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This matter has been initiated on the basis of information ascertained in the normal course of the Commission's supervisory responsibilities, an investigation has been conducted, and the Commission has found reasonable cause to believe that respondent, Richard H. Riley, violated 2 U.S.C. §434(a)(1)(A)(i) by filing his 10 Day Pre-Primary Election Report late.

Therefore, the Federal Election Commission and respondent, Richard H. Riley having duly entered into conciliation pursuant to §437g(a)(5), do hereby agree as follows:

I. That the Federal Election Commission has jurisdiction over respondent and the subject of this proceeding.

II. That respondent has had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against him in this matter.

III. That the pertinent facts in this matter are that Richard H. Riley, as of July 29, 1978, failed to file his 10 Day Pre-Primary Report; the report was filed on August 8, 1978, thereby making the report ten (10) days late.

Therefore, respondent agrees:

I. That his action in failing to file the 10 Day Pre-Primary Election Report on July 29, 1978, was in violation of 2 U.S.C. §434(a)(1)(A)(i).



GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

On October 16, 1978, the Commission voted to adopt the recommendation contained in the General Counsel's report to conciliate with respondent Riley, a Missouri 10 Day Pre-Primary late filer.

On October 19, 1978, a conciliation agreement was sent to respondent Riley by certified mailed, and received by him on October 21, 1978.

On October 30, 1978, a letter from the respondent was received by the Commission. The letter indicated that respondent wishes to discuss the conciliation agreement.

On November 2, 1978, the respondent telephoned the General Counsel's Office and stated he will submit, in writing, his proposed changes to the conciliation agreement.

On November 13, 1978, the Commission received the attached letter from the respondent, which delineates his reasons for filing late.

In a subsequent telephone conversation, the respondent offered to pay a civil penalty of \$50 in settlement of this matter.

On November 20, 1978, the Commission received the conciliation agreement with respondent's counter-proposal and a check for \$50 in settlement of this matter.

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In the light of the reasons stated in the respondent's letter of November 4, 1978, and the fact that he aggregated only \$79.63 in receipts and \$164.63 in expenditures during his campaign, the Office of the General Counsel recommends that the Commission reduce the respondent's civil penalty from \$250.00 to \$50.00.

RECOMMENDATION

Accept the respondent's counter proposal reducing the civil penalty from \$250.00 to \$50.00, and approve the attached conciliation agreement.

GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

I. Background

On August 25, 1978, the Reports Analysis Division referred, to the Office of the General Counsel, the names of eight (8) Missouri Congressional candidates and committees, which failed to file their ten (10) Day Pre-Primary Election Reports in violation of 2 U.S.C. §434(a)(1).

The reports were due on July 29, 1978. "Reason to believe" notices were sent by mailgram on July 31, 1978, and "reasonable cause to believe" notices were similarly sent on August 2, 1978. On August 5, 1978, a list of those candidates and committees which failed to file the ten (10) Day Pre-Primary report were published.

II. Analysis

A. Respondent Riley subsequently filed his ten (10) Day Pre-Primary Election report on August 8, 1978, making his report ten (10) days late. As indicated on the attached chart, the respondent received over 30% of the vote in the primary election.

Therefore, the General Counsel's office recommends, in accordance with the report of the task force on non-filers, dated May 23, 1978, that compliance action with respondent Riley be continued.

B. Respondent Amelung for Congress never has filed its

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ten (10) Day Pre-Primary Election report. Amelung the candidate, however, has filed a ten (10) Day Pre-Primary Election report on August 3, 1978, two (2) days prior to publication of his Committee. Also, his committee filed a 3A postcard in lieu of its July 10, quarterly reports, indicating less than 1,000 in activity.

Therefore, the General Counsel Office recommends, in accordance with the report of the task force on non-filers, that no further action be taken against respondent, Amelung for Congress.

C. Respondents Shelton, Committee to Elect Helen Gerleman, Goins for Congress Committee, Panlasigui, Tei for Congress and Roche subsequently filed their ten(10) Day Pre-Primary reports late, as indicated on the attached chart. These respondents, however, did not have \$25,000 in contributions and expenditures, or reach the 30% vote threshold as outlined in the task force on non-filers, and therefore the General Counsel's Office recommends that no further action be taken against them.

III. Recommendations

A. With respect to the following respondent, find that compliance action should be continued, approve the attached conciliation agreement and send the attached letter:

If such agreement isn't reached, the Commission may institute civil suit in the United States District Court and seek payment of a civil penalty not to exceed \$5,000.

A proposed conciliation agreement is enclosed, which this office is prepared to recommend to the Commission in settlement of this matter.

If you agree with the provisions of the enclosed conciliation agreement, please sign and return it along with the civil penalty, to the Federal Election Commission within ten (10) days. I will then recommend that the Commission approve the agreement.

