CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

This matter having been initiated by the Federal Election Commission in the ordinary course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities, and, after an investigation, the Commission having found reason to believe (under then applicable statute) that the Fernandez for President Committee (hereinafter referred to as "Respondent") violated 2 U.S.C. § 434 of the Federal Election Campaign Act, ("the Act"), for failure to file cumulative reports of receipts and expenditures and for failure to continuously report debts and obligations with the Federal Election Commission.

WHEREFORE, the Commission and Respondent having duly entered into informal methods of conciliation do hereby agree as follows:

- I. The Federal Election Commission has jurisdiction over the Respondent and the subject matter in the case, and this Agreement has the effect of a conciliation agreement under 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(4)(A).
- II. Respondent has had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.

- III. Respondent enters voluntarily into this Agreement with the Commission.
- IV. The pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:
 - A. Respondent registered with the Commission on January 4, 1978, as the "Presidential Candidate Committee."
 - B. Respondent became the principal campaign committee for Benjamin Fernandez (1980 presidential candidate) in November 1978, changing its name to the Fernandez for President Committee.
 - C. Respondent's July 10, 1978 Report (closing date June 30, 1978) disclosed outstanding debts of \$25,368.53.
 - D. Respondent's October 10, 1978 Report began coverage of financial activity on August 13, 1978, and ended on September 30, 1978, leaving a disclosure gap between July 1, 1978 and August 12, 1978.
 - E. Respondent's October 10, 1978 Report disclosed outstanding debts of \$2,699.50 without showing whether or in what manner the original debts of \$25,368.53 had been reduced.
 - F. Reports Analysis Division made many requests for additional information regarding the inadequate disclosure.

- G. On February 5, 1979, the Commission found reason to believe that Respondent violated 2 U.S.C. § 434.
- H. Respondent attempted to obtain Committee records from former treasurer Morales, the treasurer from July 6 to August 23, 1978.
- I. Commission subsequently subpoenaed Mr. Edwin Morales for documents and mailed copies to Respondent upon receipt.
- J. On November 6, 1979, the Commission found reasonable cause to believe that Respondent violated 2 U.S.C. § 434.
- K. Respondent filed amended disclosure reports on April 28, 1980.

WHEREFORL, Respondent agrees that:

- I. 2 U.S.C. former § 434(c) requires that political committees file with the Commission cumulative reports of receipts and expenditures.
- II. 2 U.S.C. former § 434(b)(12) requires that political committees report continuously their debts and obligations until such debts are extinguished.
- III. Failure to timely file cumulative reports with the Commission constitutes a violation of 2 U.S.C. former § 434(c).
- IV. Failure to continuously report debts and obligations constitutes a violation of 2 U.S.C. former § 434(b)(12).


V. Respondent will pay a civil penalty to the Treasurer of the United States in the amount of \$500 pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(6)(B).

VI. Respondent shall not undertake any activity which is in violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, 2 U.S.C. § 431, et seq.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- I. The Commission, on request of anyone filing a complaint under 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1), concerning the matters at issue herein, or on its own motion, may review compliance with this Agreement. If the Commission believes that this Agreement or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute a civil action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.
- II. It is mutually agreed that this agreement shall become effective as of the date that all parties hereto have executed same and the Commission has approved the entire agreement.
- III. It is agreed that respondent shall have no more than thirty (30) days from the date this agreement becomes effective to comply with and implement the requirement contained in this agreement and to so notify the Commission.






On February 5, 1979, the Commission found reason to believe that the Fernandez for President Committee ("the Committee") was in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434 for failure to file cumulative reports, and failure to continuously report debts and obligations. This matter originated in the Reports Analysis Division and was subsequently referred to the Office of General Counsel.

The Committee did not disclose activity between July 1, 1978, and August 21, 1978, during which time Mr. Edwin Morales was treasurer. The present Committee officials have been unable to obtain records for the period from the former treasurer. The Committee has provided evidence of efforts to obtain the necessary documents. Mr. Morales resides in New Jersey and the Committee is headquartered in California.

The Commission approved a subpoena of the records in Mr. Morales' possession. Shortly thereafter, the Committee's assistant treasurer, Mr. Donald Kay, spoke with Mr. Morales and learned that the former treasurer would cooperate and send the records to California.

