

Dear Mr. De Prospo:

On April 11, 1979, the Commission determined to take no further action against your Committee in connection with your acceptance of corporate contributions from Island Drafting and Technical Institute, Berkshire Nursing Center and Good Samaritan Hospital which may have violated 2 U.S.C. §441b(a). The Commission made this determination based on the fact that your Committee refunded the illegal contributions on 12 September 1978. In this regard, the Commission has noted that your September 12, 1978 letter stated that there was no indication that the checks received from the three contributors were in fact corporate checks. Your attention is drawn to Section 103.3(b) of the Commission's regulations which directs a Committee treasurer to "make his or her best effort to determine the legality of a contribution." Therefore, it is the responsibility of each recipient committee, before accepting a contribution, to determine whether the contribution is permissible under the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

The Commission notified all candidates and committees in August 1978 that in the future, civil penalties would be assessed against the contributors and recipients of corporate contributions in addition to the requirement that such contributions be refunded.



GENERATION OF MATTER

A review of 1978 reports filed by the Citizens for Downey '78 Committee (Committee) disclosed the receipt of four contributions which appeared to be contributions in violation of 2 USC § 441b(a): a \$50 contribution on 20 April 1978 and a \$25 contribution on 22 August 1978 from Island Drafting and Technical Institute; a \$50 contribution on 28 April 1978 from the Berkshire Nursing Center; and a \$50 contribution on 28 April 1978 from Good Samaritan Hospital. The Reports Analysis division referred this matter to the office of General Counsel on 16 March 1979. (See Attachment I)

EVIDENCE

The Committee was notified of the surface violation on 7 September 1978 and submitted a response on 12 September 1978 in which the Committee noted that the corporate contributions had been refunded. (See Attachment II) The Committee's October 10 quarterly report disclosed that the corporate contributions were refunded on 12 September 1978. (See Attachment III)

PRELIMINARY LEGAL ANALYSIS

Consistent with the Commission's policy on dealing with pre-August 1978 corporate contribution matters of this nature, we recommend that no further action be taken against the recipient committee. The Committee has been advised that the corporate contributions were illegal and has promptly refunded the money to the respective corporations. The proposed closing letter will advise the Committee of the illegality of these contributions and of the manner in which the Commission will deal with such contributions accepted after August 1978.

While the Commission apprised the Committee of the illegal contributions, the three contributors have not received such notification from the Commission. However, on July 26, 1978, the Commission adopted a \$100 contribution threshold for making "respondents" of corporate contributors (see Memorandum, p.2). As each corporate contribution in this matter fell short of the \$100 threshold, the Office of General Counsel recommends taking no action against the contributors and closing the file. In connection with a closing of the file, we propose sending letters to each of the contributors advising them of the illegality of the contributions.

RECOMMENDATION

- (1) Take no further action against the Citizens for Downey '78; send attached letter.
- (2) Take no action against the Island Drafting and Technical Institute, the Berkshire Nursing Center and the Good Samaritan Hospital; send attached letters.
- (3) Close the file.

Dear Mr. De Prospo:-

This letter is prompted by the Commission's interest in assisting candidates and committees who wish to comply with the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended. During review of the July 10 Report of Receipts and Expenditures, we noticed entries indicating that you may have accepted contributions from a corporation. Corporate contributions are prohibited by the Act, unless the contribution is made by a separate segregated fund established by the corporation. A copy of that portion of your report is attached for your review and clarification.



This letter is prompted by the Commission's interest in assisting candidates and committees who wish to comply with the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended. During review of the July 10 Report of Receipts and Expenditures, we noticed entries indicating that you may have accepted contributions from a corporation. Corporate contributions are prohibited by the Act, unless the contribution is made by a separate segregated fund established by the corporation. A copy of that portion of your report is attached for your review and clarification.

The Commission recommends that if you have accepted prohibited contributions that you return the full amounts to the donors. These returns of the contribution should be reported immediately by letter and should be reflected as a contribution refund on your next report of receipts and expenditures.
