GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

BACKGROUND

Pursuant to a routine review of filed reports, the Reports Analysis Division discovered that the respondent, a District of Columbia corporation, contributed \$200 to the Young Republican National Federation (YRNF) on January 23, 1978. This contribution was refunded by YRNF on September 19, 1978, after a finding of reason to believe had been made. The matter was then referred to the General Counsel's Office.

On March 1, 1979 the Commission determined to close the file with regard to YRNF and found reason to believe that Jay Parker and Associates, Inc. (JP) had violated 2 U.S.C. §441b(a) by making this contribution to YRNF.

PERTINENT FACTS

J.A. Parker, the president of JP responded to the Commission's reason to believe finding by a letter dated March 13, 1979 (See attachment). Essentially, it is stated that this contribution was inadvertently made on the corporate account and a refund was requested by JP as soon as this error was noticed. In a telephone conversation, counsel for JP stated to us that no other contributions of this type have been, or will be, made.

LEGAL ANALYSIS

For corporate contributions made prior to August 1978, Commission policy has been to document the fact of the refund of the contribution and close the file, taking no further action against the contributor and recipient. As the contribution in issue has been verified as being refunded and was made prior to August of 1978, and in view of Mr. Parker's representations, it is recommended that this matter be closed.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Take no further action and close the file
2. Approve the attached letter.







Based on information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities, the Federal Election Commission has found reason to believe that your corporation may have violated certain provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). Specifically it appears that in making a contribution of \$200 on January 23, 1978 to the Young Republican National Federation, your corporation violated 2 U.S.C. § 441b, which prohibits any corporation from making a contribution in connection with a Federal election. Although we note that the Young Republican National Federation returned the contribution to you on or about September 19, 1978, the Act was violated when the contribution was made. We have numbered this matter MUR 906(79).

Under the Act, you have an opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against you. Please submit any factual or legal materials which you believe are relevant to the Commission's analysis of this matter. Where appropriate, statements should be submitted under oath.

The Commission is under a duty to investigate this matter expeditiously. Therefore, your response should be submitted within ten days after your receipt of this notification.

GENERATION OF MATTER

This matter was referred to the Office of the General Counsel by the Reports Analysis Division by a memo dated January 17, 1979 (referral memo attached). A review of respondent Young Republican National Federation's (YRNF) April 10, 1978 quarterly report showed the receipt of \$200 from a Washington, D.C. corporation.

EVIDENCE

The respondent was advised of the prohibition on the receipt of corporate contributions by letter of June 12, 1978. No response was received and a second letter was sent on August 10, 1978, again advising the respondent of the prohibition on corporate contributions, and that its failure to respond to the first letter in a timely manner had given the Commission reason to believe that 2 U.S.C. §441b had been violated. While no response to the second letter was received, <sup>1</sup>/<sub>1</sub> a routine review of the respondent's October 10, 1978 quarterly report revealed that this contribution had been refunded on September 19, 1978.

1/ The referral file does not contain either return receipt sent with both of the letters.

PRELIMINARY ANALYSIS

Section 441b(a) of the Act renders it unlawful for a corporation to make a contribution in connection with any federal election. Thus the Act was violated when Jay Parker and Associates made the contribution in question.

The Commission, on July 26, 1978, discussed the subject of civil penalties in connection with violations of 2 U.S.C. §441b which prohibits corporate contributions. Based on the Commission's decision, all candidates and committees were notified in August, 1978, that in the future, the Commission would not only require that corporate contributions be refunded, but that civil penalties would be assessed against the contributor and recipient of such contributions. Due to the fact that this matter deals with a corporate contribution prior to August, 1978, which has been refunded, it appears that no further action should be taken against the YRNF; however, the Commission should find reason to believe that Jay Parker and Associates violated 2 U.S.C. §441b(a) for making the contribution.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Based on information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities, the Federal Election Commission has found reason to believe that your corporation may have violated certain provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). Specifically it appears that in making a contribution of \$200 on January 23, 1978 to the Young Republican National Federation, your corporation violated 2 U.S.C. § 441b, which prohibits any corporation from making a contribution in connection with a Federal election. Although we note that the Young Republican National Federation returned the contribution to you on or about September 19, 1978, the Act was violated when the contribution was made. We have numbered this matter MUR 906(79).

Under the Act, you have an opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against you. Please submit any factual or legal materials which you believe are relevant to the Commission's analysis of this matter. Where appropriate, statements should be submitted under oath.

The Commission is under a duty to investigate this matter expeditiously. Therefore, your response should be submitted within ten days after your receipt of this notification.
