the structure of a Sub Chapter S corporation the same as a proprietorship since all income "passes through" and is declared by the stock holders as income.

Commission auditors found ten contributor checks which were apparently drawn on corporate accounts in violation of 2 U.S.C. §441b(a) to the Bud Shuster for Congress Committee (hereinafter the "Shuster Committee") (See Attachment 1). The Shuster Committee stated that it was unaware of the receipt of any corporate contributions (See Attachment 2) and told the Commission's auditors that it would attempt to repay all corporate contributions.

PRELIMINARY LEGAL ANALYSIS

It is unlawful for any corporation whatever to make a contribution or expenditure in connection with any Federal election. 2 U.S.C. §441b(a). The audit of the Shuster Committee revealed ten contributor checks totaling \$1,225 from corporate accounts. It is also unlawful for any candidate, political committee, or other person to knowingly accept a corporate contribution. 2 U.S.C. §441b (a). Further inquiry should be made of the Shuster Committee with regard to the receipt of these corporate contributions and any repayment made by the Shuster Committee.

RECOMMENDATIONS
