GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

Allegations

Two committees supporting Democratic candidates for the U.S. Senate in the March 21, 1978, Illinois primary election were referred to the Office of General Counsel from the Reports Analysis Division on July 10, 1978, for failing to file the 30 Day Post-Election report in violation of 2 U.S.C. §434. (Attachment I).

Evidence

1. Illinois Democratic Campaign Committee

Anthony Robert Martin-Trigona filed a statement of candidacy on July 12, 1977, in which he designated the Illinois Democratic Campaign Committee as his principal campaign committee.

The Commission found reason to believe on May 3, 1978; and reasonable cause to believe on May 19, 1978, that the Illinois Democratic Campaign Committee was in violation of 2 U.S.C. §434 for failing to file a 30 day post-election report. The Committee's name was published by the Press Office on June 19, 1978.

The reason to believe and reasonable cause to believe notices to the Respondent were unclaimed, and a telephone call to the candidate was not returned. The candidate sent a letter to the Commission, dated June 15, 1978, stating that he was resting after

a year of campaigning, and his combination 30 day post-election and termination report had been delayed. (Attachment II). Previous reports filed by the committee reveal \$976,419.07 in total primary expenditures. Mr. Martin-Trigona lost the primary election although he received 30.8% of the vote.

Due to the amount of expenditures made by the committee, and the percentage of the vote which the candidate received, it is recommended that the Commission find probable cause against the Illinois Democratic Campaign Committee and attempt to conciliate this matter in accordance with the Commission's non-filing procedures.

2. Seith for Senate

Alex Robert Seith filed a statement of candidacy on August 8, 1977, in which he designated the Seith for Senate Committee as his principal campaign committee.

The Commission found reason to believe on May 3, 1978; and reasonable cause to believe on May 19, 1978, that the Seith for Senate Committee was in violation of 2 U.S.C. §434 for failing to file a 30 day post-election report. The Committee's name was published by the Press Office on June 19, 1978. The Committee received the Commission's reason to believe and reasonable cause to believe notifications.

On July 10, 1978, Garry South, treasurer of the Seith for Senate Committee, called the Reports Analysis Division and stated that the 30 day post-election report was mailed to the Senate on July 3, 1978. The postmark on the report proved to be July 3, 1978. The Committee reports reveal total primary expenditures of \$218,043.05. Mr. Seith won the primary election receiving 69.2% of the vote.

Due to the amount of expenditures made by the committee, and the percentage of the vote which the candidate received, it is recommended that the Commission find probable cause against the Seith for Senate Committee and attempt to conciliate this matter in accordance with the Commission's non-filing procedures.



CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

This matter having been initiated on the basis of information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities, an investigation having been conducted, and the Commission having found probable cause to believe that respondent, the Illinois Democratic Campaign Committee, (the Committee), violated 2 U.S.C. §434(a)(1)(A)(ii) by failing to file its 30 day post primary election report.

Now, therefore, the respective parties herein, the Federal Election Commission and respondent Committee having duly entered into conciliation pursuant to 437g(a)(5), do hereby agree as follows:

- I. That the Federal Election Commission has jurisdiction over respondent and the subject of this proceeding.
- II. That respondent Committee has had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.
- III. That the pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:
  - A. That reports filed by the Illinois Democratic Campaign Committee show primary expenditures of \$976,419.07.
  - B. That the Committee, as of July 25, 1978, had failed to file its 30 day post-primary report; thereby making the report over 90 days late.

THEREFORE, respondent Committee agrees:

- I. Respondent's action in failing to file its 30 day post primary election report on April 21, 1978, was in violation of 2 U.S.C. §434(a)(1)(A)(ii).
- II. Respondent will file the 30 day post primary report of receipts and expenditures as a provision of this conciliation agreement.
- III. That it will pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$5000 pursuant to 2 U.S.C. §437g(a)(6)(B)(i).
- IV. Respondent agrees that it will not undertake any activity which is in violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, 2 U.S.C. §431, et seq.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- I. The Commission, on the request of anyone filing a complaint under 2 U.S.C. §437g(a)(1) concerning the matters at issue herein, or on its own motion, may review compliance with this agreement. If the Commission believes that this agreement or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute civil action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.
- II. It is mutually agreed that this agreement shall become effective as of the date that all parties hereto have executed same and the Commission has approved the entire agreement.



In addition, we would like to file one final report as a post election and termination report.


Accordingly, we have been delayed in completing and filing the necessary documentation.
