

GENERATION OF MATTER

A review of the 10 day pre-primary report, covering the period April 1, 1978 through May 8, 1978, filed by the Bob Wood for Fourth District Congress Committee (the Committee) disclosed receipt of three contributions which appeared to be in violation of 2 U.S.C. §441b(a): \$150 on April 28, 1978 from Emerald Trailer Sales, Inc.; \$300 on May 1, 1978 from Phelps, McGrath, Bowden, Inc.; and \$150 on April 28, 1978 from Stapp's Mobile Homes, Inc. The Reports Analysis Division referred this matter to the Office of General Counsel on March 16, 1979. (See attachment I).

EVIDENCE

The Committee was notified of the surface violation on June 9, 1978 and submitted an adequate response on June 20, 1978 indicating the contributions had been refunded. The Committee's 30 day post-primary report disclosed that the three contributions were refunded on June 8, 1978.

Dear Mr. Gregory:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's interest in assisting candidates and committees who wish to comply with the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended. During review of the 10 Day Pre-Primary Report of Receipts and Expenditures, we noticed entries indicating that you may have accepted contributions from a corporation. Corporate contributions are prohibited by the Act, unless the contribution is made by a separate segregated fund established by the corporation. A copy of that portion of your report is attached for your review and clarification.

The Commission recommends that if you have accepted prohibited contributions that you return the full amounts to the donors. These returns of the contribution should be reported immediately by letter and should be reflected as a contribution refund on your next report of receipts and expenditures. If the identification of the source of these contributions are incomplete or incorrect on the original report, please submit a statement which would clarify these particular matters for the public record. You may do so by amending your original report by letter.

Please notify the Commission within fifteen (15) days from the date of this letter of the determination made on this matter. Ms. Burke called regarding a letter she had received concerning the fact that the committee had accepted corporate contributions. (This must have been sent by the House as I have just put in a SV for this which has not been sent out yet). She said that they had not realized that corporate contributions were prohibited as Mr Wood had run for governor in the past and state law does not prohibit them. She said that the contributions had all been written on corporate checks. I told her that if they were in fact corporate funds, which they appear to be, there would be little choice<sup>but</sup> to refund them, and ask the contributor to re-give them from their personal accounts. She said they would begin doing this immediately and they were trying to comply with the law. I told her they would be receiving a surface violation next week.

I also told her she would be receiving an RFAI to attribute a partnership contribution. She said she really hadn't understood the difference between a corporation and a partnership. I explained the difference to her and I think she understood more fully the problem with the corporate checks. I also asked her about the cash contributions they received which were over \$100 which they showed on their Q1 and TOP reports. I asked her why there was such a gap in time from when they received the cash contribution to the time when they refunded them. She said that when they were accepted they hadn't realized the limitation. They then contacted the persons who, when they brought their checks in to replace the cash part of the contribution over \$100, they then handed them back their cash. They wanted to return the cash to the people personally. I asked to please put a short explanation of this in writing when she responds to the RFAI, in order to clarify the public record. I explained to her how this should have properly been reported, as a receipt and a refund, but I told her a written explanation of the situation would probably suffice rather than amending the report.

This letter is prompted by the Commission's interest in assisting candidates and committees who wish to comply with the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended. During review of the 10 Day Pre-Primary Report of Receipts and Expenditures, we noticed entries indicating that you may have accepted contributions from a corporation. Corporate contributions are prohibited by the Act, unless the contribution is made by a separate segregated fund established by the corporation. A copy of that portion of your report is attached for your review and clarification.

The Commission recommends that if you have accepted prohibited contributions that you return the full amounts to the donors. These returns of the contribution should be reported immediately by letter and should be reflected as a contribution refund on your next report of receipts and expenditures. If the identification of the source of these contributions are incomplete or incorrect on the original report, please submit a statement which would clarify these particular matters for the public record. You may do so by amending your original report by letter.

Please notify the Commission within fifteen (15) days from the date of this letter of the determination made on this matter. Spoke with Pam Burke, committee bookkeeper (503) 686-1255

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Ms. Burke called regarding a letter she had received concerning the fact that the committee had accepted corporate contributions. (This must have been sent by the House as I have just put in a SV for this which has not been sent out yet). She said that they had not realized that corporate contributions were prohibited as Mr Wood had run for governor in the past and state law does not prohibit them. She said that the contributions had all been written on corporate checks. I told her that if they were in fact corporate funds, which they appear to be, there would be little choice <sup>but</sup> to refund them, and ask the contributor to re-give them from their personal accounts. She said they would begin doing this immediately and they were trying to comply with the law. I told her they would be receiving a surface violation next week.

I also told her she would be receiving an RFAI to attribute a partnership contribution. She said she really hadn't understood the difference between a corporation and a partnership. I explained the difference to her and I think she understood more fully the problem with the corporate checks. I also asked her about the cash contributions they received which were over \$100 which they showed on their Q1 and 10P reports. I asked her why there was such a gap in time from when they received the cash contribution to the time when they refunded them. She said that when they were accepted they hadn't realized the limitation. They then contacted the persons who, when they brought their checks in to replace the cash part of the contribution over \$100, they then handed them back their cash. They wanted to return the cash to the people personally. I asked to please put a short explanation of this in writing when she responds to the RFAI, in order to clarify the public record. I explained to her how this should have properly been reported, as a receipt and a refund, but I told her a written explanation of the situation would probably suffice rather than amending the report.
