GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

Background

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On April 25, 1978 Reports Analysis referred to the Office of the General Counsel the names of six Pennsylvania House candidates who had failed to file a Statement of Candidacy and designate a Principal Campaign Committee. Reason to Believe and Reasonable Cause to Believe letters were mailed to these six candidates.

Five of the respondents filed their reports soon after receiving the RTB and RCTB notifications. On June 13, 1978 the Commission voted to take no further action with regard to these respondents. One respondent, Gene Bassalyga, remained, and, the Commission directed the Office of the General Counsel to attempt to obtain Mr. Bassalyga's reports.

Analysis

Mr. Bassalyga was contacted by the Office of the General Counsel on June 6, 1978. As Mr. Bassalyga claimed


he had misplaced his forms, additional forms were mailed to him the same day. However, as these reports were not received within two weeks the candidate was again contacted on July 11, 1978. Mr. Bassalyga stated that he gave these forms to his agent to fill out and would now check on their status. On August 4, 1978 the Commission received Mr. Bassalyga's Statement of Candidacy.



GENERATION OF MATTER

This matter generated from a referral by Peter Kell of Reports Analysis to William Oldaker on April 25, 1978. Six House candidates who have registered with the Pennsylvania Secretary of the State have failed to file a Statement of Candidacy and designate a Principal Campaign Committee with the Federal Election Commission. After Reasonable Cause to Believe letters were sent on April 18, 1978, the matter was referred over to the Office of the General Counsel for further action.

LEGAL ANALYSIS

Since the date of transmittal of this matter to the Office of the General Counsel, five of the above six respondents have filed their Statement of Candidacy with the Commission. The one remaining candidate, Gene Basalyga, sent a letter to the Commission on May 15, 1978. In this letter the candidate stated that as of that date he had only spent \$35 on registration fee and expected to spend no more than \$100 on his 1978 campaign. On June 6, 1978 Mr. Basalyga was telephoned and told he must file a Statement of Candidacy regardless of how much money he intended to spend during the year. Mr. Basalyga asked for the proper forms and agreed to file immediately. We expect to receive his reports within ten days.

RECOMMENDATION

- 1) With regard to the candidates Douglas Henderson, Richard C. Grove, Frank M. Clark, Doug Walgren and Joseph Vigorito we recommend that no further action be taken.
- 2) With regard to the candidate Gene Bassalyga we recommend waiting to receive his reports.

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
