GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

On February 15, 1978, the Commission found reason to believe the Beasley for Congress Committee violated 2 U.S.C. § 441b in accepting corporate contributions totaling \$120 from the above-named businesses. The Commission also found reason to believe these businesses violated 2 U.S.C. § 441b by making corporate contributions to the Beasley for Congress Committee.

The Beasley Committee replied that the corporate contributions that it is alleged to have accepted were accepted unintentionally by an inexperienced volunteer staff. Other corporate contributions were refused or returned by the Committee but the Committee has no documentation of these instances.

After being informed of the two contributions which remained in question as of the last Interim Report, i.e., National Shoes and ABC School Supply, Inc., the Treasurer forwarded to this office evidence of refunds of these contributions.

ABC School Supply, Inc. is verified a corporation. Although the company replied to this office that it could find no record of the alleged \$10 contribution to the Beasley Committee, the refund check from the Beasley Committee is addressed to the same ABC School Supply, Inc. that this office has corresponded with in

connection with this MUR.

The refund check from the Beasley Committee to National Shoes is addressed to an entity in Orangeburg, South Carolina. The Office of General Counsel has been informed that this business is not associated with the National Shoes of New York City to which the staff has been directing all correspondence concerning the contribution. National Shoes, of New York City, is the only entity of that name listed on the corporate records of South Carolina. This office therefore believes that the contribution from National Shoes of Orangeburg was not corporate.

This office's inquiry regarding the \$25 contribution attributed to the Rhodes Oil Company in the Committee's records was directed to Mr. Rhodes of the L.D. Rhodes Oil Company. Mr. Rhodes has checked his records and finds no such contribution. In a telephone conversation with a member of this staff, he explained that he has several brothers in the oil business who could have made this contribution. According to the Oklahoma Secretary of State's office, he is the only one who is incorporated.

Stillwater Medical Associates has replied that they did contribute \$50 dollars to the Beasley Committee but that they are a partnership. It has been verified with the Oklahoma Secretary of State that this entity is not incorporated. The respondent was apparently confused with Stillwater Medical Assistance, which is incorporated, because Beasley's records showed receipt of a contribution from "Stillwater Medical Assn".


Harold McFall has replied that his company, Harold McFall Landscaping, ceased to be a corporation on February 2, 1976, (confirmed by the Secretary of State). His contribution of \$10 was apparently written on one of his leftover checks showing the corporate name at a time when the company was no longer incorporated. The Beasley Committee's records show this contribution was probably written in April of 1976 because it was deposited on May 1, 1976. Mr. McFall has sent a letter to this effect.

RECOMMENDATION

With only one \$10 contribution from ABC School Supply Inc. verified as corporate, the Office of General Counsel recommends that the Commission: find no reasonable cause to believe that Beasley for Congress Committee accepted corporate contributions from Harold McFall Landscaping, Inc., National Shoes, and Stillwater Medical Associates; find no reasonable cause to believe that Harold McFall Landscaping, Inc., National Shoes and Stillwater Medical Associates made corporate contributions to the Beasley for Congress Committee; take no further action with regard to the contribution from ABC School Supply, Inc.



INTERIM REPORT

On February 15, 1978, the Commission found reason to believe the Beasley for Congress Committee violated 2 U.S.C. §441b in accepting corporate contributions totaling \$120 from the above-named businesses. The Commission also found reason to believe these businesses violated 2 U.S.C. §441b by making corporate contributions to the Beasley for Congress Committee.

Respondent ABC School Supply, Inc., has replied that a search of their records reveals no \$10 contribution to the Beasley for Congress Committee. The company has since been furnished with further information from this office concerning the contribution check found by the auditors. No further response has been received as yet from this respondent but word is expected soon.

Respondent National Shoes also has no record of the \$25 contribution they are alleged to have made. The Beasley Committee's records show a contribution from National Shoes in South Carolina with no more specific information as to the address. (A contribution of this amount does not require itemization under 11 C.F.R. §102.9(a).) National Shoes is incorporated in New York and qualified to do business in South Carolina, but in phone conversations between a member of this staff and the Company's Treasurer and attorney it was made known that the Company's stores in South Carolina deal only

with depository accounts from which monies are transferred to the firm's New York accounts. These stores are not authorized to make any draws from these depository accounts. The Treasurer would be aware of any contributions written on the corporate accounts and after a check of his records finds no evidence of such an occurrence. It is possible that the contribution detected by the auditors was made by another entity entitled National Shoes which is not incorporated in South Carolina or incorporated there under another name. In this situation, no further action is possible by this office unless a more specific address is furnished by the Beasley Committee.

This office's inquiry regarding the \$25 contribution attributed to the Rhodes Oil Company in the Committee's records was directed to Mr. Rhodes of the L.D. Rhodes Oil Company. Mr. Rhodes has checked his records and finds no such contribution. In a telephone conversation with a member of this staff, he explained that he has several brothers in the oil business who could have made this contribution. According to the Oklahoma Secretary of State's office, he is the only one who is incorporated.

Stillwater Medical Associates has replied that they did contribute \$50 dollars to the Beasley Committee but that they are a partnership. 

The Commission also found reason to believe that these businesses violated 2 U.S.C. §441b by making corporate contributions to the Beasley for Congress Committee.

At the time of the March 20, 1978, Interim Report, the General Counsel's Office was still awaiting responses to the letters of notification.

As of this date, all of the respondents have replied except two whose letters came back to this office undelivered. New addresses were determined for these respondents, and their replies are expected in the near future.

This letter is in reply to Mr. William C. Oldaker's letter of March 13, 1978 in which he pointed out your assignment to the Federal Election Commission's investigation of the Beasley for Congress Committee's acceptance of contributions totaling \$120.00 from five corporate sources.

The Committee did not intentionally or knowingly solicit or accept corporate contributions. There were instances in which offers of contributions from corporate entities were refused, but this is not documentable. There were also check contributions received by the Committee which were recognized as representing corporate contributions and were immediately returned. However, we are unable to document this fact.

In retrospect it may seem difficult to understand how these contributions got by our effort to be vigilant against such an occurrence. I would like to offer the following explanation.

First, the Candidate, as a busy family physician, was unable to get away from his medical practice long enough to either adequately campaign or stay in close contact with the Committee. Those of us on the Committee were volunteer workers with otherwise full-time employment. We had inadequate time and expertise. The campaign funds raised by the Committee were inadequate to hire expert accounting or legal council. I submit that these errors made by the Committee were not deliberate violations. We tried to the best of our knowledge and ability to avoid these mistakes.

Further, I would like to point out that the size of the contributions involved indicates error rather than intentional wrong-doing. Surely, no one would place himself in jeopardy over such small amounts.

This has been such a disrupting experience that the Beasley for Congress Committee is going to be discontinued as soon as the proper forms can be procured.

On behalf of the Committee and the Candidate, I can assure you that there was no intentional wrong-doing. I hope that the Commission understands how difficult it is for inexperienced individuals to try to carry out a political campaign and to avoid such error. Since this was honest error and not intentional wrong-doing, I request that you permit the Committee to simply return the amount of these contributions to the appropriate source.
