



Interim Investigative Report

This matter was originally referred to the Office of the General Counsel by the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") on April 9, 1979, because of the respondent committee's failure to file a Statement of Organization in violation of 2 U.S.C. §433. On May 15, 1979, the Commission deferred requesting the Committee to register through the enforcement process until the Committee had adequate time to respond to Advisory Opinion 79-14, which it had requested.

Advisory Opinion 79-14, which stated that the respondent was required to file a Statement of Organization, was received by the Committee on May 17, 1979. The Committee has not responded to the A.O. and the Office of General Counsel has made a number of attempts to contact the American Party of Georgia by phone to determine what their intention is in this regard. We have not spoken with the Committee's Treasurer but we have left messages concerning the nature of our calls. If we receive no response in the very near future we will prepare recommendations for further action.

GENERATION OF MATTER

This matter was referred to the Office of the General Counsel by the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") on April 9, 1979, because of the Respondent Committee's failure to file a statement of organization in violation of 2 U.S.C. §433. (Attachment I)

EVIDENCE

This matter originated in connection with transfers totalling \$1,666 made by the American Party of Georgia (the Georgia Committee) to the National American Party during 1977. The National American Party is registered with the Commission. On February 27, 1979 the Commission found reason to believe that the Georgia Committee had violated 2 U.S.C. §433. On March 5, 1979 the Georgia Committee requested an Advisory Opinion as to whether it is subject to the requirements of §433, since it has made "no contributions to a Federal candidate..." (Attachment II)

An earlier matter, MUR 277, dealt with a similar issue in connection with transfers from state affiliates to the National American Party during 1975 and 1976. The Georgia Committee was one of these affiliates, having transferred \$1,100 in 1975 and \$1,622 in 1976 to the National Party. The Commission, on April 20, 1978 found reason to believe and on June 12, 1978 reasonable cause to believe that the Georgia Committee was in violation of 2 U.S.C. §§433 and 434. On July 19, 1978 the Commission voted to take no

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further action against the Georgia Committee, since reports received from it adequately disclosed the origin of assessments paid to the National Party in 1975 and/or 1976. Letters of notification were not sent to the state affiliates, including the Georgia Committee, whose matters were closed in this MUR.

LEGAL ANALYSIS

2 U.S.C. §433(a) requires a political committee to register with the Commission if it makes expenditures in excess of \$1,000 during the calendar year in connection with a federal election. See also 11 CFR §102.1(a). The National American Party is registered with the Commission and it appears that the National does not maintain separate federal and non federal accounts pursuant to 11 CFR §102.6 (a)(2). Therefore when the American Party of Georgia transferred in excess of \$1,000 to the National's single account, the American Party of Georgia became responsible for registering as a political committee. (See also AO 1978-91, pg. 4).

However, in light of the fact that the American Party of Georgia has requested an Advisory Opinion regarding the requirements of §433 and its obligation to register, we recommend that the Commission defer action until the respondent has reviewed and responded to the A.O. which is issued.

RECOMMENDATION

Defer action until the American Party of Georgia has had the opportunity to respond to Advisory Opinion 1979-14.

Concerning your letter of February 27, 1979, 35v2/78-100, please be advised that the Campaign Disclosure Reports for 1977 that your agency requested were completed and mailed to the FEC on February 15th by our treasurer, Mr. D.J. Fulton.

This information was submitted after discussion with Alma Smith and her supervisor, Peggy Sims. The submission of this data does not acknowledge any obligation of this committee to register and report as a Campaign Committee.

I would like to request from the Commission an Advisory Opinion on whether or not the American Party of Georgia is subject to the registration and reporting requirements of the Federal Election Campaign Act.

As a member of the National Executive Board of the American Party of the United States and a former National Vice-Chairman I have done a thorough study of the Federal Election Campaign Act and it is my opinion that the American Party of the United States and its various State Committees have made no contributions to a Federal Candidate or otherwise met the definition of campaign committees required to register and report.

I understand that the FEC auditors spent a great deal of time with Mrs. Margaret Woodhead in Pigeon Forge, Tennessee going over the National American Party Financial records.

Mrs. Woodhead has assured me that the 1976 American Party Presidential campaign was funded entirely from a separate account and that all the reports have been submitted for this campaign activity. Furthermore, no general Party funds nor State Party Assessments were utilized in that or any other federal campaign.

After research into the FEC Regulations and the Federal Election Campaign Laws, I cannot find any requirement for the American Party of Georgia to register and report.

