GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

I. BACKGROUND:

On August 28, 1978, Reports Analysis Division referred to the Office of General Counsel the names of Lenore Etchison and the Committee to Elect Etchison U.S. Senate for failure to file a 30 day post-primary report. Reason to believe was found on June 20, 1978 and reasonable cause to believe was found on July 7, 1978 that respondents were in violation of 2 U.S.C. §434 for their failure to file. Respondents' names were published by the Commission on August 7, 1978.

II. ANALYSIS:

Lenore Etchison was a candidate for the United States Senate in the Nebraska Republican primary held on May 9, 1978. (See newspaper article attached). Ms. Etchison lost the election receiving 21% of the total vote cast. The Committee to Elect Etchison U.S. Senate is the principal campaign committee of Ms. Etchison.

A civil action has been filed by the Commission against the Committee to Elect Etchison '76 for failure to file reports in 1977. A review of Lenore Etchison's records indicates that she and her committee also failed to file a 10 day pre-primary report for the 1978 Nebraska


primary election.

In view of these facts, the General Counsel's Office recommends that the Commission find probable cause to believe that Lenore Etchison and the Committee to Elect Etchison U.S. Senate have violated 2 U.S.C.§434 for failure to file a 30 post-primary report. We also recommend that the Commission authorize the General Counsel's Office to incorporate in the civil action against the Committee to Elect Etchison '76 respondents' failure to file the 30 day post-primary report.

III. RECOMMENDATION:

1. Find probable cause to believe that Lenore Etchison and the Committee to Elect Etchison U.S. Senate have violated 2 U.S.C.§434 for failure to file 30 day post-election reports.
2. Incorporate this matter into the civil action which has been filed by the Commission against Lenore Etchison and the Committee to Elect Etchison '76.

Lenore Etchison seeking GOP nomination

Senate candidate may be living in car

OMAHA (UPI) — A candidate for the Republican U.S. Senate nomination may not only use her car for transportation to campaign appearances but may live in it as well, it was reported Monday.

No one in Sarpy County, including school district officials, knows where Mrs. Lenore Etchison has been living since authorities said she was asked to leave a Papillion apartment about a year ago.

However, Mrs. Etchison listed the Papillion address in January when she changed party registration from Democratic to Republican. The account of Mrs. Etchison's residence, or the lack of it, was carried in Monday's editions of the Omaha World-Herald.

Saturday in Lincoln, a reporter at the state GOP Founders Day asked her

where she lived, but she declined to comment, saying, "My press secretary will get in touch with you."

The press secretary, Mrs. Jo Bragg of Lincoln, later told a reporter he could meet Mrs. Etchison at the University of Nebraska at Omaha library Sunday. The reporter went to the library but was told no one had seen the candidate.

"I don't know how to get in touch with her," Mrs. Bragg said. "She is on the move. I've never asked her where she lives."

Mrs. Bragg said Mrs. Etchison contacted her Monday and said speaking engagements elsewhere prevented her from keeping the UNO appointment.

A report filed by Sarpy County Sheriff Pat Thomas and interviews with others indicate Mrs. Etchison and her son, Hughie, about 16, may be living in the family's car.

"There are a number of reports she is living in her car," a Sarpy County official said. The operator of a late-hour coin laundry said Papillion residents have reported seeing the Etchison car in the parking lot behind the laundry at night.

"We have found discarded food containers in the trash," the operator said.

On Jan. 29, when the temperature was 9 below zero, Thomas said, he observed Mrs. Etchison's car parked at a camper hookup near the Offutt Air Force Base lake and pavilion.

In his report, Thomas said Mrs. Etchison was in the front seat reading a newspaper and the son was in the rear seat, sleeping. Thomas, who has known Mrs. Etchison since she was a teacher in Bellevue, said he approached the car and asked Mrs. Etchison if she was all right and she said she was.

"I could not see what type of heating apparatus she had hooked to the electrical outlet," Thomas said, adding that it appeared to be "very hot" inside the car.

Thomas said there was "so much paraphernalia" in the back seat that there was no room for her son to stretch out. Thomas said he saw newspapers, pots and pans, a plastic bag filled with cabbage — what appeared to be cabbage all cut up.

Sarpy County officials think

Mrs. Etchison's husband, Hubert, is now living in Georgia. Mrs. Etchison, who filed for the Senate as a pauper, recently applied for aid - to - dependent - children payments of \$250 monthly. She has not followed up on her application with the necessary documentation, officials said.

Mrs. Etchison, who made a token showing in the 1976 Democratic U.S. Senate primary, is the mother of two daughters, both of whom attend Smith College in Northampton, Mass., one of the nation's most exclusive

women's colleges. Papillion High School Principal Keith Pollard said Hughie Etchison is a good student and is a member of the school track team.