The Zagoria Affair

The Senate Rules Committee moved toward a vote on the controversial nomination of Samuel D. Zagoria to a Republican vacancy on the Federal Election Commission (FEC) as hearings continued through Aug. 10.

Like John W. McGarry, nominated by President Carter to fill a Democratic vacancy on the commission, Zagoria has drawn vocal Republican opposition.

Republican leaders agreed throughout the hearings that Zagoria, a director of labor-management relations for the U.S. Conference of Mayors and a veteran Republican campaign worker, was well-qualified for the FEC post. But they charged that in nominating Zagoria, Carter broke a pledge to include them in the nominating process.

Senate Minority Leader Howard H. Baker Jr. and House Minority Leader John J. Rhodes told the Rules Committee that on Feb. 23, 1977, the president promised that he would fill all Republican vacancies on the commission from a list of names submitted by the GOP leadership. Three names were submitted and Zagoria's was not one of them.

"The president has not lived up to the commitment that he made in that meeting," said Baker. "There is nothing more fundamental in politics than living up to your commitment."

Rhodes added that in nominating a person not approved by the Republican leadership, Carter was establishing a precedent that could undermine the bipartisan balance on the politically sensitive FEC. "It betrays all concepts of fair play," he concluded.

A letter signed by 132 House Republicans protesting Zagoria's nomination was submitted.

Democratic committee members countered the Republican criticism by noting that the 1976 decision of the Supreme Court in *Buckley v. Valeo* gave the president complete power to make all appointments to the FEC. It was noted that in May 1977 Carter had asked the Republican congressional leaders to submit a list with 10 to 12 additional names for the FEC vacancy, but that only one more name was submitted.

Zagoria was formally nominated by Carter in October 1977. Republican leaders said they read about it for the first time in the newspapers. Confirmation hearings for Zagoria and McGarry were begun last November, but not completed before the end of the 1977 session. Both names were resubmitted April 10, with GOP leaders again contending that they were not consulted.

Although Zagoria drew high marks from Republican witnesses for his experience and integrity, he has attracted some criticism for his ties to organized labor and the liberal wing of the party. He is a past president of the Washington Newspaper Guild and a former member of the National Labor Relations Board, and served as an aide to Sen. Clifford P. Case, R-N.J.

Zagoria was nominated to replace former Rep. William L. Springer, R-Ill., on the six-member FEC, while McGarry would succeed Democrat Neil O. Staebler of Michigan. The terms of Springer and Staebler both expired April 30 but the two men have stayed on until their successors are confirmed.

House Primary:

Snowden Nominated In Missouri's 6th

Democrats in the 6th Congressional District of north-west Missouri voted Aug. 8 to nominate Phil Snowden, a state senator from suburban Kansas City, as their candidate against freshman Republican Rep. E. Thomas Coleman.

The 6th District primary was the highlight of a relatively quiet Missouri election day. All ten incumbent U.S. representatives were renominated.

Snowden, once a star quarterback for the University of Missouri, defeated his closest foe, Bob Slater, a former St. Joseph newspaper editor, by 4,500 votes. Snowden entered the contest late, but raised money quickly and organized an aggressive campaign.

The results split along geographic lines. Snowden won nearly half of the vote in Clay and Platte counties, which contain parts of Kansas City and its suburbs. Slater won only nine percent of the vote in the two suburban counties.

Slater won slightly more than half of the vote in Buchanan County (St. Joseph), while Snowden won 18 percent.

In the combined vote of the district's 20 rural counties Snowden ran ahead of Slater. However, Snowden and Slater each won seven counties.

Morgan Maxfield, a Kansas City business entrepreneur, also carried seven rural counties and finished third in the balloting. Maxfield was Coleman's Democratic opponent two years ago and was considered the favorite until his campaign chairman quit shortly before the general election contending that Maxfield had misrepresented his own marital status.

The November contest between Snowden and Coleman matches two former colleagues in the Missouri House of Representatives. Until Coleman's election, the 6th District had been represented in the U.S. House for 22 years by Democrats, although it has been carried by some Republican statewide candidates in recent years.

In the 2nd Congressional District, Bob Chase, a former television newscaster, handily won the Republican nomination to oppose Democratic Rep. Robert A. Young.

Democratic Rep. William (Bill) Clay had little problem with six primary opponents. St. Louis City Sheriff Benjamin L. Goins had been expected to give Clay a stiff challenge, but he was convicted in June of corruption in office and tax evasion. Goins finished fifth.

In Missouri's only statewide race this year, former Gov. Warren E. Hearnes, defeated three others to win the Democratic nomination for state auditor. He was the unsuccessful Democratic Senate candidate two years ago. Republicans are expected to wage a strong battle against Hearnes in November.

In the wake of California voters' approval of Proposition 13, which rolled back property taxes, Missouri residents overwhelmingly turned down a proposed increase in the state gasoline tax from seven cents a gallon to 10 cents. The gas tax proposal, which was placed on the ballot by initiative petitions, received less than a 13 percent favorable vote.