This matter was referred to the Office of the General Counsel by the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") on April 9, 1979, because of the Respondent Committee's failure to file a statement of organization in violation of 2 U.S.C. §433. (Attachment I)

EVIDENCE

The American Party of Georgia, which is an unregistered committee, transferred a total of \$1,666 during 1977 to the National American Party. The National American Party is registered with the Commission. On February 27, 1979 the Commission found reason to believe that the Committee had violated 2 U.S.C. §433. On March 5, 1979 the Committee requested an Advisory Opinion as to whether it is subject to the requirements of §433, since it has made "no contributions to a Federal candidate..." (Attachment II)

LEGAL ANALYSIS

2 U.S.C. §433(a) requires a political committee to register with the Commission if it makes expenditures in excess of \$1,000 during the calendar year in connection with a federal election. See also 11 CFR §102.1(a). The National American Party is registered with the Commission and it appears that the National does not maintain separate federal and non federal accounts pursuant to 11 CFR §102.6 (a)(2). Therefore when the American Party of Georgia transferred in excess of \$1,000 to the National's single account, the American Party of Georgia became responsible for registering as a political committee. (See also AO 1978-91, pg. 4) Therefore, we recommend that the Commission send the attached letter to the Committee notifying it of its obligation to register.

RECOMMENDATION

Send the attached letter to the American Party of Georgia notifying it of its obligation to file a statement of organization.



The act defines "political committee" to mean any organization, or other group of persons which receives contributions or makes expenditures (which includes contributions to Federal candidates and committees supporting Federal candidates), aggregating in excess of \$1,000 during a calendar year. It would appear that your organization may qualify as a "political committee" subject to registration, reporting, and contribution limitation requirements of the Act.

If you agree that your organization is a political committee, please submit a Statement of Organization on FEC Form 1, in accordance with 2 U.S.C. 423. In addition, your committee will be required to file disclosure reports in accordance with 2 U.S.C. 434 on FEC Form 3.

Mr. Hawkins was referred to me by Alva Smith. Mr. Hawkins wanted to know the basis upon which the FEC was requesting the American Party of Georgia to file reports. I stated that the request was based on the national American Party reports which showed transfers in from the American Party of Georgia in excess of \$1,000 per calendar year. I explained that because the national American Party was considered ^{a federal committee} whose activities influenced federal elections, the American Party of Georgia was considered to be making expenditures in excess of \$1,000 per calendar year towards influencing a federal election. It was Mr. Hawkins' understanding that the national American Party committee maintained two bank accounts; one for Presidential activity from which expenditures were made for all federal activity, and one "General Fund" which accepted assessments from the states and made expenditures for activity other than federal activity. He stated that he had talked to Mrs. Woodhead of the national American Party who told him FEC auditors instructed her to report the transfers in from the state American Party committees. Mr. Hawkins questioned the rationale behind the FEC auditors' suggestion. I responded, indicating that I did not know what the FEC audit findings were as the audit had not yet been published. I added

that, unless we had found federal activity in the "General Fund" if they had made such a recommendation to Mrs. Woodhead. Mr. Hawkins emphasized that, in his capacity as the Vice-Chairman of the national American Party, he was informed that none of the money in the General Fund was used for federal elections. Mr. Hawkins then stated that he would file reports for 1977 and we briefly discussed how to record transfers-in from district American Party committees. I reminded him that he should also file a Statement of Organization. In concluding, we discussed the method by which Mr. Hawkins could file a AOR concerning the reportability of the state assessment.

Note: A subsequent discussion with FEC auditor Kevin McFadden revealed that the "General Fund" is the American Party national committee which is registered with the FEC. The account involved in the presidential activity was the American Party Presidential candidate's p.e.c.

Concerning your letter of February 27, 1979, 35v2/78-100, please be advised that the Campaign Disclosure Reports for 1977 that your agency requested were completed and mailed to the FEC on February 15th by our treasurer, Mr. D.J. Fulton.

This information was submitted after discussion with Alma Smith and her supervisor, Peggy Sims. The submission of this data does not acknowledge any obligation of this committee to register and report as a Campaign Committee.

I would like to request from the Commission an Advisory Opinion on whether or not the American Party of Georgia is subject to the registration and reporting requirements of the Federal Election Campaign Act.

As a member of the National Executive Board of the American Party of the United States and a former National Vice-Chairman I have done a thorough study of the Federal Election Campaign Act and it is my opinion that the American Party of the United States and its various State Committees have made no contributions to a Federal Candidate or otherwise met the definition of campaign committees required to register and report.

I understand that the FEC auditors spent a great deal of time with Mrs. Margaret Woodhead in Pigeon Forge, Tennessee going over the National American Party Financial records.

Mrs. Woodhead has assured me that the 1976 American Party Presidential campaign was funded entirely from a separate account and that all the reports have been submitted for this campaign activity. Furthermore, no general Party funds nor State Party Assessments were utilized in that or any other federal campaign.

After research into the FEC Regulations and the Federal Election Campaign Laws, I cannot find any requirement for the American Party of Georgia to register and report.






