GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

BACKGROUND:

A review of the 1977 year end report filed by the Friends of Gillis Long Committee (the "Committee") disclosed the receipt of a \$200 contribution on 28 October 1977 from the Thibodaux Central Trades & Labor Council (the "Council") which appeared to violate 2 U.S.C. §441b(a). The Committee was notified of the violation on 19 June 1978 and on 29 June 1978 submitted an adequate response and refunded the contribution to the Council.

PREVIOUS COMMISSION ACTION:

On 23 October 1978 the Commission determined to take no further action against the Committee based on the fact that (1) the contribution was refunded and (2) the matter involved an October 1977 contribution.

On 23 October 1978, the Commission also determined to find reason to believe that the Thibodaux Central Trades & Labor Council violated 2 U.S.C. §441b(a) in connection with its contribution to the Committee. The Council was notified of the Commission's determination on 27 October 1978.

NEW EVIDENCE:

Mr. John Avant, the Council's representative, notified the Commission by phone on 2 November 1978 that the \$200 contribution was a "mere inadvertence" and that a letter would follow to further explain the situation. The Commission received the response on 6 November 1978. (See attachment I).

The Council's representative stated in the letter that when the Council approved the purchase of two tickets to a barbecue sponsored by the Committee, it had no knowledge that the Council was a "labor organization" under §441b(a). As central bodies are not labor organizations within the meaning of the Landrum-Griffin Act, the Council assumed that it would not be considered as such under §441b(a).


ANALYSIS:

Due to the fact that (1) the October 1977 contribution was refunded and (2) the Council states that the illegal contribution was tendered through inadvertance, we believe no further action should be taken against the Council.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. Take no further action against the Thibodaux Central Trades & Labor Council and close the file.
2. Send the attached letter.

Based on information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities, the Federal Election Commission has found reason to believe that the Thibodaux Central Trades and Labor Council may have violated certain provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act").

Specifically it appears that the Thibodaux Central Trades and Labor Council contributed \$200 on 28 October 1977 to the Friends of Gillis Long Committee in violation of Section 441b(a) of the Act. This section of the Act prohibits labor unions from making contributions to Federal political committees. Although we note that the Committee returned this contribution to you on 29 June 1978, the Act was violated when the contribution was originally made. We have numbered this matter MUR 758.

Under the Act, you have an opportunity to demonstrate that no further action should be taken against you. Please submit any factual or legal materials which you believe are relevant to the Commission's analysis of this matter. Where appropriate, statements should be submitted under oath.



GENERATION OF MATTER

A review of the 1977 year end report filed by the Friends of Gillis Long Committee (Committee) disclosed the receipt of a \$200 contribution on 28 October 1977 from the Thibodaux Central Trades and Labor Council (Council), which appeared to be a contribution from a labor organization in violation of 2 U.S.C. §441b(a). This matter was referred to the Office of General Counsel by the Reports Analysis Division on 5 October 1978 (See Attachment I).

EVIDENCE

The Committee was notified of the surface violation on 19 June 1978, and the Committee submitted an adequate response on 29 June 1978. The Committee stated that the \$200 contribution was refunded on that day. (See Attachment II). The Committee's July 10 quarterly reports disclose a \$200 refund to the Council on 29 June 1978. The Commission has not notified the Thibodaux Central Trades and Labor Council of the violation.

PRELIMINARY LEGAL ANALYSIS

On 26 July 1978, the Commission discussed the subject of civil penalties in connection with violations of 2 U.S.C. §44lb, which prohibits corporate and labor contributions. All candidates and committees were notified in August 1978 that pursuant to the Commission's determination, the Commission would thereafter assess civil penalties against contributors and recipients of corporate and labor union contributions in addition to the existing requirement that such contributions be refunded.

Due to the fact that this matter involves an October 1977 labor union contribution which has been refunded, it appears that no further action should be taken against the Committee; however, the Commission should find reason to believe that the Council violated 2 U.S.C. §44lb(a).





Based on information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities, the Federal Election Commission has found reason to believe that the Thibodaux Central Trades and Labor Council may have violated certain provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act").

Specifically it appears that the Thibodaux Central Trades and Labor Council contributed \$200 on 28 October 1977 to the Friends of Gillis Long Committee in violation of Section 441b(a) of the Act. This section of the Act prohibits labor unions from making contributions to Federal political committees. Although we note that the Committee returned this contribution to you on 29 June 1978, the Act was violated when the contribution was originally made. We have numbered this matter MUR 758.

Under the Act, you have an opportunity to demonstrate that no further action should be taken against you. Please submit any factual or legal materials which you believe are relevant to the Commission's analysis of this matter. Where appropriate, statements should be submitted under oath.

The Commission is under a duty to investigate this matter expeditiously. Therefore, your response should be submitted within ten days after your receipt of this notification.
