General Counsel's Report

Background

On October 24, 1978, the respondent, the principal campaign committee for Damian Jerome Santay, was referred to the Office of General Counsel as a non-filer in regard to Mr. Santay's candidacy for the House of Representatives from the 1st Congressional District in Indiana in the primary election held on May 2, 1978. The respondent was previously before the Commission as a non-filer in regard to the same candidacy in MUR 594 (78) for its failure to file the ten day pre-primary report required by 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(1)(A)(i). (Additionally, Mr. Santay was before the Commission as a non-filer in regard to the same candidacy in MUR 566 for failure to file a Statement of Candidate and to designate a Principal Campaign Committee).

In regard to the present MUR, the respondent failed to file a Statement of Organization (FEC form 1) with the Clerk of the House. The Commission notified respondent to that effect in a letter dated July 21, 1978. The Commission found reason to believe that the respondent had violated 2 U.S.C. § 433 and so notified the respondent by certified mail in a letter dated August 25, 1978. The

Commission found reasonable cause to believe that the respondent had violated 2 U.S.C. § 432(e)(1) and 11 C.F.R. § 101.2. A letter notifying the respondent of this finding was mailed to it by certified mail on September 20, 1978. There has been no response from the respondent.

Evidence

In the primary on May 2, 1978, Mr. Santay was defeated, receiving 9.1% of the vote. (Attached is a page from The Congressional Quarterly illustrating the outcome of this election). Previously in a telephone conversation with a staff member in Reports Analysis Mr. Santay indicated that he was not a serious candidate and was not sure whether or not there would be any receipts or expenditures for his campaign. (See attached telecon of 4/10/78 from MUR 566).

Recommendation

In view of Mr. Santay's defeat, receiving 9.1% of the vote in an election held six months ago, and of the lack of indication that he had receipts or expenditures, we recommend that the Commission take no further action with regard to the Santay for Congress Committee and that the file be closed.

Upon review of the Statement of Candidate filed by Damian Jerome Santay, we noted that your committee has been designated as the principal campaign committee pursuant to 2 U.S.C. 432(e)(1).

Commission Regulations require each principal campaign committee to register within ten (10) days of being designated by the candidate, regardless of whether or not it anticipates receiving contributions or making expenditures in excess of \$1,000. her to overcome Tipton's strength in the rural areas. In her home county of Monroe (Blountingon), for example, she received 75.3 percent of the vote, compared to the second-place Tipton's 15.4 percent. And in vote-rich Vigo County (Terre Haute), Zietlow got 48.6 percent of the vote to Tipton's 29.6 percent. Raymond R. Cronin Jr. and Dallas Meneely, two media people well known in the Terre Haute area, pulled only 17.1 percent between them in Vigo Coun-

ty, not much better than the 12.6 percent they received district-wide.

Zietlow's victory sets up a distinct liberal-conservative race for November. Known as a consumer-oriented activist, Zietlow has been attacking Myers for favoring oil companies and big business in general. Whether such charges can overcome Myers' effective constituency service and personal popularity remains an open question.

Mr. Santay called to say that he was sorry that he hadn't filed his Form 2 and that he was in the process of trying to file it at this time. He wanted to know if he had to have a principal campaign committee if all receipts and expenditures, if there were any, were handled through the candidate. I told him that he would have to form one anyway and that it would have to have two officers, a chairman and a treasurer. He said that he had two friends that could act as treasurer and chair, but he wanted to know if he had to designate a depository and open a bank account for the committee if they planned to raise and spend money. I told him that the Regs. stated that a depository had to be designated.

I told him to know if we had any more literature we could send him that he found it very helpful. I told him that we would send him a copy of the Law and the Regs., which he didn't think that he had received. He said that he would try to get his Form 2 in right away, even though he was not a serious candidate.
