The Federal Election Commission has absolutely no jurisdiction over election administration, including whether states permit vote-by-mail. The Commission is charged with the administration, enforcement, and formulation of policy with respect to the Federal Election Campaign Act, the Presidential Election Campaign Fund, and the Presidential Primary Matching Account.
