III. BACKGROUND:

Failure to Timely File the 1996 April Quarterly Report

The Consolidated Local Union No. 177 of the I.B.E.W. Outside-Inside PAC Fund ("the Committee") failed to timely file the 1996 April Quarterly Report of Receipts and Disbursements covering the period from January 1, 1996 to March 31, 1996. The Committee was notified on March 22, 1996 that the report was due on April 15, 1996 (Attachment 2). A Non-Filer Notice was sent to the Committee on May 8, 1996 for failure to file the 1996 April Quarterly Report (Attachment 3).

On June 3, 1996, the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") analyst called the Committee to inquire about the 1996 April Quarterly Report. The analyst informed Renee Martin, Secretary of the Committee, that the Committee must file the April Quarterly Report immediately to avoid enforcement action by the Office of General Counsel. Ms. Martin stated that she had not filed the report because their accountant was in the hospital and she didn't want to file a report with mistakes similar to those on the 1995 Year End Report. The analyst advised the Committee to file the most accurate report possible. Ms. Martin stated that the Committee would send in the report as soon as possible (Attachment 4).

On June 13, 1996, the RAD analyst called the Committee and informed Renee Martin that the April Quarterly Report

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still had not been filed. Ms. Martin stated that she mailed the April Quarterly Report on June 7, 1996 via certified mail. The analyst stated that he would be looking for the report (Attachment 5).

On June 26, 1996, the RAD analyst called the Committee and told Ms. Martin that the April Quarterly Report still had not arrived at the Commission. Ms. Martin said that she had mailed it earlier, but that she would send a copy of the report to the Commission via registered mail (Attachment 6).

The 1996 April Quarterly Report was sent certified mail on June 28, 1996 and received by the Commission on July 3, 1996 (Attachment 7).

Committees which make contributions or expenditures (including independent expenditures) in connection with an election must also file a Pre-Election Report, if the activity was not previously reported. See the January 1996 Record.

24 HOUR REPORT ON INDEPENDENT EXPENDITURES

Any PAC that makes independent expenditures in connection with an election may have to file a 24 hour report. This reporting requirement will be triggered if the committee make independent expenditures aggregating \$1,000 or more after the 20th day, but more than 24 hours, before the election day.

CHANGE IN FILING FREQUENCY

Committees wishing to change their reporting schedule (for example, from quarterly to monthly) must notify the Commission in writing when they file their next report due under their current reporting schedule. Committees may change their filing frequencies no more than once per calendar year.


LABEL

Committees should affix the peel-off label from the envelope to Line 1 of the report. Corrections should be made on the label.

*These dates indicate the beginning and the end of the reporting period. A reporting period always begins the day after the closing date of the last report filed. If the committee is new and has not previously filed a report, the first report must cover all activity that occurred before the committee registered.

**Reports sent registered or certified mail must be postmarked by the mailing date; otherwise, they must be received by the filing date.

Dear Mr. Gibbons:

On November 12, 1996, the Federal Election Commission found that there is reason to believe that the Consolidated Local Union No. 177 of the I.B.E.W. Outside-Inside PAC Fund ("Committee") and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(i), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). The Factual and Legal Analysis, which formed a basis for the Commission's finding, is attached for your information.

You may submit any factual or legal materials that you believe are relevant to the Commission's consideration of this matter. Please submit such materials to the General Counsel's Office within 15 days of your receipt of this letter. Where appropriate, statements should be submitted under oath. In the absence of additional information, the Commission may find probable cause to believe that a violation has occurred and proceed with conciliation.

In order to expedite the resolution of this matter, the Commission has also decided to offer to enter into negotiations directed towards reaching a conciliation agreement in settlement of this matter prior to a finding of probable cause to believe. Enclosed is a conciliation agreement that the Commission has approved.

If you are interested in expediting the resolution of this matter by pursuing preprobable cause conciliation and if you agree with the provisions of the enclosed agreement, please sign and return the agreement, along with the civil penalty, to the Commission. In light of the fact that conciliation negotiations, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, are limited to a maximum of 30 days, you should respond to this notification as soon as possible.

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
Requests for extensions of time will not be routinely granted. Requests must be made in writing at least five days prior to the due date of the response and specific good cause must be demonstrated. In addition, the Office of the General Counsel ordinarily will not give extensions beyond 20 days.