On that assurance, we withheld the subpoena in the interest of voluntary compliance. However, our most recent conversation with Mr. Kay revealed that he had not received the Committee's records. As a result of Mr. Morales' intransigence, we are proceeding with issuance of the subpoena.



GENERATION OF MATTER

This matter was referred to the Office of General Counsel by the Reports Analysis Division (RAD) because of respondent's failure to amend their reports.

EVIDENCE

The Presidential Candidate Committee (the Committee) registered with the Commission on January 4, 1978. In November, 1978 it became the principal campaign committee for Benjamin Fernandez, 1980 presidential candidate, and changed its name to the Fernandez for President Committee.

The Committee has been sent several RFAI's by RAD regarding their failure to file cumulative reports, in violation of 2 U.S.C. §434(c) and their failure to continuously report debts and obligations and/or provide relevant information about such debts obligations, if extinguished, in violation of 2 U.S.C. §434(b)(12).

On their July 10 Quarterly Report, which covered up to June 30, 1978, the Committee disclosed \$25,368.53 in outstanding debts. On their next report, the October 10 Quarterly Report, no reference was made to these outstanding debts. In addition, the Committee's activity between 7/1/78 and 8/21/78 was not disclosed as the report's beginning coverage date was 8/13/78. From July 6 through August 23, 1978, the treasurer of the committee was Edwin Morales.

RFAI's were sent out by RAD on December 14, 1978 in regard to all of the Committee's reports filed in 1978. In response, Mr. Donald Kay, assistant treasurer, has contacted the Commission numerous times by phone and letter. Mr. Kay has explained that records for the period 1/1/78-8/23/78 are in Mr. Morales' possession who, in turn, has not complied with requests from Committee members to supply them with such records. Documentation of the requests made to Mr. Morales have been sent to the Commission.

On February 5, 1979, the Commission found reason to believe the Committee was in violation of 2 U.S.C. §434.

ANALYSIS

As attempts by the Committee to obtain the records from Mr. Morales have proved unsuccessful, the Office of General Counsel recommends that the Commission authorize the attached subpoena for documents to be issued to Mr. Edwin Morales.

Approve the attached subpoena for documents and cover letter.



Dear Mr. Stoltz:

During the period of time from July 1, 1978 to his resignation on August 23, 1978, the Treasurer of this Committee was Mr. Edwin Morales.

Recently your office requested additional information from this Committee for the period when Mr. Morales was Treasurer. The records are still in Mr. Morales' possession, and we are unable to comply with your request until he returns said records to us.

We have written to Mr. Morales on February 19, 1979 and spoke to him on the telephone about returning the records to us. He informed us that he would send us the records but has yet to do so.





At that time, Mr. Fernandez informed Mr. Morales that the Federal Election Commission had requested additional information on records of the period I during which Mr. Morales was Treasurer of this Committee. At that time, Mr. Morales informed Mr. Fernandez that he was still in possession of all of the records of the Committee for that period and would send them to this office.

On February 15, 1979, at approximately 2:02 P.M., I again phoned Mr. Morales and requested information as to when we might expect to receive the records from him. His answer was that he had not sent out the records of that time but planned to send them "when he get around to do it".

At this point in this conversation, I explained to Mr. Morales that the Federal Election Commission needed information and it was important that we receive the records to comply with the Commission as quickly as possible. Mr. Morales then informed me "never mind about the God damned crop" about the Commission. He was mad at Fernandez anyway because Fernandez owed him money and he would send the records on Monday, February 12 if he got around to bringing them up to date". When I asked what that meant, I was informed that he didn't owe me any explanation and if I wished to mention that to the Federal Election Commission "go ahead". At that point Morales hung up the phone after refusing to give me his mailing address, telling me it was none of my darned business.

Gilda B. Gjurich, present Treasurer of the Fernandez for President Committee, is a member of the Executive Committee for the Republican National Hispanic Assembly.

Edwin Morales, a former Treasurer for the Fernandez for President Committee and a Fieldman for the Republican National Hispanic Assembly.

There is a possibility that the Republican National Hispanic Assembly Committee has made undisclosed in-kind contributions to the Fernandez for President Committee (Formerly Presidential Candidate Committee) in the form of salaries.