However, school officials said they are uncertain where Mrs. Etchison lives or what is considered her legal address.

Sarpy County attorney Pat Kelly said he wrote for the school board an opinion stating that "residency is a state of mind."

"I've always had a difficult time defining residency or domicile," Kelly said.

Candidate's Home Apparently Inside Her Car

Mrs. Lenore Etchison of Papillion, candidate for the Republican nomination for the U.S. Senate, is a woman who declines to say where she lives.

She does not live at the address she listed in January when she changed party registration. The owner of the building at the address said she has not lived there for about a year.

In Lincoln Saturday, at Republican Founders' Day, she was asked by a newsman where she lived. She refused to say.

"My press secretary will be in touch with you," she said.

The press secretary, Mrs. Jo Bragg of Lincoln, called later and said a reporter could meet Mrs. Etchison at the University of Nebraska at Omaha library Sunday.

A reporter went to the library Sunday, but found no one who had seen Mrs. Etchison.

"I don't know how to get in touch with her," Mrs. Bragg said later Sunday. "She is on the move."

"I've never asked her where she lives."

Asked to Leave

On Monday, Mrs. Bragg said Mrs. Etchison contacted her

later and told her she did not keep the appointment at UNO because she had to go to speaking engagements elsewhere.

The address listed by Mrs. Etchison on her Sarpy County registration card is 126 N. Washington. It is an apartment in the rear of a building that houses Galaxy Construction Co.

Dave Rak, a vice president of the company, said Mrs. Etchison was asked to leave the apartment about a year ago.

Since then, no one in Sarpy County, including school district officials, knows where Mrs. Etchison has been living.

"There are a number of reports that she is living in her car," one official said.

The operator of a late-hour coin laundry said Papillion residents have reported seeing the Etchison car in the parking lot behind the laundry at night.

Some persons reported seeing Mrs. Etchison in the laundry at a late hour using facilities.

"We have found discarded food containers in the trash," the operator said.

At 4 p.m., Sunday, Jan. 29, when the overnight low temperature was nine below zero, Sheriff Pat Thomas saw Mrs. Etchison's 1965 Chrysler parked at a camper hook-up near the Offutt Air Force Base lake and pavilion.

"The vehicle was occupied by Mrs. Etchison and her son, approximately 16 years old," Thomas wrote in an office report.

The report said Mrs. Etchison was in the front seat reading a newspaper and the son was in the rear seat sleeping.

Hot in Car

Thomas' report said tracks in the snow indicated the car had been there some time.

"It had electrical lines coming from the hookups," the report said.

"When I approached the ve-



hicle . . . I tapped on the window . . . and asked if I could help."

The report quoted Mrs. Etchison, who Thomas has known since she was a teacher in Bellevue, as saying she was all right.

"I could not see what type of heating apparatus she had hooked to the electrical outlet, but it seemed very hot inside (the car)," the report said.

The report said the back seat "had so much paraphernalia" there was no room for young Hughie Etchison to stretch out.

The report said Thomas saw in the car "newspapers, pots and pans, one plastic bag filled with cabbage — what appeared to be cabbage all cut up."

"On the front dash of the car was a large butcher knife that was very dirty which looked like it had been cutting cake or something," the report said.

Thomas concluded the report saying: "Mrs. Etchison said

that they had no problem and this officer then left the scene."

Good Student

Officials of the LaVista-Papillion School District are reluctant to discuss the question of whether Mrs. Etchison is a qualified resident of the district.

Two of her daughters have graduated from Papillion High School and were outstanding students, Principal Keith Pollard said.

Hughie Etchison is Mrs. Etchison's last child in high school, Pollard said. He said he is a good student and a member of the school track team.

"His mother picks him up after school," Pollard said.

The girls are in an Eastern college.

The World-Herald learned both now are students at Smith College, Northhampton, Mass., one of the country's most exclusive colleges for women.

A spokesman at Smith said Marta Etchison is a junior at Smith and Jerolyn is a freshman.

In 1976, Jerolyn won one of the country's most prestigious scholarships — National Merit

Scholarship — but Pollard said the scholarship later was revoked when it was learned Jerolyn had not completed one English course.

She later completed it, he said, but too late to get the scholarship.

Jerolyn was elected lieutenant governor at Nebraska Girls State in 1976, the same year her mother was a candidate for the Democratic nomination to the U.S. Senate.

Mrs. Etchison collected about 5 percent of the vote compared with 49 percent for the winner, Edward Zorinsky, and 47 percent for runnerup Hles Dyas.

In the 1978 campaign, Mrs. Etchison — now a Republican — has made few appearances.

She came late to the GOP Founders' Day observance in Lincoln and was denied a chance to speak because she arrived well after the time set aside for campaign speeches.

Later she appeared in a television interview on KETV, Channel 7, with her primary opponent, Don Shasteen of Hastings.