If you intend to be represented by counsel in this matter, please advise the Commission by completing the enclosed form stating the name, address, and telephone number of such counsel, and authorizing such counsel to receive any notifications and other communications from the Commission.

This matter will remain confidential in accordance with 2 U.S.C. §§ 437g(a)(4)(B) and 437g(a)(12)(A), unless you notify the Commission in writing that you wish the investigation to be made public.

For your information, we have attached a brief description of the Commission's procedures for handling possible violations of the Act. If you have any questions, please contact Jeffrey Marks, the staff member assigned to this matter, at (202) 219-3400.

This matter was generated based on information ascertained by the Federal Election Commission ("the Commission") in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. See 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(2).

The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act,") requires that in a year in which a regularly scheduled general election is held, political committees other than authorized committees of a candidate must file quarterly reports no later than the 15th day after the last day of each calendar quarter. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(i).

Pursuant to the Act, the Respondents were required to file a Quarterly Report of Receipts and Disbursements by April 15, 1996. The Commission received the Respondents' report by certified mail postmarked June 28, 1996, 74 days after the required date. Therefore, there is reason to believe that Consolidated Local Union No. 177 of the I.B.E.W. Outside-Inside PAC Fund and Thomas M. Gibbons, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(i).

GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

I. BACKGROUND

On November 12, 1996, the Commission found reason to believe that the Consolidated Local Union No. 177 of the I.B.E.W. Outside-Inside PAC Fund and Thomas M. Gibbons, as treasurer, ("Respondents") violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(i), and entered into conciliation with Respondents prior to finding of probable cause to believe. The agreement approved by the Commission contained an admission of the violation and a civil penalty of \$1,100. Attached for the Commission's acceptance is a conciliation agreement signed by R. Michael Williams, Financial Secretary of the Consolidated Local Union No. 177 of the I.B.E.W. Outside-Inside PAC Fund.

CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

This matter was initiated by the Federal Election Commission ("Commission"), pursuant to information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities.

The Commission found reason to believe that Consolidated Local Union No. 177 of the I.B.F.W. Outside-Inside PAC Fund and Thomas M. Gibbons, as treasurer ("Respondents") violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(i).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission and the Respondents, having participated in informal methods of conciliation, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, do hereby agree as follows:

I. The Commission has jurisdiction over the Respondents and the subject matter of this proceeding, and this agreement has the effect of an agreement entered pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(4)(A)(i).

II. Respondents have had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.

III. Respondents enter voluntarily into this agreement with the Commission.

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IV. The pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:

1. Consolidated Local Union No. 177 of the I.B.E.W. Outside Inside PAC Fund is a political committee within the meaning of 2 U.S.C. § 431(4).
2. Thomas M. Gibbons is the treasurer of Consolidated Local Union No. 177 of the I.B.E.W. ~~Outside~~-Inside PAC Fund.
3. The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act") requires that in a year in which a regularly scheduled general election is held, political committees other than authorized committees of a candidate must file quarterly reports no later than the 15th day after the last day of each calendar quarter. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(i). The Act further states that if the report is sent by certified or registered mail, the United States postmark will be considered the date of filing of the report. *Id.* at § 434(a)(5).
4. Pursuant to the Act, the Respondents were required to file a Quarterly Report of Receipts and Disbursements by April 15, 1996.
5. The Commission received the Respondents' report by certified mail postmarked June 28, 1996, 74 days after the required date. The report disclosed \$10,499.15 in contributions and \$7,756.81 in disbursements during the applicable reporting period.

V. Respondents failed to timely file the 1996 April Quarterly Report of Receipts and Disbursements, in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(i).

VI. Respondents will pay a civil penalty to the Federal Election Commission in the amount of one thousand one hundred dollars (\$1,100), pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(5)(A).

VII. The Commission, on request of anyone filing a complaint under 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1) concerning the matters at issue herein or on its own motion, may review compliance

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with this agreement. If the Commission believes that this agreement or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute a civil action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

VIII. This agreement shall become effective as of the date that all parties hereto have executed same and the Commission has approved the entire agreement.

IX. Respondent(s) shall have no more than 30 days from the date this agreement becomes effective to comply with and implement the requirement(s) contained in this agreement and to so notify the Commission.

X. This Conciliation Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties on the matters raised herein, and no other statement, promise, or agreement, either written or oral, made by either party or by agents of either party, that is not contained in this written agreement shall be enforceable.
