The Federal Election Commission (the "Commission") was asked by the Office of Management and Budget to provide its views regarding S. 1321, the Defending the Integrity of Voting Systems Act, which passed Congress and is awaiting Presidential action. This bill would amend Title 18 of the United States Code to criminalize interference with voting systems under the Computer Fraud and Abuse Act.
