

I. BACKGROUND

On November 7, 1978, the name of Debra Figueroa was referred from the Reports Analysis Division to the Office of General Counsel for failure to file a statement of candidacy and to designate a principal campaign committee. Ms. Figueroa is registered as a House candidate with the Hawaii Secretary of State. On September 15, 1978, the Commission mailed certified reason to believe letter to Ms. Figueroa. On October 4, 1978, the Commission mailed certified reasonable cause to believe letter to Ms. Figueroa.


II. ANALYSIS

The Federal Election Commission has not received your candidate statement designating a principal campaign committee for the primary election to be held in your state. Prior notification was sent to you approximately 30 days ago, advising you of your disclosure reporting requirements under the Federal Election Campaign Act along with the appropriate forms. We are enclosing another candidate statement (FEC Form 2) for your immediate attention. If you need additional forms, please let us know.

Your failure to file a candidate statement and to designate a principal campaign committee gives the Commission reason to believe that you are in violation of 2 U.S.C. 432(e)(1) and 11 C.F.R. 101.2.

No action will be taken against you until you have had a reasonable opportunity to respond to this matter. If you have not filed a candidate statement or designated a principal campaign committee, you should do so within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter with the Clerk of the House, Office of Records and Registration, 1036 Longworth H.O.B., Washington, D.C. 20515.

A copy of these statements should also be filed with your Secretary of State or the equivalent state officer. In the event you have already filed the required statements, or require further information, please contact Kevin Kelly in our Reports Analysis Division on the toll free number (800)424-9530. You have been notified twice of the requirement for you to file your Statement of Candidate (FEC Form 2), designating a principal campaign committee as required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.

As of this date, we have received no response from you. Your continued failure to file the required document gives the Commission reasonable cause to believe that you are in violation of 2 U.S.C. 432(e)(1) and 11 CFR 101.2.

You are hereby afforded a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate why no action should be taken against you. You have thirty (30) days from the date of your receipt of this letter to conciliate this matter with the Commission. If we do not receive an adequate response from you, the Reports Analysis Division must refer this matter to our Office of General Counsel for appropriate legal action.

You should file the required documents with the Clerk of the House, Office of Records and Registration, 1035 Longworth HOB, Washington, D.C. 20515. A copy of these statements should also be filed with your Secretary of State or the equivalent state officer.
