GENERATION OF MATTER

This matter generated from a referral by Peter Kell of Reports Analysis to William Oldaker on April 28, 1978. Terry L. Hicks, Oregon House candidate for 1978, registered with the Oregon Secretary of State but failed to file a Statement of Candidacy and designate a Principal Campaign Committee with the Federal Election Commission. After a Reasonable Cause to Believe letter was sent on April 25, 1978, the matter was referred over to the Office of the General Counsel for further action.

LEGAL ANALYSIS

Since the date of transmittal of this matter to the Office of the General Counsel, respondent Terry L. Hicks filed a Statement of Candidacy and designated a Principal Campaign Committee with the Commission. Notification of this action was received by the Office of the General Counsel on May 4, 1978.

RECOMMENDATION

With regard to respondent Terry L. Hicks we recommend that no further action be taken.
